### **CLEMSON OVERVIEW**

- Clemson, who has a 10-5 road record, swept No. 22 Louisville in three home games last weekend and have won nine of its last 10 games.
- The Tigers are averaging 6.9 runs per game and hitting .298 with a .449 slugging percentage, .393 on-base percentage and 69 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.42 ERA, .249 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .975.

## **COASTAL CAROLINA OVERVIEW**

• Coastal Carolina, who has a 19-9 home record and is averaging 9.4 runs per game, is led by 28th-year Head Coach Gary Gilmore.

#### **QUICK HITS**

- Clemson totaled 15 hits in its 16-6 win over No. 17 Coastal Carolina in seven innings at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on April 4, 2023.
- Clemson has won nine of its last 10 games and 14 of its last 17 games.
- Seven Tigers have contributed to the team's 12 saves in 2023.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

- Clemson is averaging 4,426 fans per home date (28), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 8).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 10 in the nation by Perfect Game, its second weekly ranking of the season.
- Clemson is ranked in the top 25 in all six polls this week for the first time in 2023.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

## **ACC STANDINGS**

- Clemson is in second place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 14-10 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for third.
- Clemson was in last place in the overall ACC standings at 2-8 after its loss at Florida State on April 6, but is 12-2 in ACC games since.

## **DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM**



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse. coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

#### **SCHEDULE STRONG**

- Clemson has an RPI of 13 (through games of May 8).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-15 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 4 in the nation.
- · Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 13 in the nation, and the Tigers are 17-7 in nonconference games.
- Of Clemson' 48 games, 38 have been against teams with a winning record through games of May 8.
- Seven of the Tigers' last eight regular-season games are against teams in the top 51 of the RPI.

#### **ROAD SURGE**

- Clemson's second-half surge is due in large part to its success in road games, as it has won eight of its last nine road contests.
- The Tigers have a 10-5 road record on the season after starting the year 2-4 in road games.
- · Clemson won the final two games at Florida State, downed Georgia, swept NC State and won two of three games at No. 11 Boston College.
- Clemson is 8-4 in road ACC games.
- Excluding the shortened 2020 season, Clemson has not finished with a .500 or better road record since 2018 (15-5).

#### **SWIPING BAGS**

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 69 in 48 games (1.4 per game).
- · Clemson has multiple steals in 18 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 69 stolen bases.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 19 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 16 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

### **FIELDING STEADY**

- Clemson has a .975 fielding percentage in 2023, ahead of the Tiger record for fielding percentage in a season, set by the 2018 team (.975).
- Clemson has committed just 43 errors in 48 games in 2023
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 31 of the last 34 games.
- Clemson is 11-5 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than six errors on the season.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 16 errors.
- Clemson has a .978 fielding percentage in ACC regularseason games, committing only 19 errors in 22 games.

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the preseason
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant cap-
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

#### **AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE**

- Sophomore infielder Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger Iore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.

- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He's hitting .387 with eight homers, a triple, nine doubles, 32 RBIs, 22 runs and a .438 on-base percentage in 31 games (27 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .717 slugging percentage.
- He has 19 two-out RBIs among his 32 RBIs.
- He played only one of the first 12 games in 2023 and did not make his first start until March 11, Clemson's 15th game of the season.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the goahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.
- In his career, he is hitting .344 with eight homers, a triple, nine doubles, 32 RBIs and 23 runs in 40 games (30 starts).
- He has a .624 slugging percentage and .393 on-base percentage in his career.

#### **AMMONS RETURNS**

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He is 1-0 with four saves, a 2.25 ERA and .161 opponents' batting average in 16.0 innings pitched over seven appearances (two starts).
- He has 21 strikeouts against only three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .053 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- He recorded two saves in Clemson's three-game sweep of No. 22 Louisville from May 5-7.
- In his career, he is 2-2 with 12 saves, a 3.78 ERA, .191 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 47.2 innings pitched (41 outings).

#### **BERTRAM ADDING LEADERSHIP**

- Senior Riley Bertram transferred to Clemson after four years at Michigan, including one (2019) when he played in the College World Series.
- He has been the everyday starter at second base in the 2023 season and has been one of the team's best
- The switch-hitter is batting .257 with eight doubles, 27 RBIs, 26 runs, a .365 on-base percentage and 10 steals in 48 games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game.
- He has a .976 fielding percentage, committing only
- He is hitting .284 with a .385 on-base percentage and five steals in 24 ACC regular-season games.
- He is hitting .389 in the last nine games.

