COACHES QUOTES

Coach Red Parker of Clemson: I thought we played a good running game defense, but I was disappointed with our pass rush at times. Marty had too much time to throw and we almost went into a prevent defense too quick. Everything considered, I was fairly well satisfied.

We blew so dang many scoring opportunities. I believe we had four good drives hurt by penalties. We failed to score once when one of our receivers failed to pick up the signal and stayed in and blocked when he should have been the only receiver out.

I'd like to commend Marty Crosby on a fine throwing job. I can't say enough for him. He just did an outstanding job. I tried to see Andrew Johnson--he's a complete football player -- boy is he tough.

Steve Fuller hurt his shoulder in the second quarter and couldn't play anymore. If he's hurt, then he's our only injury.

We didn't move the ball on short yardage situations, but guess that comes from being a young team. We can correct that. I bet we're the youngest team in the United States today. But I'm right proud of them.

The defense got better as the day went along. We made some adjustment at halftime and overplayed the pitch and play action pass. You see, we didn't know what to expect from the Citadel. We hadn't seen them, so we were expecting almost anything.

Coach Bobby Ross of The Citadel: It was a very hard game and our kids played with their hearts. We don't have a thing to be ashamed of. We just made one ~~major~~ mistake too many.

Their score right before halftime took some momentum away from us. We thought we could move the ball on them and get it in even on that last drive.

There were two turning points...when we fumbled before halftime and they came back to score and when we fumbled late in the game. Both times I thought we were on the way to putting points on the board.

Our goal line stand was the finest I've ever been associated with. They had three downs to make a yard and they ~~didn't~~ didn't make an inch. I can't ask for any more effort than we get today.

Ball placement didn't beat us but I thought there were several times a Clemson ball carrier's knee went down behind where the officials put the ball. ~~Mr~~ Clemson ~~stopped~~ stopped us on a power play on fourth down but on third down I thought our quarterback easily sneaked for a yard and the first down. But the officials placed the ball behind him.

I'm pleased with Marty Crosby. We had some turnovers but if we can get them corrected, we could have a pretty good team. I'm not discouraged.
