Duke head coach Steve Sloan:

I want to congratulate Clemson on winning the game. They did a really good job. They did a lot of things that I thought were real smart alignment wise. They've got a really good team. They should have an excellent year. They are someone who will have to be contended with.

Our biggest disappointment was that we could not run the ball. We seem to have trouble against the real top teams running the ball and when we can't run the ball it puts too much pressure on our passing game because we don't have enough speed to make a lot of really big plays in the passing game.

Offensively we were really poor. We couldn't pass protect well early, we couldn't run block at all during the course of the game, and of course we're going to continue to work on these things, but that's our biggest weakness. When we play a really good team, we can't run the ball.

Clemson's front people did a great job. Their backside ends played well against us. They have a lot of speed in their secondary and were able to run up and play us man (to man) and we couldn't get away from them.

Defensively I thought we played real hard. Had we been able to score some points we could have reinforced our defensive play and kept the score a little better than it ended up. We've got to continue to try to figure out a way to be successful against these top personnel teams with some type of running attack.

Steve Slayden:

They were putting a lot of pressure on me, and when you don't establish any kind of running game they are able to tee off on you. That's all they did the whole game and they did a good job of it.

We had to use the short pass as a run, get five yards on first down. We couldn't run over them.

Mike Junkin:

They are very deep. They keep coming at you physically. We just got worn down. They were very good at getting to the small cutback lanes, which is all their backs needed. We're not being very consistent. We're giving up four or five yards a clip and making the tackles instead of making tackles at the line of scrimmage.

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: This was a very good homecoming win for us. I thought that the defense played very hard. In fairness to Duke, they played hard against us, but they have a lot of young offensive linemen up there. Some of our older guys had the advantage on them in depth, age and experience. We went through that last year.

I thought Duke's defense was very, very good against us. We weren't very crisp offensively because of penalties, especially on the corners, where clips and everything hurt us, and in a tighter football game, that wouldn't have been too good. It's something we've got to work out. We've had it two weeks in a row now.

We bragged on our kicking team too much. Duke looked like we had been looking. Our kickoff coverage looked awful today. We got a little bit better in the second half, but still we can't regress like we did.

Defensively, we had 14 sacks (tackles for losses), one away from the school record and we're real happy about that. Our secondary kept everything in front of them very well, our underneath coverage was good, we broke on the ball real well and we had some real big hits, and some good one-on-one tackles. But in some parts of the game, it looked like we were getting ready to go look at the homecoming floats.

We're thankful and gratefully that we came out of the football game probably injury free. That and the fact that we won. And we were real happy for our second team who came in and push a score across. That was a big plus for us because so far they have been able to play that much, and as much as they need to play. That was a big confidence builder for our second team.

POST GAME NOTES

- The Duke seniors have never defeated the Tigers. Clemson has won the last six meetings.
- Kicker Treadwell has now hit on 45 consecutive extra points throughout his career.
- Raymond Chavous played for the first time since the Georgia Tech game due to his ankle injury.
- Michael Dean Perry had three tackles for loss placing him 4th on the Career tackle for loss list behind ~~fourth on the list with 20~~ Jim Stuckey. Perry has 30 for his career.
- Roulhac's reception in the first quarter was his first in three games.
- Duke's Doug Peterson continued his perfect streak from 40 yards by hitting a field goal. He now is 6-6 when inside of 40 yards.
- The TD return by Hall on the interception was the first defensive touchdown this season for the Tigers. Hall's TD return of 67 yards places him 10th on the Longest Clemson Interception Return list. He knocks out Willie Underwood's interception return of 64 yards in the 1980 win over South Carolina.
- With Kenny Flowers' run of 12 yards in the third quarter, it placed him first on the all-time rushing list in Clemson history. He leads the list with 2585 yards. He broke the record of Buddy Gore which was set in his career which took place from 1966-68. Gore gained 2571 during his career.
