

N.C. STATE vs. CLEMSON COACHES' QUOTES

N.C. State Head Coach Dick Sheridan: "This was a great victory, but there is a down side to it and that's that we may have lost lineback Fred Stone for the season. He suffered a knee injury. I'm proud to accept this textile award for him!

"This was a big hurdle for us to stay alive in the conference race. We beat an outstanding Clemson team.

"It was a great defensive effort on our part. It's hard to believe we held Clemson to only three points and that we haven't allowed a touchdown in our last 16 quarters.

"I believe two of the biggest plays in the game were our last two punts. Preston got good snaps and he was able to knock both punts deep. Those were key plays.

"It was critical that we match their intensity and I believe we did. The crowd was a big factor. They gave us lift in a lot of key situations.

"This isn't a Danny Ford vs. Dick Sheridan game. It's a game matching two teams that have a whole lot of respect for one another. Clemson is without a doubt the program everyone in the ACC tries to measure up too.

"Until we can rush the ball better we're not going to be the kind of team we want to be.

"I certainly didn't expect to keep Clemson from scoring a touchdown. It was just a total team effort."

Clemson Head Coach Danny Ford: "The first thing you have to do is congratulate North Carolina State for winning the football game. I thought our football team played very well. Critical mistakes in our kicking game --we missed two field goals that were makeable, but I'm in charge of the kicking game so that is my fault. The defensive team played really well.

"I'm pleased with our football team defensively. Number one blocking the field goal and getting an opportunity late in the football game and just a lot of things that we did very well in the football game, but they did some things well, too.

"The offensive football team made some errors. We had good field position, super field position given to us by our defensive football team. We had two penalties in the football game that definitely self-destructed when we had a chance to go in.

"You have to give credit to North Carolina State. They stopped us on one short yardage. We pitched the ball outside when we should have taken it inside. That's yet another error by me. They deserve to win the football game. They won it. It was a good football game.

"I thought our players played hard. I have no problem with our football team other than our elimination of mistakes in a big football game. This puts us with one loss in the conference and we'll try to gather our people back up and try to get better execution than we had today and get ready for Wake Forest. There's not much more I can say than that. We've got to get more movement and more execution offensively. Our kicking game has got to improve. We've got to make field goals and get the snap on the fourth down plays."
