Coaches' Quotes

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

"That was just a good whippin'. Clemson's better than I thought they were. I believe they're better than last year. I could be wrong, but I believe it. They looked like they came out with a year of frustration behind 'em. I think they'd heard

enough about the Puntrooski.

"Everytime we would stop the bleeding and climb back in it, Clemson would make a big play and take the momentum back. They played great. I'm very impressed with them. I'm amazed that we couldn't stop them better. We evidently have some kids out of position or something. Their's just something missing. I don't think we're that bad. Our fumble hurt awful bad. We had the momentum and I think at that point, we were back in it. Bur our kids fought hard. Their long run also hurt."

Clemson Head Coach Danny Ford

Coach Ford told his players in the dressing room: "I'm very proud of you for the game you played. You came into a very hostile place and I couldn't have asked any better of you. The third quarter was a little shakey, but we came back and got a score of our own, and then getting the fumble sure help out.

You all did what you had to to do and that is the mark of a great team against some pretty big odds.

The third quarter, with the way we stuck in there after they took the kickoff and went right down the field and scored -- I was very proud of them. We kept everything in front of us and we were pleased about that. We were able to put some heat on the quarterback in the second half -- they are a tremendous offensive football team -- and they kept me scared to death the entire game. We had to have some people play better than they able to and to have some others whip some people and we did a pretty good job of accomplishing that.

When Coach Ford and Coach Bowden met at mid field, Bowden said: "You have a better team than you had last year. You're a lot faster.

When Coach Ford got into the dressing room, he pulled a piece of turf out of his pocket from Doak Walker Field, and Ford said "we'll get a tombstone going tomorrow.

Clemson vs. Florida State Game Notes

Wayne Simmons returned an interception 73 yards in the second quarter to give Clemson a 21-0 lead. That was the longest interception return for a touchdown by a Clemson linebacker in Clemson history. It broke the mark of 68 yards held by teammate Doug Brewster. It tied for eighth longest overall in Clemson history.

Terry Allen had a 73 yard run in the first half and it was the 13th longest run in Clemson history. It was also the longest of Allen's career. It was the ninth 100-yard game of Allen's 24-game career. His 130 yards ranks as his sixth best game, his career high is 183 against Virginia in 1987.

Chris Morocco had a passing efficiency rating of 213.96 for the evening, the best of his career and the best by a Clemson QB since Rodney Williams had a 220 againt Wake Forest in 1986. Morocco is now 16-23 for the season for 233 yards and no interceptions for the season.

Clemson has not had a turnover in two games, covering 134 plays. It marked the sixth time in the last 14 games that Clemson has not had a turnover. Clemson has had 16 turnover-less games under Danny Ford, six have been in the 1st 14 games. Danny Ford has been the coaching in 119 games at Clemson. Clemson now has just one turnover offensively this year, while the opposition has committed six. Clemson was second in the nation to Arkansas in turnover margin last year. Clemson is now 56-3-2 under Danny Ford when it commits fewer turnovers than the opposition.

Clemson is now 7-5 under Danny Ford in night games. Clemson has two more night games this year, at Virginia Tech and at South Carolina.

This is just the fifth time in Danny Ford's 11 years that Clemson has been 2-0.

Running back Terry Allen gained 130 yards against Florida State and jumped from ninth to fifth in Clemson history in career rushing. Allen now has 2295 for his career and moved ahead of Fred Cone, Lester Brown, Ken Callicutt and Stacey Driver with his performance at Florida State.

The 28-point output by Clemson was the most in a first half since last year's Duke game when Clemson led 28-14 at the half. The last time Clemson scored at least 28 points in any half was last year at Maryland when Clemson scored 28 points in the fourth period and 36 points for the half. The last time Florida State gave up 28 points in a half was in the 1985 Florida game when Florida led 28-0 at the half.

Tyron Mouzon, who caused the fumble in the third period
"I was put in the game on that play and we were in a routine
coverage. I was expecting a draw play and just charged toward the
runner as best I could. I wanted to give him a good, lick, but most
of my contact was by reaching for the ball. I was not trying to strip
the ball, it just worked out that way."

Vince Taylor, native of Clearwater and captain for this game

"The trick play did not get us down because you expect four trick plays a game from Florida State. Because you expect that you don't get down about it because, that's just Florida State.

"I tried to provide leadership this week. I'm a fifth year senior and this team looks to me on defense for leadership. They have made me captain for the first two games, so I look at that as a responsibility.

John Johnson

"Everyone was prepared for this game, we were really fired up. We had last year's game on our minds. We knew they would come at us hard this game because they lost last week.

Chris Morocco

"We were all hyped up for this game. The coached did a great job. I think our unbalenced line opened things up for the sweep and that in turn opened things up for the passing game. The passing game was a possession game and we executed.

"The running backs did a great job. Terry Allen and Joe Henderson gave unbelievable effort. We've got great running backs.

Hank Phillips, center

"We eased up in practice this week and got our legs under us a little better. I think we were well prepared by our coaching staff to block against a very good Florida State defensive line. We played Clemson football tonight."
