COACHES' QUOTES

COACH KEN HATFIELD, CLEMSON: We played exactly like we were supposed to in the first half and looked good doing it. We have had four tough, emotionally, close games that were not decided until late in the fourth period. Today was a little different, and we were able to play some of our true second teamers.

Rodney (Blunt) ran hard again and I've been telling Doug (Bolin) all along that we were going to need him sometime this season. He kept on staying with it and today he found out what we had been talking about.

We knew Wake Forest could move the ball. They have been able to score points on just about everybody and I think they were averaging nearly 350 yards a game in offense. So we knew they could move the ball. In the first half we weren't giving them much time to set up on their passing and they weren't all that successful. But they did do a good job and I hope that our players who got to play learned from the experience.

We had to get used to Eddie's (Moncrief) snap count as it's a little different from DeChane's (Cameron). But we're pretty well pleased at the way things went for us today.

We have a tough game on the road next week at North Carolina. I don't think they have lost at home and it definitely won't be an easy game. We cannot slip up in any of the four we have left.

COACH BILL DOOLEY OF WAKE FOREST:

You can never be pleased with a loss and that is certainly not the case with our football team today! However, I must say I was proud of our effort in the second half. We did not quit or hang our heads out here this afternoon.

I will say that we played 30 good minutes of football today when we came back in the second half. It takes 60 minutes like that to beat a team the caliber of Clemson, though. Today, we weren't able to do that.

In the first half, we were tentative and let Clemson take the game to us. Clemson is an outstanding team. As good as there is in our conference. Obviously, you can't sit back like that against a team like Clemson.

The two big plays in the first half, the long pass and the punt return were big keys in putting us behind early today. That's been the story of our season -- we get behind, and then we never can catch up.

Keith West did a much better job running the offense in the second half today, and I thought Todd Dixon made some big plays catching the ball. Defensively, we had good play from (Marvin) Mitchell, and Dred Booe. I think at times, we were as physical as we have been all season on the field today.
