CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, who has a 21-10 home record, defeated USC Upstate 12-2 in eight innings at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.3 runs per game and hitting .306 with a .462 slugging percentage, .400 on-base percentage and 80 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.47 ERA, .252 opponents' batting average and 2.37 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .976.

NORTH CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- North Carolina, who has a 9-5 road record and is averaging 7.7 runs per game, is led by third-year Head Coach Scott Forbes.
- The Tar Heels lost at No. 8 Coastal Carolina 8-6 on Tuesday. They are hitting .286 and have a 4.52 ERA and .975 fielding percentage.
- Casey Cook is hitting .348, Mac Horvath has 21 homers and 61 RBIs, Tomas Frick has 10 homers and 50 RBIs and Kevin Eaise has five saves.

QUICK HITS

- On Saturday at 12:30 p.m., Clemson will honor its 10 senior players on Senior Day.
- Clemson has won nine games in a row, 14 of its last 15 games and 19 of its last 22 games.
- The Tiger bullpen is 23-9 with a 4.11 ERA, .259 opponents' batting average and 257 strikeouts against 114 walks in 249.2 innings pitched.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,415 fans per home date (29), the 13th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of May 16).
- Entering 2023, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance 29 straight seasons.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 6 in the nation by Perfect Game this week, its third weekly ranking of the season.
- Clemson is ranked in the top 25 in all six polls for the second week in a row.
- Clemson's top-10 ranking marked its first such ranking since the 2018 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in second place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 17-10 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is also in second place.
- Clemson was in last (14th) place in the overall ACC standings at 2-8 after a loss at Florida State on April 6, but is 15-2 in the ACC since.
- The Tigers have also won 13 of their last 14 ACC games since Notre Dame defeated the Tigers in the series opener on April 14.

ACC SERIES WINS IN A ROW

- Clemson has won six ACC series in a row and has won 15 of its last 17 ACC games since Florida State defeated Clemson on April 6.
- Clemson has won those series over Florida State, Notre Dame, NC State, No. 11 Boston College, No. 22 Louisville and Virginia Tech.
- It is the first time Clemson has won six ACC series in a row during one season since 2011, when it won its last six ACC series.
- Clemson went from playing 24 ACC regular-season games (eight series) in 2004 to 30 ACC regular-season games (10 series) starting in 2005.
- Clemson won all eight ACC series in 1994, its last time winning more than six ACC series in a row during one season.

SCHEDULE STRONG

- Clemson has an RPI of No. 8 (through games of May 16).
- A big reason for the Tigers' top-10 RPI is their strength of schedule, which is No. 4 in the nation.
- Clemson's non-conference strength of schedule is No. 19 in the nation, and the Tigers were 19-7 in regular-season non-conference games.
- Of Clemson's 53 games, 46 have been against teams with a .500 or better overall record through games of May 16.

ROAD SURGE

- Clemson's second-half surge is due in large part to its success in road games, as it has won 12 of its last 13 road contests.
- The Tigers have a 14-5 road record on the season after starting the year 2-4 in road games.
- Clemson won two games at Florida State, downed Georgia, swept NC State, won two games at No. 11 Boston College and swept Virginia Tech.
- Clemson was 11-4 in ACC road games.
- Excluding the shortened 2020 season, Clemson has not finished with a .500 or better road record since 2018 (15-5).

SWIPING BAGS

- A key to Clemson's scoring has been its ability to steal bases, as it has 80 in 53 games (1.5 per game).
- Clemson has multiple steals in 22 games.
- A total of 12 different Tigers have contributed to the team's 80 stolen bases.
- Benjamin Blackwell and Cam Cannarella are tied for the team lead with 21 steals apiece.
- Benjamin Blackwell and Cam Cannarella are the first Tiger duo with 20+ steals apiece in a season since 2011.
- Clemson totaled 17 steals in the season-opening series against Binghamton, including 11 in the season opener, one shy of the school record.

