GAME NOTES
CLEMSON vs. VIRGINIA
October 10, 1987

Durwin Greggs' 2 yard run in the third quarter for Virginia was the first points Clemson has given up in the third period all year.

James Lott's interception in the fourth quarter was his first of the season. It is the second of his career.

Terry Allen's 183 yards on 27 carries and Wesley McFadden's 119 yards on 18 carries marked the first time two Clemson backs had gone over 100 yards in the same game since the Wake Forest game in 1985. Kenny Flowers and Stacey Driver pulled the double in that game as well as against Virginia earlier that same year.

The two-yard touchdown catch by Virginia's Bruce McGonnigal in the first quarter was his first career TD catch.

John Ford's catch of 54 yards was the 21st catch in his career over 50 yards.

This is the third largest crowd to ever see Virginia play. (Today's announced crowd was 80,500).

This is largest crowd to ever see Clemson and Virginia play.

John Ford became UVa's all-time leader in yards receiving. Ford now has 1,571 yards in his career moving him past Dave Sullivan who had 1,568 yards when he played during '70-'72. Ford now has caught passes for more than 100 yards in four games in his career, a Virginia record.

With Scott Secules passing for 202 yards today, that marks the 6th time in his career he has gone over the 200 yard mark. He is now tied for second on the Cavalier career list behind Scott Gardner ('73-'75) with seven.

Clemson has now defeated Virginia 27 straight times in the series. This is the longest current winning streak of one team over another in NCAA Division I.

Danny Ford is now 5-1 after an open date.

Clemson now has an unbeaten streak of nine games. The Tigers' record during the streak is 7-0-2.

Rodney Williams' 82 yards passing today gives him 2,517 for his career which moves him ahead of Bobby Gage (2,448 from '45-'48).

Terry Allen's 183 yards is the most ever by a freshman in a single game. O.d record was 124 by Kenny Flowers against Georgia Tech in 1983.

Clemson's record at Homecoming record over the last 17 years is now 16-0-1. The overall mark is 45-15-2. Clemson is 8-0 over Virginia when the Cavaliers were the Homecoming opponent.

Clemson tailbacks rushed for 331 yards today, the second-highest total in Clemson history. Clemson had 347 rushing yards from the tailback position against Duke in 1982.

Clemson is now 24-1 against the four teams it plays in October over the last six years.

University of Virginia head coach George Welsh:

I didn't see anything different (about Clemson's defense) than they had done. I don't know if they got better in a couple of weeks or if we've slipped a little bit. It was not a real good performance, we had some bad lapses.

(against Clemson's defense) It's very difficult to be consistent. You have to go in and score like we scored, big plays. That'll get you close any way.

I think we did alright on offense. I wish we could have got in the fourth quarter. It's hard to think you can score 30 (points) on them.

When you play them, the game changes, like when you're playing Duke and VMI. It's a different tempo on the run, better backs, quicker, stronger offensive line, so it's hard to practice against it. It's the same old story for us, we've had troubles with them.

I think we did some good things on offense, I hope we can keep it going. We need to regroup on defense and play better defense.

That's a big-league defense, I can't expect too much more. You're not going to be consistent against them, nobody has and I doubt if anybody will. Maybe there's somebody along the way that's going to be a better offensive football team than us. We did some things good. Another touchdown, you never know.

I've yet to see Clemson not play well against us, not since I've been here.

You're not just going to score two touchdowns every quarter on Clemson.

Coach Danny Ford of Clemson: We're delighted to have won the game. Virginia is an excellent offensive team, by far the best one we've faced (this year). Course, we knew that going in. And we had a hard time getting that across to our people, because I don't think we played too well defensively. We just played very, very average. It didn't look like the defensive team I have seen for the last four weeks.

But you have to say that Virginia had something to do with this. They had a great game plan, and executed properly. We tried to tell everyone that Secules is a very outstanding quarterback.

The Ford youngster--the wide receiver--I never have believed he could catch rabbits, but I'm about to become a believer that he can catch rabbits because he can fly. He just went past us like we were standing on a muddy field at times.

The improvement we made in the open week didn't look like it was with the defensive team. I thought that our offense improved. Again, we're not the real, real sharp football team for us in our opinion. But they were able to overcome a sloppy game at times, execution-wise by us defensively, and win the football game. So I guess you have to have some of those sometimes when you can win despite yourselves.

We have a lot of improvement to do. We still have got to get some people well. But we just weren't hitting on all eight cylinders. But I have a lot of respect for Virginia. We didn't get to Secules. He does a good job, a lot of it by himself getting back and getting rid of the ball.

But to sum it up, I think the defense went backwards during the last two weeks and the offense made a marked improvement.
