COACHES" STATEMENTS

Coach Danny Ford of Clemson: A km immediate lot of credit has got to go to Virginia Tech. In make the past, they've come in and knocked out heads off, but we won. This time, they did the same thing. But while we waiting for something bad to happen happen to Virginia Tech that would be something good for us. But that never came about.

We're disappointed that we put a football team out **kkdx**x there that didn't do any better than it did. Fundamentally, in the things we tried to do, I'm not sure we got that accomplished in our pre-game work.

We give up seven easy points on a blocked punt which is a no-no, and we put a lot of time on the punting team. We go out there in the first five minutes of the third -quarter and we're not ready to play. We just were not ready to play and they took the ball and scored on us and we're 10 down.

Our offensively team looked like what they were doing at times, and that we could be decent as a football team.

Defensively, we never pressured the quarterback--think we sacked him twice--but we have had some people hurt and we hadn't been tested deep, and we haven't had a lot speed there, and they jumped on it right quick and found a weakness in our pass coverage. Either we're trying to do too much or it's too complicated. We'll leget that straightened out and we'll get out pass rush istraightened out. We were pretty good defensively against the run sometimes and sometimes we weren't.

We had to burn a time out because of 12 men on the field and that's poor coaching and poor organization:

COACH BILL DOOLEY OF VIRGINIA TECH:I couldn't be prouder of this football team for the gutty performance it gave here tiday. I'm especially proud in view of the fact that we lost an extremely **xweek** tough game to Cincinnati last week.

We've lost some real close ones to Clemson in recent years--some games that I felt we should have one. But I don't believe in jinxes. I told my players that if you get after people, those close games are going to start coming your way. That's what happened XXXXX today.

Erik Chapman did a terrific job at quarterback and I thought our receivers, EXE especially Steve Johnson, David Everett and Myron Richardson did a good job of catching the ball. We planned to throw a lot in this game. We had to do that to keep Clemson off balance. Clemson iss such a big, physical team. You can't just line up and run at them.

Our defense would bend out there, but it didn't really break except once in the game. A short punt set up one Clemson score and Clemson really only sustained a drive on us once. There were a lot of solid performances on defense. Agemy was around the ball all day, Vic Jones and Curtis Taliaferro also played extreme; y well.

We've got to build on this one and I think we can go on to have a good season. Clemson will come back.yes You can bet on that. Coach Ford and a-1 of his assistants do a great job.