FIELDING STEADY

- Clemson has a .976 fielding percentage in 2023, ahead of the Tiger record for fielding percentage in a season, set by the 2018 team (.975).
- Clemson has committed just 46 errors in 53 games in 2023.
- Clemson has committed no errors or one error in 35 of the last 39 games.
- Clemson is 14-5 when not committing an error in a game.
- No Tiger has committed more than seven errors.
- The everyday third baseman (Blake Wright), shortstop (Benjamin Blackwell) and second baseman (Riley Bertram) have combined for 17 errors.
- Clemson has a .979 fielding percentage in ACC regular-season games, committing only 21 errors in 27 games.

CAPTAINS

- Ryan Ammons, Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains in the pre-season.
- Benjamin Blackwell, Chad Fairey and Mac Starbuck were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Tristan Bissetta, Jacob Jarrell and Rocco Reid were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

GRADUATES

- Six Tiger players received their diplomas during commencement ceremonies in Littlejohn Coliseum on May 11.
- Ryan Ammons, Nick Clayton, Nick Hoffmann and Rob Hughes earned their bachelor's degrees.
- Benjamin Blackwell and Tyler Corbitt earned their master's degrees.
- Riley Bertram, Jackson Lindley and Willie Weiss earned their certificates.

NOTES

AMICK PUTS NAME IN TIGER LORE

- Sophomore infielder Billy Amick had been a bench player in his career until March 10, when he put his stamp in Tiger lore.
- He entered the series opener against Georgia State in the sixth inning as a pinch-hitter and had a single later in the game.
- In the ninth inning with the Tigers trailing 8-5, he blasted a 446-foot grand slam with two outs to give Clemson a 9-8 walkoff victory.
- It was his first career homer in his 12th career game and second year at Clemson. It was also the third walkoff grand slam in Tiger history.
- He is hitting .422 with 10 homers, a triple, 14 doubles, 46 RBIs, 32 runs and a .466 on-base percentage in 36 games (32 starts) in 2023.
- He has a team-high .781 slugging percentage.
- He has a team-high 26 two-out RBIs among his 46 RBIs.
- He played only one of the first 12 games in 2023 and did not make his first start until March 11, Clemson's 15th game of the season.
- He went 3-for-4 with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs in Clemson's 8-1 win at Georgia on April 11.
- He went 3-for-4 with two doubles, including the go-ahead, two-out, run-scoring double in the seventh inning against Notre Dame on April 16.
- He went 4-for-5 with two homers, a double and five RBIs in Clemson's 10-2 win at NC State on April 21.
- He has multiple hits in each of the last five games.
- He was named one of nine national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Player-of-the-Week on May 15.
- He was 11-for-20 (.550) with two homers, four doubles, nine RBIs, eight runs and a walk in four road games on the week.
- He was 8-for-14 (.571) with four doubles, a homer, six RBIs and six runs in Clemson's three-game sweep at Virginia Tech from May 12-14.
- In his career, he is hitting .381 with 10 homers, a triple, 14 doubles, 46 RBIs and 33 runs in 45 games (35 starts).
- He has a .694 slugging percentage and .424 on-base percentage in his career.

AMMONS RETURNS

- Junior lefthander Ryan Ammons was Clemson's closer in 2022 and moved into the rotation early in 2023, but suffered an injury in February.
- He missed almost two months, but made his return to the mound against Georgia on April 18 out of the bullpen, where he has settled.
- He is 1-0 with four saves, a 3.94 ERA and .203 opponents' batting average in 16.0 innings pitched over eight appearances (two starts).
- He has 21 strikeouts against only three walks, good for a 7.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- He is holding opponents to an .053 batting average with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal.
- In 5.0 innings pitched in each of his two starts in 2023, he struck out nine and 10, respectively.
- He recorded two saves in Clemson's three-game sweep of No. 22 Louisville from May 5-7.
- In his career, he is 2-2 with 12 saves, a 4.34 ERA, .205 opponents' batting average and 70 strikeouts in 47.2 innings pitched (42 outings).