#### **BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED**

- Senior infielder Beniamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including 16 stolen bases.

## **NOTES**

- He is hitting .305 with nine doubles, two triples, a homer, 21 RBIs, 26 runs and a .393 on-base percentage in 48 games in 2023.
- He has 17 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game.
- He has a .967 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only six errors in 181 chances.
- His .967 fielding percentage is fourth highest in a season by a Tiger shortstop in history.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .318 with 19 doubles, three triples, four homers, 54 RBIs, 78 runs and 20 steals in 106 games.
- He has committed only 17 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .958 fielding percentage.

#### **CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN**

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .391 with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, 32 RBIs, 55 runs, a .464 on-base percentage and 19 steals in 45 games.
- He leads the team lead in batting average, runs, hits (75), total bases (100), multiple-hit games (22) and steals.
- He has four three-hit games, three four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .395 with runners on base and .440 with two outs.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 43 of his 45 games.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

#### **CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE**

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 5-0 with a 3.22 ERA, .198 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts against 17 walks in 36.1 innings pitched over 18 appearances.
- He has only allowed five extra-base hits thanks in large part to 47 groundball outs compared to 15 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .135 with runners on base and .125 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed five of 20 inherited baserunners to score.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- In his career, he is 12-3 with a save, 4.09 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 113 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched (54 outings).

#### **DARDEN A TIGER WINNER**

 Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.

- He is 3-2 with a 5.05 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts in 46.1 innings pitched over 15 outings (nine starts) in 2023.
- He has 72 groundball outs compared to only 24 flyball outs.
- Clemson has an 8-1 record in his nine starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.
- He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

#### **GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION**

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.35 ERA, .205 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against eight walks in 23.0 innings pitched in 2023.
- He leads the team in appearances (20).
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .195 with runners on base and .182 with runners in scoring position.

#### **GORDON PROVIDING STARTS**

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-4 with a 4.52 ERA, .234 opponents' batting average and 58 strikeouts against 15 walks in 63.2 innings pitched over 12 starts.
- A total of 23 of his 34 runs allowed have come on the 15 home runs he has surrendered.
- He is holding opponents to .132 with two outs.
- He is 1-4 with a 3.80 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 44 strikeouts against 13 walks in 45.0 innings pitched over eight ACC starts.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with five strikeouts in Clemson's 4-3 win over No. 22 Louisville on May 6.
- In his career, he is 2-4 with two saves, a 4.71 ERA and 89 strikeouts against 24 walks in 91.2 innings pitched over 29 outings (12 starts).

#### **GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS**

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.42 ERA .199 opponents' batting average and 68 strikeouts in 50.0 innings pitched over 10 starts on the mound in 2023.
- Clemson has an 8-2 record in his 10 starts on the mound.
- He is holding opponents to .167 with runners on base, .188 with runners in scoring position and .118 with two outs
- He is hitting .301 with 11 homers, a triple, 12 doubles, 46 RBIs, 38 runs and three steals in 44 games (43 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .589 slugging percentage and .412 on-base percentage.
- He is only the third Tiger in history with 10+ homers and 5+ wins in a season, joining Jarrod Schmidt (2001) and Kris Harvey (2005).
- $\bullet$  He has a team-high 24 two-out RBIs.
- He has hit all 11 of his homers in the last 30 games of the season.
- He has a team-tying-high 11 multiple-RBI games, including two three-RBI games, three four-RBI games and two five-RBI games.
- He is 5-for-9 (.556) with two grand slams, 18 RBIs, a 1.222 slugging percentage and .615 on-base percentage with the bases loaded.

- He is hitting .318 with eight homers, seven doubles, 30 RBIs, a .670 slugging percentage and .426 on-base percentage in 24 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.
- With two outs and Clemson trailing in the eighth inning, he hit a grand slam in the Tigers' 9-7 win at NC State on April 22.

- . He has 25 strikeouts against nine walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.66 ERA and 90 strikeouts against 41 walks in 104.1 innings pitched over 63 appearances.

### **OLENCHUK CHANGING FOR THE BETTER**

- Junior righthander and outfielder Ty Olenchuk changed his posture and delivery midway through 2023.
- He is putting up strong numbers in the second half of the season.
- He is 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA, .254 opponents' batting average and 14 strikeouts in 17.1 innings pitched over 12 relief appearances in 2023.

- He was 6-for-8 (.750) with an .833 on-base percentage in the three-game sweep over No. 22 Louisville from May 5-7.
