BO REIN, N.C. State: "It was another great one for the fans. A great game to win, a tough one to lose. The game boiled down to one play. A kid took a chance and made a heckuva play. It was the ball game (the punt return). I can't say enough for our defense. We played offense after we x scored for the offense, figuring field position would be the key. But it backfired on us with the punt return.

"Clemson has an excellent defense. I'd maxim have to say the strength of their team is in their defense. (Were the interceptions devastating?) They sure didn't help us any. When you have to throw, those things happen. (On the personal foul) You really want to know? I'd rather not telk about the officiating. Well, it was for swearing. The official said: 'It's heen a clean, hard-fought game, but your guy got up and swore.' But that didn't affect the outcome of the ball game. We got the ball back after that.

"Clemson has a fine team. We congratulate them and coach Pell."

CHARLEY PELL, Clemson: The closeness of the game is what we expected. I was very proud of our defense as it has continued to play and improve with each week. I'm going to have to give a little more credit to that defense because they did a super job today. They have to be our herces.