BERTRAM ADDING LEADERSHIP

- Senior Riley Bertram transferred to Clemson after four years at Michigan, including one (2019) when he played in the College World Series.
- He has been the everyday starter at second base in the 2023 season and has been one of the team's best leaders.
- The switch-hitter is batting .271 with nine doubles, 34 RBIs, 32 runs, a .390 on-base percentage and 11 steals in 53 games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .974 fielding percentage, committing only six errors.
- He is hitting .316 with a .429 on-base percentage and six steals in 27 ACC regular-season games.
- He is 21-for-53 (.396) with a .492 on-base percentage and five steals in the last 14 games.
- He was 6-for-10 with six RBIs, four runs, five walks and a .733 on-base percentage in the three-game sweep at Virginia Tech from May 12-14.

BLACKWELL GLAD HE RETURNED

- Senior infielder Benjamin Blackwell decided late in the process last summer to return for his fifth collegiate season in 2023.
- The Tigers are glad he did, and he is putting up solid numbers along the way, including a team-tying-high 21 stolen bases.
- He is hitting .308 with nine doubles, two triples, two homers, 30 RBIs, 31 runs and a .399 on-base percentage in 53 games in 2023.
- He has 18 multiple-hit games.
- He is one of two Tigers to play and start every game in 2023.
- He has a .969 fielding percentage as Clemson's starting shortstop, committing only six errors.
- His .969 fielding percentage is third highest in a season by a Tiger shortstop in history.
- In his two-year Tiger career, he is hitting .318 with 19 doubles, three triples, five homers, 63 RBIs, 83 runs and 25 steals in 111 games.
- He has started all 111 games at shortstop the last two seasons for the Tigers.
- He has committed only 17 errors in his two seasons at Clemson, good for a solid .959 fielding percentage.

CANNARELLA EMERGING AS FRESHMAN

- Cam Cannarella has stepped right in to become the everyday starter in center field and has shown consistency as a freshman in 2023.
- He is hitting .388 with 13 doubles, a triple, five homers, 37 RBIs, 62 runs, a .455 on-base percentage and 21 steals in 50 games.
- He leads or is tied for the team lead in runs, hits (83), multiple-hit games (25), total bases (113) and steals.
- He has five three-hit games, three four-hit games and two five-hit games.
- He is hitting .384 with runners on base and .426 with two outs.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 48 of his 50 games.
- He started his college career on a 14-game hitting streak and reached base via a hit or walk in his first 30 games.
- He won the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina three-game series from March 3-5, as he was 6-for-13 with three doubles.
- He went 5-for-6 with four runs in Clemson's 9-8 walkoff win over Georgia State on March 10.
- He joined Cooper Ingle, who also had five hits in the game, as the first Tigers with five hits in a game since 2012.
- Cannarella and Ingle became the first Tiger duo with five hits apiece in a game since 1982.
- He went 5-for-6 with two doubles, two RBIs and three runs in the 14-9 win over Duke in the second game of a doubleheader on March 18.
- He hit a three-run walkoff homer to lift Clemson to an 8-5 win over Winthrop on March 21.

CLAYTON A NEW PITCHER FROM SIDE

- Junior righty Nick Clayton changed his arm slot to the side prior to the season, and it has paid dividends.
- He is 6-0 with a 2.97 ERA, .194 opponents' batting average and 43 strikeouts against 19 walks in 39.1 innings pitched over 19 appearances.
- He has only allowed five extra-base hits thanks in large part to 54 groundball outs compared to 15 flyball outs.
- He is holding opponents to .127 with runners on base and .116 with runners in scoring position.
- He has only allowed five of 21 inherited baserunners to score.
- He pitched 3.0 perfect innings in relief with four strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 8-5 walkoff victory over Winthrop on March 21.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball to earn the win in Clemson's 9-8 victory at Virginia Tech on May 13.
- In his career, he is 13-3 with a save, 3.99 ERA, .239 opponents' batting average and 114 strikeouts in 117.1 innings pitched (55 outings).

DARDEN A TIGER WINNER

- Freshman lefthander Ethan Darden was a reliever and spot starter in the first half of the season, but he has emerged as a weekend starter.
- He is 3-2 with a 5.44 ERA, .267 opponents' batting average and 37 strikeouts in 48.0 innings pitched over 16 outings (10 starts) in 2023.
- He has 75 groundball outs compared to only 25 flyball outs.
- Clemson has a 9-1 record in his 10 starts.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball to earn the win in his first career ACC start at Florida State on April 7.
- He allowed just one run and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at NC State on April 21.

