NCSU HEAD COACH DICK SHERIDAN: "You couldn't have asked for a better effort after the performance last week. We played hard, but the turnovers hurt us. We cannot make mistakes like that against the number two defense in the country."

"Davenport performed very well. We wanted to get the ball in his hands and he responded well."

"It is hard to feel good after a loss like this. We have to go back to work, and prepare hard for next week. We just cannot keep making costly mistakes against top defensive units like we faced today."

COACH KEN HATFIELD OF CLEMSON: It was a real hard fought game on both side. We didn't play as good as we could and I think maybe last week's game (against Georgia Tech) might have taken something out of us. We made too many mistakes and the penalties hurt us. But we also came up with some big plays ourselves, maybe the biggest might have been the screen pass to Derrick Witherspoon when we nedd a lot of yardage.

I think maybe in the second half, and the fourth quarter especially, our depth paid off for us. I beliefe the pressure out defense put on them the second half played a big part in the outcome. Coming up with those two fumble recoveries certainly helped our situation.

We knew that people had had a hard time running against N. C. State because their defense has given some people problems this year. That is why we came out with our passing to start with at the beginning.

We told our team at halftime that they would have to go out there and overcome some of the difficulties we had encountered in the first half. The did that although it might not have been pretty, we got a 'w' and that's what counts. People have had a tendancy to understimate N. C. State. They had a good game plan for us and I'm just thankful we came out on top. We thought they would overplay the run and that played a big part in us coming out with the passing to start out with.
