POST GAME NOTES
Clemson vs. Duke
October 15, 1988

Today's crowd, estimated at 83,500, is the second largest ever to see a game in Death Valley. There were 84,700 fans at the Clemson-Florida State game (the last home game on September 17) earlier this year.

Quinton McMcCracken's 97 yard kickoff return for a touchdown was the fourth longest in Clemson opponent history.

Rodney Williams became the second Clemson quarterback to pass the 4,000 yard mark in passing yardage. Steve Fuller ended his career with 4,359, and Rodney's total of 663 yards today now gives him 4,015 for his career.

Clemson is now 17-0-1 in Homecoming games since a 44-0 loss to Auburn in 1970. Clemson now leads the series with Duke 20-12-1 overall and 10-4-1 in games played in Death Valley. Duke has been the Homecoming opponent 5 times.

Clemson coach Danny Ford now has the second most wins by an ACC coach with 81. Former coach Frank Howard had 98 wins. Ford's record 81-26-4. Coach Howard had 67 Southern Conference wins, which do not count for his total of 81.

Wide receiver Doug Thomas's 47 yard carry on the reverse was his first varsity play. Tony Kennedy's runs were also his first carries as a Tiger.

Duke quarterback Anthony Dilweg averaged 5.1 yards per attempt today, he came into the game averaging 8.9 yards per attempt. It was also Dilweg's season low in terms of passing yardage, the first time he had under 300 yards in a game all year.

Clemson had season highs today in rushing yards, passing yards and total offense.

The 49 points scored by Clemson were the most by the Tigers since a 54-21 homecoming win over Duke in 1984.

DeChane Cameron's 79-yard touchdown pass tied for the eighth longest in Clemson history. It was the longest by a Tiger since an 81-yard TD pass from Billy Lott to Perry Tuttle in 1979 against Furman. It was also the first pass completion of Cameron's career and the longest reception of Gary Cooper's career.

POST GAME QUOTES
DUKE HEAD COACH STEVE SPURRIER

General comments We got whipped on both sides. We did run a kick back though. They just thoroughly beat us about every way you can. But maybe they are just a lot better than us. For us to have a chance to win we had to hit a lot of passes. I don't know how big any one play was.

I told the team to be realistic about the loss. I hope the teams we play from here on out are not quite as big or as strong as Clemson was today. Hopefully we can line up better. It was only one loss today - not two or three. We still have a chance for an excellent season. We should be very healthy for next week as we had no injuries today.

(on ineffective passing game) We didn't throw and catch today as well as we can and their pass rush was tremendous.

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON

We looked like the team we should be this afternoon, but they had to do it because we beat a good football team. Our youngsters for the most part, did very well. I thought our coaches prepared the team very well for the task at hand. I'm happy for our team.

I think during the week, the team decided to accept the challenge we had given them. We had a let down on that kickoff return and they got the momentum on their side, but that was a fine kickoff return and I don't want to take anything away from the youngster because he went right up through us.

I thought the turning point was when the defense got that fumble, and we were able to open the lead up again. But Duke is dangerous at anytime from any place on the field and I don't think you can ever rest and say you have enough points.

We made some good adjustments at halftime on the pass coverage and it helped us out in the second half. I thought our offensive team had some good drives. Our defense didn't have as many sacks as we would have liked, but we were in his face a lot. I think the best thing we did was that our guys were accountable.
