

## TODAY'S WEATHER

### Special Climatological Event....

It was 13 years ago, but not on this date. The date was October 12, 1963. Georgia came to Death Valley. At the 2 p.m. kick off, the skies were blue. Only a few ~~the~~ lazy cumulus clouds floated above. In the far distance, a towering thunderhead was noted. Its anvil top poked over the horizon just before the half ended. Frank Howard Field was pelted by hail and more hail. The thunder and hail storm lasted 40 minutes. The .95 inches of rain that fell was the only rainfall during the entire month of October, 1963, to occur in Clemson.

The final score: Clemson 7, Georgia 7 -- the last tie game in Memorial Stadium. And that's the way it was 13 years ago.

### GEORGIA COACH VINCE DOOLEY

"I thought we played a good football game today. In fact I told the team it was a job well done. We did have a shutout and those are rare these days. I guess you could say we silenced the crowd."

### CLEMSON COACH RED PARKER
