WEATHER SUMMARY: Low pressure with its associated frontal system stretching from Texas to Tennessee will move slowly east and north eastward bringing moisture from the Atlantic which will produce some rain in our area this weekend. Most of the system will move north of the upstate. High pressure will move to the Carolinas after the low front moves through and will bring fair and cooler weather to the Carolinas next week.

GAME NOTES

Clemson vs. South Carolina

November 19, 1988

The estimated crowd of 84,500 is the second largest crowd in Clemson history behind the 84,576 at the Florida State game. HOWEVER, once all the tickets are actually counted this week, Clemson Ticket Manager Van Hilderbrand has said the estimate will likely be exceeded and this will indeed be the largest crowd in Clemson history. This is the second-largest road crowd South Carolina has played before. (The top figure was 104,213 at Michigan in 1980)

Clemson WR Keith Jennings has now caught a pass in fifteen consecutive games. He had four receptions for 35 yards today.

Clemson Bandit End Jessie Hatcher caused two fumbles today, which ties a Clemson record for a single game. He is tied with a whole herd of other people who have caused two fumbles.

Clemson quarterback Rodney Williams had his season best day passing, as he was 13-26-191 yards. He hadn't completed ten passes in a game all season. He was 5-38 rushing with one TD, also. Williams added to his totals for career passing yardage--he now has 4,498; career pass attempts---706; and career pass completions--338.

Clemson PK/P Chris Gardocki had his second straight game with three field goals. He has now set the Clemson freshman record for field goals with 17. His 66-yard punt in the third qtr. was the longest of his short career. His previous long was 58 yards against Florida State.

AWARDS The State Fair Association Players of the Game were Rodney Williams for Clemson and Harold Green for USC. The Spartan Foods Lineman (offense or defense) Of the Game awards went to Jessie Hatcher for Clemson and David Taylor for USC.

USC QB Todd Ellis had 141 yards passing today, which means he has passed the 100-yard mark in 33 of his 34 games. He had been averaging 17 completions coming in to today's game and he had just 12 completions today. He had been averaging 208 yards passing per game.

Clemson is now 50-32-4 against USC, 10-4-1 in Death Valley, and 7-3-1 since 1978.

Clemson had to punt for the first time since the fourth quarter of the Wake Forest game on October 29 today. The CU punt came in the second quarter.

USC did not score in the first quarter against Clemson which means that only Maryland was able to put points on the board against the Tiger defense in the first stanza.

Clemson's 1988 TV record is now 4-1. USC is 2-2.

Clemson will average 80,000 people per game this year. This is a new ACC record. This also marks the 12th straight season Clemson had led the league in putting bottoms in the seats.

USC TB Harold Green had 18 carries for 71 yards and that moves him into tenth place on the all-time USC rushing list.

The 50 victories Clemson has over USC is the most victories the Tigers have over any opponent. The 86 games the two teams have played are also the most of any opponent.

Mr. Bradley's consecutive game streak now stands at 367 in a row. USC's Tom Price does hold the edge in Clemson-Carolina games, though, as he has seen the last 42 in a row, while Mr. B. has seen 36 (but not consecutively)

The 15-yard personal foul and disqualification Mr. B. issued Cricket Yates-Stewart for cheering in the Bob Bradley Press Box is the first infraction in the facility's history.

## COACHES QUOTES

Coach Danny Ford of Clemson: First of all, I'd like to congratulate South Carolina on the fine year they have had. They are a quality team and we wish them well in their bowl game.

But we are tickled to death with the outcome today. With the exception of that long pass and being a little tender up front, we did pretty good. We gave up some yardage, but I thought we had control of both sides of the line most of the time. I thought everything we did except our kickoff coverage, was adequate.

The offensive line must have played pretty good because we had several long drives and a couple of them resulted in touchdowns. The unsung hero early in the game was (Wesley) McFadden. He was hitting the hole a little quicker and that helped a good deal. The secondary also had to play well. But their young players caused us to miss a lot of tackles. We were grabbing air lots of times.

But we did what we had to do. We hadn't won at home with South Carolina since 1982. We also had to look for a lot of things, but we weren't surprised that they came out in the run and shoot. We thought they might throw some more stuff at us. They didn't blitz as much as we thought, but they put a lot of pressure on us from the outside.

You've got to give our seniors a lot of credit. They have really given us leadership this season and we're going to miss every one of them.

But we're happy about today's outcome and we're looking forward to going back to Orlando again and playing in the Citrus Bowl. I thought the early turnovers set the pace because you can never tell what would have had them had they not taken place.

Quotes from Joe Morrison: "I told our ball club after the game that we were proud of their effort. They've accomplished a great deal this season with eight wins thus far...Clemson is an excellent football team. They are strong offensively and defensively...I thought the touchdown we scored at the end of the half might give us some momentum. But, we didn't get good field position at all the second half...We had a lot of folks banged up and playing out of position. We need to get these people healthy...We ~~thought~~ thought the run and shoot would give Todd a better opportunity to ~~throw~~ throw the ball, get him on the move and spread the defense out some. We didn't want to throw the ball over the middle and tried to keep the ball outside...We accepted an invitation to go to the Liberty Bowl following the game. We're excited about ~~that~~ that and happy to be going...We're banged and bruised right now and need some rest to get these guys healthy."

Wide Receiver Robert Brooks -- "Until the third period, we thought we could come back and win the ball game. (On his TD catch) I knew that I had the left side on the play. We called my number and I just pinned him inside. I thought we had a lot of momentum then. I'm very excited about going to a bowl game. I'm sad we lost but I'm happy with the bowl bid."

Defensive Lineman Derrick Frazier -- "Clemson had a really good game plan. Rodney is a good quarterback and he did a good job today, especially reading the option and keeping outside. I'm looking forward to the Liberty Bowl and having the chance to win a bowl game."

Quarterback Todd Ellis -- "The run-and-shoot is actually "Bronco" in our pro-set offense. We worked on it a lot in pre-season practice. We knew Clemson could disguise their defensive coverages well, so we just wanted to spread them out with the run-and-shoot. The turnovers just killed us. We knew they wouldn't expect us to come out in the old offense and we wanted to jump on them early. The turnovers took away that edge. They had excellent pass coverages today and were able to get some pressure on me."

Linebacker Matt McKernan -- "They just got rolling out there today and we fell down. We just could never come back. It's exciting to go to a bowl game again. It helps to put the Clemson game behind us -- especially if we win. Though I don't get to play Clemson any more since I'm a senior, I feel we have had (the senior class) good success against them, especially if you look at the overall series record. We feel we've had a good showing against them over the last few years."
