N. C. STATE COACH'S QUOTES: Dick HHSheridan

"First of all I want to say that I'm extremely proud of how hard our team played. I thought we came out and played great defense in the second half. We moved the ball well in the second half but broke down at crucial times.

"When we play a team the calibre of Clemson, we have to play perfectly. And for the most part we have this season. But today we didn't. You have to give Clemson credit for making things happen, especially the turnovers.

"We are still tied for the league lead. We'll have to play well in those

two remaining games to win the championships.

"I know our team was well prepared as far as intensity was concerned. But if things don't go well for you, you don't get the opportunity to show that. We couldn't get anything going today. Clemson was beating blocks and getting to us. Txey are the quickest team we've played. We saw from them exactly what we had prepared for. They just executed better in one-on-one situations. Still, I thought we played better on both sides of the ball in the second half."

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD: I think our people were motivated, we played with enthusiasm, they played with effort and it was the Clemson football team on the field today, it was the Clemson coaching staff, it was the Clemson crowd, it was the Clemson gand and it was the Clemson student body. I think all of them contributed to bhe win.

I thought we played well. I'm not going to say anything negative although we didn't do everything perfect. But we played and we had fun and we won and that's all I care about. Hopefully we can correct what we did wrong next week. We had some spots where we could do better, but overall, we played well and we're pleased with that.

I think we had a much better atmosphere at Clemson this week. It was a much better performance by our people. I thought everybody came ready to play today. Right now, looking to next week, I hope we can continue two weeks in a row. That would be my biggest hope right now...getting them ready to play and getting 60 minutes of quality football.

We had enough offense in the first half to win. We had a bunch of mistakes forced on them by our defense. I thought the defense played tremendously. I thought Gardocki was excellent in punting situations. We had a better pass rush...the offensive line did a pretty decent job and when Joe (Henderson) got hurt a little bit Reggie (Lawrence) came in and did all right. Hopefully we can get Terry back real soon, but there's no use taking a chance on him getting hurt again before he is well. He has another year to go.

They got the momentum going in the second half and it's hard to stop when a team can 11-, 15-, 9- and 10-yard you to death like they were doing. They had complete momentum in the second half.
