GAME NOTES

*When Chris Morocco started at quarterback in place of Rodney Williams today, it marked the first time in 27 games that Williams did not start. The last contest he did not start was the 1985 Kentucky game.

*Donnell Woolford's 67 yard punt return for a touchdown was the second time this season has reached paydirt with a punt return. His other return for a touchdown was against Georgia Tech.

*When Chris Morocco was sacked today in the second quarter, it marked the first time that the Tigers had given up a sack this season. Williams was also sacked in the second half. The last sack that Clemson gave up was against USC in 1986.

*Clemson is now 13-1 in orange pants,

*Clemson broke the school's all-time mark for total attendance in a season with today's game. A total of 536,042 fans have witnessed the Tigers in Death Valley in 1987. The previous high was 521,898 over seven games in 1983.

*With his two tackles for loss today, Michael Dean Perry is now tied for second place on the ACC career tackles-for-loss list. Perry is tied with William Fuller of UNC. They both have 57 tackles for loss.

*Henderson's 131 yards rushing is a career high. He had just 121 rushing yards coming into the game for the season. Against Wake Forest he had two touchdown runs of 31 and 48 yards. He also had 115 second half yards. Last year against Wake Forest, Terrence Flagler set a school record with 274 yards in all purpose running.

WAKE FOREST COACH BILL DOOLEY

"We're disappointed that we had the opportunity to win the football game against a very good football team, but could not come up with the big plays that it takes to do it. They wore us down, they are big and strong, and they kept pounding at us and finally we just let the flood gates open. We couldn't make the big play when we had it late in the game. We played well early, and then all of a sudden their strength and size just wore us down.

"I'm disappointed, and I know our football players are disappointed because we had a good opportunity against a very good team--Clemson does have a very good football team. They are strong up front, and they really come off the ball--just keep pounding at you, and they made us look like very poor tacklers. We didn't tackle very well at all in the second half. Williams came in and executed the option play very well on that third quarter drive when they took it right down field and scored. We came right back and moved the ball, but couldn't get it in when we had to. I don't like playing close and not getting any cigars.

"Power football is what Clemson does best, and we expected that. The only time that they have thrown the football is when they were down 30-0 to N.C. State. They like to run it, they like to contol it, and they have been very successful in doing so. They had a very good game plan and they executed well.

DEACON NOTES: Clemson's punt return was the first against a Wake team since UNC's Mel Collins did so in 1974.

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD

We feel a lot better now than we did this time last week. I thought our youngsters bounced back real well after being down seven at halftime, then coming back and winning the football game. Hopefully, we can a little better every week. But our wins are very hard to get. We're just thankful that our people was able to win the football game against a Wake Forest team that played very, very well, and got after.

We gave up two long plays in the first half, and that's all right if you can dome back and make it up. One reverse hurt us, and other than that, it wasn't to bad a defensive performance in the first half. They made some very fine plays. They beat us on a down and up, which was a great play call. Then they beat us one time on a route that we had a good shot at covering, but didn't.

It was a big play by Woolford (interception) at halftime. We really would have hated to go in 14 down and he made a great play out of it.

Offensively, it's probably the first time in two weeks that we had to take the football and make good, solid drives and score. We were real pleased with the way we did that. Henderson made two very, very fine run-one really a great run-the first time he scored on a sweep to the left, but he had to have some blocking and our offensive line must have blocked pretty well.

Morocco got a chance to get some playing time early and I thought he did a fairly decent job. Rodney came in the second half--we didn't want to play him, but after Chris had a littel bit of uneasiness right before halftime. We had hoped to come back with him a little earlier in the third quarter, but we're just happy to win.

We have three more tough games left and two of them are on the road. Everybody's going to play Clemson like it's the end of the world.
