CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has an 11-5 road record, defeated No. 8 Coastal Carolina 13-6 on the road on Wednesday.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.0 runs per game and hitting .298 with a .451 slugging percentage, .394 on-base percentage and 70 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.45 ERA, .249 opponents' batting average and 2.52 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .976.

VIRGINIA TECH OVERVIEW

- Virginia Tech, who has a 21-7 home record and is averaging 9.2 runs per game, is led by sixth-year Head Coach John Szefc.
- The Hokies defeated Liberty 14-1 on the road on Wednesday. They are hitting .302 and have a 5.25 ERA and .983 fielding percentage.
- Jack Hurley is hitting .342 with 16 homers and 45 RBIs, and Garrett Michel is batting .336 with 10 homers and 41 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson has won 10 of its last 11 games and 15 of its last 18 games.
- Clemson has won five ACC series in a row, the first time the Tigers have done that in one season since 2017, when they won the first five.
- Clemson is 29-8 when totaling at least as many hits as the opposition.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,426 fans per home date (28), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 10).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 10 in the nation by Perfect Game this week, its second weekly ranking of the season.
- Clemson is ranked in the top 25 in all six polls this week for the first time in 2023.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in second place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 14-10 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is tied for third place.
- Clemson was in last place in the overall ACC standings at 2-8 after its loss at Florida State on April 6, but is 12-2 in ACC games since.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of 11 (through games of May 10).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-15 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 4 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 16 in the nation, and the Tigers are 18-7 in non-conference games.
- Of Clemson' 49 games, 39 have been against teams with a winning record through games of May 10.
- Six of the Tigers' last seven regular-season games are against teams in the top 48 of the RPI.

ROAD SURGE

- Clemson's second-half surge is due in large part to its success in road games, as it has won nine of its last 10 road contests.
- The Tigers have an 11-5 road record on the season after starting the year 2-4 in road games.
- Clemson won the final two games at Florida State, downed Georgia, swept NC State and won two of three games at No. 11 Boston College.
- Clemson is 8-4 in road ACC games.
- Excluding the shortened 2020 season, Clemson has not finished with a .500 or better road record since 2018 (15-5).

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 70 in 49 games (1.4 per game).
- Clemson has multiple steals in 18 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 70 stolen bases.
- Cam Cannarella has a team-high 19 steals, while Benjamin Blackwell is second on the team with 17 steals.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a .976 fielding percentage in 2023, ahead of the Tiger record for fielding percentage in a season, set by the 2018 team (.975).
- Clemson has committed just 43 errors in 49 games in 2023.
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 32 of the last 35 games.
- Clemson is 12-5 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than six errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 16 errors.
- Clemson has a .978 fielding percentage in ACC regular-season games, committing only 19 errors in 24 games.

GRADUATES

- Six Tigers received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 11.
- Ryan Ammons, Nick Clayton, Nick Hoffmann and Rob Hughes earned their bachelor's degrees.
- Benjamin Blackwell and Tyler Corbitt earned their master's degrees.
- Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Willie Weiss earned their certificates.

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .393 with nine homers, a triple, nine doubles, 35 RBIs, 24 runs and a .441 on-base percentage in 32 games (28 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .732 slugging percentage.
- He has 20 two-out RBIs among his 35 RBIs.
- He played only one of the first 12 games in 2023 and did not make his first start until March 11, Clemson's 15th game of the season.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the go-ahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.
- In his career, he is hitting .351 with nine homers, a triple, nine doubles, 35 RBIs and 25 runs in 41 games (31 starts).
- He has a .641 slugging percentage and .397 on-base percentage in his career.

AMMONS RETURNS

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He is 1-0 with four saves, a 2.25 ERA and .161 opponents' batting average in 16.0 innings pitched over seven appearances (two starts).
- He has 21 strikeouts against only three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .053 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- He recorded two saves in Clemson's three-game sweep of No. 22 Louisville from May 5-7.
- In his career, he is 2-2 with 12 saves, a 3.78 ERA, .191 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 47.2 innings pitched (41 outings).

BERTRAM ADDING LEADERSHIP

- Senior Riley Bertram transferred to Clemson after four years at Michigan, including one (2019) when he played in the College World Series.
- He has been the everyday starter at second base in the 2023 season and has been one of the team's best leaders.
- The switch-hitter is batting .251 with eight doubles, 27 RBIs, 27 runs, a .364 on-base percentage and 10 steals in 49 games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .977 fielding percentage, committing only five errors.
- He is hitting .284 with a .385 on-base percentage and five steals in 24 ACC regular-season games.

NOTES

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way in 2023, including 17 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .307 with nine doubles, two triples, a homer, 22 RBIs, 28 runs and a .403 on-base percentage in 49 games in 2023.
- He has 17 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .968 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only six errors.
- His .968 fielding percentage is fourth highest in a season by a Tiger shortstop in history.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .318 with 19 doubles, three triples, four homers, 55 RBIs, 80 runs and 21 steals in 107 games.
- He has committed only 17 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .958 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Freshman Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .390 with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, 33 RBIs, 55 runs, a .460 on-base percentage and 19 steals in 46 games.
- He leads the team in runs, hits (76), total bases (101), multiple-hit games (22) and steals.
- He has four three-hit games, three four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .390 with runners on base and .431 with two outs.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 44 of his 46 games.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righthander Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the 2023 season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 5-0 with a 3.22 ERA, .198 opponents' batting average and 42 strikeouts against 17 walks in 36.1 innings pitched over 18 appearances.
- He has only allowed five extra-base hits thanks in large part to 47 groundball outs compared to 15 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .135 with runners on base and .125 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed five of 20 inherited baserunners to score.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.

