GEORGIA HEAD COACH RAY GOFF

"I don't think I could tell you all my feelings right now. Obviously, I am disappointed. We just got whipped. You can write all the ifs, ands or buts you want, but the bottom line is that Clemson lined up and whipped us. That just about sums up the whole ballgame.

On punt block: "The last time we had a punt blocked as far as I can remember was in 1984 at the Citrus Bowl against Florida State. That was just a terrible play on our part today.

On the skirmishes that broke out: "We've got to look at the films and see how they got started. I'm not going to jump off a cliff and say what I'm going to do now. After we see the films, I'll take the appropriate action with our players.

"Clemson has a great football team. I've said before that the Clemson team was my preseason pick to win the national championship. Defensively, they are as good as anybody in the country. We found that out today. I can assure you of that.

"My responsibility is getting our football team ready to play each week. I don't think we were ready today. I don't think we are as bad as we looked, but Clemson is an extremely good team.

CLEMSON HEAD COACH KEN HATFIELD

There was no doubt -- we were ready to play. This was the cap on a great week for Spirit Blitz...with 84,000 waving their flags throughout the game.

What a great game to play in for our four Georgia seniors. The score might look like we had an easy time, but everything we earned came the hard way. We played hard every down.

I think the two key plays in the game, or turning points, were first, when we took the second half kickoff and got points out of it. The second, was when we had our only turnover and they got the ball deep in our territory and we kept them out of the end zone. They got three points, but that was a real morale booster to not let them have a touchdown.

That was a most electrifying feeling coming down the hill today. Everybody in the Clemson family had an assignment and all of them followed through just like it was planned.

I cannot say enough for our defense. They still haven't given up a touchdown in Death Valley yet this season. They just played great...from the opening play when we threw their trick play for a loss. The defense kept pressure on the passer all afternoon and there weren't many times when they couldn't get set and planted to get all that zip on the ball. When they run as much as they do, they really don't spend that much time on pass defense, and we were able to get in there several time. And our coverage people did a great job and never did give them a chance to turn up the field.
