COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: Coach Ford apologized to the team in the dressing room for not having them ready to play, but told them they would start at 3 o'clock Sunday to correct the mistakes and get ready to play next Saturday (Wake Forest).

North Carolina State played a very fine football game against us. The played a lot better than we did and deserved to win the f game. They did a very good job and you have to commend their players and their coaches. And it wasn't an accident. They made big plays and they stopped our running attack.

Defensively, it was a big, big game for them. They did a very fine job against our offensive football team. They just made the big play and we didn't.

Our problems today happened Thursday. We weren't ready to play when we got here. We didn't have the kind of practice we needed to have last week. We lost the football game a long time before we got up here, but we'll get that straightened out. After playing like this, it makes you want to go back and look at yourself very vlosely.

COACH DICK SHERIDAN OF NORTH CAROLINA STATE: "This was, without question, the best effort we've had this year. We played very well offensively and defensively for two halves for the first time. When you consider all the aspects, it was definitely our finest game.

We felt that the best way to play Clemson was to try and establish the running game. You never know whether or not you can do something until you try it. Our offensive line did a great job, and that was a big key.

We've unfortunately had a lot of injuries this year, but this team has done a tremendous job of responding to that adversity. We've had some very good players on the sidelines that last couple of weeks, and everyone has worked to overcome that.

This is one of the best defensive games I've had a team play. The whole group just did an exceptional job all game.

WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE ACC TITLE & POST-SEASON PLAY: "We've been talking about the ACC championship since January. That's always been our goal, and our goals haven't changed. Right now we're concerned about bowl bids, we're concerned about South Carolina. We're going to be tested again next week, and then we've got two conference games to worry about.