- In his career, he is 12-3 with a save, 4.09 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 113 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched (54 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 3-2 with a 5.05 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts in 46.1 innings pitched over 15 outings (nine starts) in 2023.
- He has 72 groundball outs compared to only 24 flyball outs.
- Clemson has an 8-1 record in his nine starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.
- He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.35 ERA, .205 opponents' batting average and 32 strikeouts against eight walks in 23.0 innings pitched in 2023.
- He leads the team in appearances (20).
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .195 with runners on base and .182 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-4 with a 4.52 ERA, .234 opponents' batting average and 58 strikeouts against 15 walks in 63.2 innings pitched over 12 starts.
- A total of 23 of his 34 runs allowed have come on the 15 home runs he has surrendered.
- He is holding opponents to .132 with two outs.
- He is 1-4 with a 3.80 ERA, .206 opponents' batting average and 44 strikeouts against 13 walks in 45.0 innings pitched over eight ACC starts.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with five strikeouts in Clemson's 4-3 win over No. 22 Louisville on May 6.
- In his career, he is 2-4 with two saves, a 4.71 ERA and 89 strikeouts against 24 walks in 91.2 innings pitched over 29 outings (12 starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.42 ERA, .199 opponents' batting average and 68 strikeouts in 56.0 innings pitched over 10 starts on the mound in 2023.
- Clemson has an 8-2 record in his 10 starts on the mound.
- He is holding opponents to .167 with runners on base, .188 with runners in scoring position and .118 with two outs.
- He is hitting .299 with 12 homers, a triple, 12 doubles, 47 RBIs, 41 runs and three steals in 45 games (44 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .599 slugging percentage and .415 on-base percentage.
- He is only the third Tiger in history with 10+ homers and 5+ wins in a season, joining Jarrod Schmidt (2001) and Kris Harvey (2005).
- He has a team-high 24 two-out RBIs.

- He has hit all 12 of his home runs in the last 31 contests.
- He has a team-tying-high 11 multiple-RBI games, including two three-RBI games, three four-RBI games and two five-RBI games.
- He is 5-for-9 (.556) with two grand slams, 18 RBIs, a 1.222 slugging percentage and .615 on-base percentage with the bases loaded.
- He is hitting .318 with eight homers, seven doubles, 30 RBIs, a .670 slugging percentage and .426 on-base percentage in 24 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.
- On March 26, he hit two homers with five RBIs, and he pitched 5.0 strong innings with six strikeouts to earn the win in a starting role.
- At Florida State on April 8, he pitched 6.1 innings to earn the win and went 2-for-4 with a grand slam in the 6-2 series-clinching victory.

- Junior catcher and outfielder Cooper Ingle has proven why he is one of the best hitters in the ACC, including with some power.
- He is hitting .325 with five homers, 13 doubles, 30 RBIs, 42 runs, a .415 on-base percentage and steal in 48 games in 2023.
- He has 30 walks against only 22 strikeouts in 197 at-bats.
- He had a 16-game hitting streak from February to March.
- He had a 19-game hitting streak from April to May.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 43 straight games.
- He went 5-for-6 with a homer, four RBIs and two runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cam Cannarella, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.

- Ingle and Cannarella became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- In his career, he is hitting .328 with 26 doubles, 13 homers, 77 RBIs, 94 runs and a .424 on-base percentage in 112 games (106 starts).

LINDLEY A SUPER SENIOR OUT OF PEN

- Fifth-year senior and righty Jackson Lindley has continued his dependability out of the bullpen from the 2022 season into the 2023 season.
- He is 1-3 with two saves, a 3.75 ERA and .271 opponents' batting average in 24.0 innings pitched over 15 appearances (one start) in 2023.
- He has 26 strikeouts against nine walks.
- He has only allowed two of nine inherited baserunners to score.
- In his career, he is 10-3 with three saves, a 4.61 ERA and 91 strikeouts against 41 walks in 105.1 innings pitched over 64 appearances.

OLENCHUK CHANGING FOR THE BETTER

- Junior righthander and outfielder Ty Olenchuk changed his posture and delivery midway through the 2023 season.
- He is putting up strong numbers in the second half of the season.
- He is 1-0 with a 3.50 ERA, .260 opponents' batting average and 15 strikeouts in 18.0 innings pitched over 13 relief appearances in 2023.
- In his last eight appearances, he has allowed only nine hits and one run with 10 strikeouts in 11.0 innings pitched.
- In his career, he is 4-4 with a 4.52 ERA, .269 opponents' batting average and 61 strikeouts in 71.2 innings pitched over 44 appearances.

TALLEN ADDS DEPTH IN LONG RELIEF

- Sophomore righthander Casey Tallent has been a consistent long reliever in 2023.
- He is 1-0 with one save, a 2.04 ERA, .232 opponents' batting average and 17 strikeouts in 17.2 innings pitched over 12 appearances in 2023.
- He is holding opponents to .100 with runners in scoring position.
- In his 11 relief appearances, he is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched.
- He missed four weeks due to injury from late March to early April.
- In his career, he is 2-0 with a save, 3.07 ERA, .239 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts in 41.0 innings pitched over 27 outings.

TAYLOR FINDING HIS BASEBALL RHYTHM

- Sophomore outfielder Will Taylor is healthy after an injury-plagued freshman season.
- The wide receiver on the Tiger football team has found his rhythm in left field in 2023.
- He is hitting .345 with 15 doubles, two triples, three homers, 38 RBIs, 46 runs, a .474 on-base percentage and six steals in 48 games.
- He is hitting a team-high .403 with runners in scoring position.
- He has 19 multiple-hit games and a team-tying-high 11 multiple-RBI games.
- He had multiple hits in six consecutive games in March.
- He was 6-for-8 (.750) with an .833 on-base percentage in the three-game sweep over No. 22 Louisville from May 5-7.
