HILL DOOLEY, UNC-Clemson ran inside, outside and they threw on us. They did anything they wanted to do. Our defense was terrible.

We did mome back to battle them offensively in the second half, but you can't do much about it when you give up a gir big lead like that. I congratulate Coach Perker and his Clemson team. They did an excellent job of preparation and they executed very well.

I don't want to try to take anything my away from the Clemson team, but the crowd noise then we were calling signals was terrible. That should be a five-yard penalty against the home team. It is the responsibility of the home team to control that. Our players couldn't hear the signals and that is what we were in motion so much. We wound up getting the five-yard kommandate players applicant penalty when it should have been stepped off against Clemson. Other teams who have played here have had mimilar problems. I told the referee about it before the game, again in the first quarter, in the second quarter and at the half. I was still in talling him late in the game, but he didn't do anything about it. RED PARKER, CHENSON-It was a great offensive show and I think North Caroline has a great offense, truly outstanding, one of the g best we've ever gone up against. I admire them and they did a fantastic offensive job. And ke I'd be telling you a flat out lie if I didn't tell you that we were better.