GARRIS GARNERING ATTENTION

- Sophomore Reed Garris was a catcher as a freshman in 2022, but has emerged as a dependable reliever in 2023.
- He is 4-0 with a 2.10 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts against 10 walks in 25.2 innings pitched in 2023.
- He leads the team in appearances (22).
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He is holding opponents to .174 with runners on base and .171 with runners in scoring position.

GORDON PROVIDING STARTS

- Sophomore righthander Austin Gordon has been a weekend starter all season and has provided consistency on the mound.
- He is 1-4 with a 4.72 ERA, .245 opponents' batting average and 62 strikeouts against 16 walks in 68.2 innings pitched over 13 starts.
- A total of 24 of his 38 runs allowed have come on the 16 home runs he has surrendered.
- He is holding opponents to .123 with two outs.
- He is 1-4 with a 4.14 ERA, .225 opponents' batting average and 48 strikeouts against 14 walks in 50.0 innings pitched over nine ACC starts.
- He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with five strikeouts in Clemson's 4-3 win over No. 22 Louisville on May 6.
- In his career, he is 2-4 with two saves, a 4.84 ERA and 93 strikeouts against 25 walks in 96.2 innings pitched over 30 outings (13 starts).

GRICE TWO-WAY PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Caden Grice is contributing as both a lefthander on the mound and slugger at the plate in 2023.
- He was named one of 12 semifinalists for the John Olerud Two-Way Player-of-the-Year Award.
- He is 6-1 with a 3.60 ERA .204 opponents' batting average and 73 strikeouts in 55.0 innings pitched over 11 starts on the mound in 2023.
- Clemson has a 9-2 record in his 11 starts on the mound.
- He is holding opponents to .188 with runners on base, .204 with runners in scoring position and .167 with two outs.
- He is hitting .293 with 12 homers, a triple, 12 doubles, 49 RBIs, 46 runs and three steals in 49 games (48 starts) batting in 2023.
- He has a .565 slugging percentage and .406 on-base percentage.
- He is only the third Tiger in history with 10+ homers and 5+ wins in a season, joining Jarrod Schmidt (2001) and Kris Harvey (2005).
- He has 24 two-out RBIs among his team-high 49 RBIs.
- He has hit all 12 of his homers in the last 35 games.
- He has 11 multiple-RBI games, including two three-RBI games, three four-RBI games and two five-RBI games.
- He is 5-for-10 (.500) with two grand slams, 18 RBIs, a 1.100 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage with the bases loaded in 2023.
- He is hitting .307 with eight homers, seven doubles, 32 RBIs, a .614 slugging percentage and .415 on-base percentage in 27 ACC games.
- He was named one of 11 national players-of-the-week by Collegiate Baseball and ACC Co-Player-of-the-Week on March 27.
- In five games, he totaled four homers and 11 RBIs, and he also earned the win on the mound at Georgia Tech on March 26.

- In his career, he is 8-2 with a 4.06 ERA, .212 opponents' batting average and 94 strikeouts in 71.0 innings pitched over 23 appearances.

- Junior righthander transferred to Clemson after Furman canceled its program following the 2020 season.

- He has one save, a 1.64 ERA, .194 opponents' batting average and 14 strikeouts in 11.0 innings pitched over eight relief outings.
- He has not allowed a homer.
- He has not allowed any of his five inherited baserunners to score.
- In his two active seasons at Clemson, he is 1-0 with one save, a 3.41 ERA and .214 opponents' batting average in 34.1 innings pitched.
- He has 37 strikeouts against 14 walks in 25 appearances (one start) as a Tiger.

INGLE NOT JUST A SINGLES HITTER

- He has 28 strikeouts against 10 walks.

- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2021.
- White, who hit .275 with 104 runs and 36 steals at Clemson from 2014-16, made his MLB debut with the Texas Rangers on Sept. 1, 2020.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2020 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 68 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 50 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
