COACHES' QUOTES. CLEMSON 43, WESTERN 0.

WESTERN CAROLINA COACH BOB WATERS:

"That is what hurt us, the kicking game and special teams coverage. It took us out of any chance we had of winning the football game. I'd like to think that Clemson was pretty good at running back punts and blocking, but our coverage and blocking was pretty dissapointing to me.

"(Quarterback) Todd (Cottrell) didn't have a bad day, and he didn't really have a good day. No one on offense did. Defensively I thought we made a stand and kept at it.

"Clemson's a great football team. They're an excellent team with very good players. I was more impressed with them than I was dissapointed with our team. I'm not sure we put them to any test that showed a weakness on their part.

"The way we played, if we had been in a Southern Conference game; we would not have fared very well, not with a kicking game like that. It was just lousy. . . .

"Todd certainly didn't look like Superman out there, but to judge him by this one game I think would be unfair to him. I still think he's going to be a pretty good quarterback.

"(Kicker) Kirk (Roach) didn't come close on his field goals, but he will.

"It was just one of those days -- embarrassing. But we'll get better. We have a tough road to go, 10 more games to go. It wasn't the way we wanted to play. We are certainly not close to being a good offensive football team yet."

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD:

We played very well, both mentally and physically. I thought our coaching staff had the team well prepared for the game, and really, I can't find too many things to fuss about.

I thought our kicking game went very well. We created some turnovers and then got a couple of good punt returns and blocked one. And we were able to move the ball on several occasions, but Western created some problems for us on third down situations.

I'm happy for the defense in getting themselves a shutout. It's been a pretty good while since we had one of them (actually last year against The Citadel was the last shutout for the Tigers 10 games ago). We didn't have to struggle too much. And I think a big difference was that they came in here with a (true) freshman quarterback and fullback against a seasoned defense. We kinda outmanned them.

We had too many penalties in the second half, but I think we can correct that. WCU made it tough on our offense. But I thought our tailbacks -- all three of them -- ran well and held onto the ball despite the weather. We went away from the option early because of the weather.

POST GAME NOTES

- ***Clemson is now 4-0 in the series with Western Carolina. This marked the first time that Western Carolina has not scored exactly ten points against Clemson.
- ***Clemson has now won 24 straight games against Southern Conference schools and has not lost at home to a school currently in the Southern Conference since 1936. Clemson has never lost to a current Southern Conference school in Death Valley.
- ***This was the first home opener Clemson had won since 1984.
- ***Today's attendance of 72,000 is the largest crowd to witness a Western Carolina football game.
- ***Michael Dean Perry's one-and-a-half sacks today moves him into seventh place on the All-Time ACC Sack List. He now has 17.5 in his career.
- ***Perry's three tackles for loss today moves him into fourth place on the ACC Career Tackles For Loss list. Perry now has 40 career tackles for loss.
- ***Rodney Williams complete 9 of 12 passes today for a .750 percentage. This ties him for his best completion ratio in his career. Williams also hit 9 of 12 receivers last year against North Carolina.
- ***Clemson's 155 yards in punt returns today was the second most in school history for a single game. Clemson had more punt return yardage today than the 1983 and 1985 teams respectively.
- ***Both James Lott and Donnell Woolford had career highs for punt return yardage. Lott had a 41-yard return while Woolford had a 45-yard return.
- ***Clemson's blocked punt by Jesse Hatcher was the first blocked punt by a Tiger since the N.C. State game in 1986.
