Post-Game Quotes Wake Forest (5-3, 2-3 ACC) vs. Clemson (4-4, 2-4 ACC) October 31, 1992

Wake Forest head coach Bill Dooley:

"The defense did an outstanding job. The key was to not give them the ball past the 50. Even though the option play gave them points, we had the big touchdowns.

"It was a team victory. The only problem was, there were so many penalties, I thought we were in Death Valley (Clemson's stadium). But this team faced a lot of diversity, and did a great job.

"Our team is very close. Every team has a character, but our team's characteristic that pulls them through the tough spots is unity. It was a great win and I'm proud of them.

"Elton (Ndoma-Ogar) and Ben (Coleman) did great jobs. I just can't say enough about our team. Overall, it was a team victory."

DEACON NOTES:

- * This is Wake Forest's first win over Clemson since 1976.
- * Today is Wake Forest head coach Bill Dooley's final home game as the head coach of the Deacons. Dooley now has 95 wins as an ACC head coach -- one short of tying the ACC record for wins currently held by Frank Howard and Danny Ford, both Clemson coahces, each with 96.
- * This is also Dooley's first-ever win over Clemson as the head coach of Wake Forest. For his career, Dooley is 7-15-1 against the Tigers.
- * Keith West today became just the fifth Wake Forest quarterback to pass for 4,000 yards in a career. West was 11-21 today with no interceptions and 166 yards. He has 4,079 yards (number three in the Wake Forest recordbooks) in his career.
- * Today marks Todd Dixon's third career two-touchdown game. It is Dixon's first-ever two-touchdown performance against an ACC opponent. $_{69}$
- * John Henry Mills turned 23 today (b'day -- 10/31/92). Mills set up the gamewinning touchdown with a 42-yard reception to give the Deacs a crucial first down at the Clemson 33-yard-line. The reception is the his second-longest career reception and is the longest of the season for the 1991 1st team ALL-ACC tight end.

Clemson head coach Ken Hatfield

"We didn't do very weell on controlling the situation. Sapp did a good job, especially getting the ball to Gibson on that one play. He made several big plays, but we have to get the ball in the end zone when we get down there. We got hurt several times on penalties on first down and we have got to put an end to that.

"We did a lot better in the second half on the option. Sapp has a strong arm and is a powerful runner and I thought he did a good job in his first start. We just made too many mistakes towin the game. O'Neal could go back in there late because of his ankle. I'd like to congratulate Wake Forest on their win. They are on a roll and they were ready to play. This has been a tremendously frustrating year for us, butwe have our fall break next week and I hope we can put a little more emphasis on the things that have been bothering us because North Carolina will be comingin for another real challenge for us.
