### GAME NOTES

- \*Clemson's streak of undefeated games ended at 11 games. The Tigers last loss was to North Carolina State in 1986.
- \*Michael Dean Perry became the ACC's Career Sack Leader against the Wolfpack. His two sacks brought his total to 26, breaking his brother William's record of 24. He is also third on the ACC's Career Tackle-for-loss list with 55. He needs 5.5 to break William's record in this department.
- \*Clemson's first first down came with 2:17 remaining in the first half.
- \*The 30 points NCSU scored in the first half is the most Clemson has allowed since Maryland's 31 points in 1984.
- \*NC States 30 points during the first half was the most given up in a single half by a Danny Ford coached team since N.C. State scored 24 points against the Tigers in 1984 in the first half.
- \*The 30-0 score is the largest deficit Clemson has faced since the Clemson-Georgia Tech game in 1984. In that game, Tech led the Tigers 21-0 at the half.
- \*This is the first time that N.C.State has won back-to-back games with Clemson since the 1979 and 80 seasons.
- \*This is the fourth time that Clemson has lost their seventh game after beginning the season 6-0, dating back to 1900.
- \*Rodney Williams' 54 pass attempts is a new record for the most attempts in a game at Clemson. His 21 completions was a personal best.
- \*Clemson's 100 rushing yards was the second lowest rushing total by a Danny Ford coached team. The lowest was against Baylor at the 1979 Peach Bowl (97 yards).
- \*Rodney Williams' 271 yards passing was the third highest in Clemson history.

## COACHES QUOTES

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON:I'm very disappointed in the fact that we lost, but I thought the team did a tremendous job in the second half. I'm very proud of our football team the way it came back. Being 30 points behind .. don't know if we've ever been in a situation like that before.

We got behind and tried our darndest to come back. Getting 28 points like we did is certainly a tribute to the team. Guess we just come unglued in the first half...no particular reason...we don't have an excuse. It's just a situation that just happened that we didn't perform very well.

It was a great try the second half which I was happy to see that our youngsters hung in there because we're not a throwing team very much. It came down to a fourth and five. We were hoping we could get to a field goal and couldn't quite do it. But that's the way the football went. We just didn't do what we should have done or I didn't have them ready to participate in the first half

We've got another tough week coming up and we'll have to get them off the ground. I think we'll see a lot of good things in the film as well as some bad ones.

I thought our sideline did a terrific job during the second half. They were really in the game.

COACH DICK SHERIDAN OF N. C. STATE: "It was like two differnt ball games out there. But we can't be too worried about how it happened. We won. It wasn't pretty. We had to fight and claw and scratch to stay alive. EXt that doesn't batter. We're just going to try and enjoy this.

"We did get more conservative in the second half. We were running the same plays that were successfual un the first half. We just didn't stay on the blocks as well. They were running the same defense, but they did a better job.

"We got just a super effort from our defense in the first half. We had to in order to shut out a team as potent as this in the first 30 minutes.

"On our kickoffs, we decided to give up a couple more yards by kicking it short, but we didn't want them to break one open. Our kicking teams did a fine job, except for the one punt return. Oserall all of our people followed the game plan very well."
