APPALACHIAN HEAD COACH JERRY MOORE

"I had forgotten in the last 18 months the biggest difference in I-A and I-AA --- speed...I was in awe of Clemson's team speed...I think our team played extremely hard today, but we couldn't offset Clemson's talent, their great speed...We had a hard time offenaively coming up with plays that could really get us going... we would have something and Clemson's speed would negate it...on defense, we would where we needed to be, but their speed would cause the play to be a big one...the defense holds and Gardocki kicks a 57-yard field goal...we put them in a third and long and they hit on a 40-yard touchdownpass...We learned some things out there today and I think Clemson learned some things this afternoon... Clemson's a great team..."

CLEMSON HEAD COACH KEN HATFIELD

We didn't look all that pretty, but we accomplished a lot of things we wanted to do offensively. One of our goals before the game was to either score at least 40 points or have over 500 yards of total offense, and we challenged our players on this.

I thought the first team offensive line did a great job. We got a quick lead--17-0-then we put the whole second team in and they just hadn't played as much. It only
takes one guy to mess up and it hurts your effectiveness and we just couldn't get
our momentum going again in the first half. Certainly the sweep on the first play
of the second half was a big play (by Ronald Williams). I was glad we got to play
a lot of second teammers and I think that will pay dividends in the long run.

Another goal was to shut Appalachian out, and I think we needed a goal that was realistic. We wanted to have our practice set up where we wouldn't have a let down We kept the pressure on all day long, but Appalachian State kept fighting and kept swinging and they had a lot of spunk and they deserve a lot of credit. But I think the real difference was the speed of the game.

Our defense stayed in there and we didn't give them anything long, and that was a real key to the game in getting the shut out.

I thought our two halfbacks (Derrick Witherspoon and Ronald Williams) came in and played with a lot of poise, and remember, they were still in high school at this time last year. They made some big things happen and that is going to help up in the long run. We're still young in those areas and I think they grew up a lot today and I think it will give us good depth at the running back position.
