COACHES' QUOTES

COACH KEN HATFIELD, CLEMSON: I'm real happy for our seniors in winning the (Atlantic Coast Conference) championship this year after we missed out on it a year ago. They certainly ended up on a good note (winning the championship), but we still have two regular season games to go and neither one of them will be easy.

We're happy that the Florida Citrus Bowl wants us to come back to Orlando again. I personally don't there is a finner bowl around.

We weren't ready to play in that first series, and I could tell it. I started to call a time out right before they hit that bomb, but I think that woke us up. And were able to come back and get a quick score by completing a couple of long passes. After we got ours (score), the defense came alive.

I knew were going to have get some yards rushing, but after DeChane (Cameron, qb) had such a great running game against North Carolina, they were going to give us the fullback and hope they could stop it. But our tailbacks had some critical yards rushing.

That was really a classic punt return by Darnell (Stephens)...probably as good as I've ever seen. He got some great blocks on the run and thank goodness, there were no clips on it.

You have to give credit to Maryland. They probably play the toughest schedule in America. They played us tough in the trenches, just as we knew they would. Coach (Joe) Krivak has done an admirable job this season. He has really been hurt by injuries. There are many teams who have had as many as he has had and still play as tough as they have. My hat is off to him as his players and coaches.

COACH JOE KRIVAL OF MARYLAND

"Our biggest problem was that we had to many third and long plays and we could not stop them (the linebackers) from coming in. It was a combination of mistakes and giving up the bigg play. Clemsc has a good group of athletes. They have speed and depth both on the offensive and defensive lines. They also have size, you have guys that would probably have to be moved around in a moving van. Kirkland and the linebacking core group run very well.... They have two or three strong fullbacks and a couple of tailbacks that run very well, giving them a solid football team with very talented athletes. Hatfield has done a good job in everything he has done. The team has become more diversified, passing the ball a little more. Outside skilled people are very talented. Smith and Stephens have great talent and are both exceptional players. Our quarterback thought he had enough time on the first-down attempt, but he ran out of time and was flagged for delay of game. Those mistakes you cannot make and expect to win the game. There were ten or fifteen times that we did not make the play, if we made them, we could have stayed in the game. Smith and Stephen are what we call "slippery guys" it's tough to get a hand on them. I thought we were pretty mentally prepared to play, in the first serie we hit on a big play but then we turned around and gave up an easy On the first two touchdowns, we had guys in position, but they play. did not knock down the ball. That was a let down, after scoring against a tough defense we just gave up easy plays for touchdowns. There is some work to be done on this team, we have to improve recruiting and also get our injured guys back in playing condition for next season. Next week we hope to regroup against N.C. State and try to put one great effort together against them. We just have to hang in there and keep working.
