FORD COMMENTS ON 1989 CITRUS BOWL:

Thank you. I guess I heard Coach Switzer talk and I echo everything he said. We had two very fine defensive football teams playing and we were able to get a big drive. We were able to make some key plays in the game. Our youngsters played awfully hard. Oklahoma is a very fine football team, an excellent coached football team, a physical team. We're real proud. We've said all week that we would have an opportunity to gage Clemson football program by playing a quality football team like Oklahoma. So I would have to say we're real proud of our senior leadership, and a group of youngsters who have been an excellent group of senior football players, about 28 of them, walk-ons and everybody that went out there and practiced and performed for five years now, most of them are five-year seniors. We're real pleased and happy for them. They brought great credit to our University today and they've always represented us very well. I've said many times I don't know of a greater group of ambassadors for Clemson University than our football team. I'm very proud of them and what happened in the football game, I don't know. I don't remember. I got cotton mouth when they took that 80-yard drive throwing and I didn't think Oklahoma had a throwing game. And we wanted to get them in a throwing game, but I don't believe we want them in the throwing game anymore because they took it just about 65 or 70 yards with a great break in the pocket by Hollieway. I thought we had him 2 or 3 times, but we couldn't get him down and they slid behind us throwing a long pass, a youngster got hit on the sidelines, I hope he's not hurt very badly. But our youngster slipped down and he made a great catch. They did a great job against us, but our football team also did a great job. So I'm real proud of our coaches for having the game plan they had. I don't know anything else to tell you. Our youngsters could tell you more.

I thought we were going to get him down before he threw it. Naturally you see a lot of bad things happening when the football game is over, which it would have been over. You can see them going for two points and winning the ballgame at the very end. You can see their youngster outjumping our guy and making a great play. I thought Hollieway, I don't want to brag on their people all day, but I thought he did a tremendous job of getting rid of the football in that situation. I thought Rodney Williams did a great job of getting rid of the football right before the end of the half when they had a backside blitz and we threw it away and it was a smart and gutsy call on his part by throwing it away. We got a penalty for intentionally grounding the football and Gardocki came in there and kicked the football. We lost 15 yards on that but he didn't get caught. We had wasted a timeout, both teams wasted a timeout because they weren't properly fitted for the game having hip pads or tailbone pads in their pants so that could have been very costly. There was no excuse for that happening.

We wanted to throw the ball a little bit more than we did. We had it open early in the ballgame and we first of all

... they were open. Their defensive end made a couple of nice plays. We went and tried to run right at them, we couldn't. The next time we were going to try to read them option wise, we couldn't. They were whooping us. I think the heat helped Clemson. I think our preparation was an advantage of going to Clearwater, Florida, and being in a little bit better condition, Maybe, I thought so. Probably a big, big play that he made that we'll remember, he cut it up there for an 11 yard gain on the option. He threw a nice pass to Terry Allen on the sideline. The most disappointing thing for us, we had 3:08 to go in the ballgame, we couldn't get first down. We had a chance to make it not so exciting, but I guess the TV people were glad to see them come back. We weren't so glad to see them come back, but they held the audience on TV pretty good.

Well, the same thing you normally say. We're in good shape at halftime, we're 6-3. There's a lot of pushing and shoving out there. It'd be an awful embarrassment to lose a football game against a great football team by somebody losing their composure and getting a penalty and being thrown out of the football game. Then it'd be bad to keep having jumping offsides. We had 2 offside penalties that really hurt us very badly in the first half. The chop block on Hank Phillips is something we've been doing all year. It's a correct call. I think the officials did an excellent job. It was a correct call, we don't get it very much in our league and I don't think they get it very much in their league, either. We were trying to zone block and he was cutting his feet out from under him. It was nothing that was intentionally done. That was basically what was said, just don't lose your composure, don't beat yourself. Oklahoma is too good to play and give them any kind of situation where they have a chance to beat us. Both teams had major problems on offense first half. Our defense played very well. At halftime I looked up and I thought it was going to be us with no first downs, but they were with 46 yards total offense the first half, added up to 190-something, and we ended up with 260-something. I believe I'm correct. Both defenses played very well in the ball game. Ours played very well. The only thing we did improper, we gave up the big pass. We didn't let them break the big run, and that's what we wanted them to do, run it right at us, take some time off the clock. Make our people stay on the field a little bit with the heat and not to give up anything big. We knew physical conditioning would be the difference in the football game.

Hatcher is a youngster who joined the National Guard when he was 17. He's an excellent worker, he came down here from junior college. We went to California looking for somebody else and found him, and he's from Georgia. He was too little in high school, Most Valuable Player in junior college, and he just continues to get better and better. The bigger the game, the better he plays. He knocked down several passes, kept pressure on the quarterback most of the day. We're very proud of him, we're going to miss Jesse very much. Jesse for two years has come in and been a very, very football player for us. Also, Levon Kirkland played very well for us. Our linebackers played good. We lost Mark Drag early in the

football game. He came back with a bad ankle and tried to play and re-injured it and he couldn't play. Mark Drag and Rodney Williams were voted our team captains this week by our players. I know he wanted to play very well. But it you notice the fumbles they had it was because Mark Drag was doing a very fine job on their center, I believe when they had some miscues with their center he was getting off the ball and getting underneath their stance. I would like to see Mark play a little bit more than that.

A big play early, for momentum if nothing else, we didn't get but 3 points out of it, but it was Wesley McFadden's fullback run early in the game. The lineman kept saying we are going to block them and we kept coming out and three downs and punt and we weren't doing very good, and we needed a big play. We broke a big play with the fullback. The curl route going in on our last score to Hooper, a big throw by Williams to Hooper. Allen's run was a big play. We had several big plays. I thought we had a very well played football game with the exceptions of the penalties. I think we moved the football better then them, but you've got to give credit to Oklahoma. They're a quality team, I don't think we played a better defensive team than them all year.
