NORTH CAROLINA COACH MACK BROWN:

"I'd like to congratulate Clemson and Coach Hatfield. They totally dominated the game in every phase. I felt like it was a day when we weren't going to have anything good happen for us. We didn't get one break, but you have to make breaks. That's something we've been able to do the last three weeks, but we weren't able to do today. Clemson played as well and was as dominant as at anytime since I've been at North Carolina. They didn't do anything wrong all afternoon.

"I thought our guys played hard. I thought we were in a position to get back in the game after Curtis Johnson broke the long run. I thought we really fortunate to only be down 12-0 at halftime. But they took it (the ball) and stuck it right down our throat (after the TD) like they had done all afternoon. That took what little momentum we had away from us. I obviously did not do a very good job of preparing our football team. That's my job. What we've got to do is get dressed, get back to Chapel Hill and get ready for Duke.

In answer to question about loss of Means: "Well, obviously Natrone has been a big part of our offense for the last three years, but we weren't blocking them very well when he was in there. Maybe he could have pulled us out of it. Randy Jordan couldn't go, either. Antuarn Williams got hurt. So we were down to one tailback. That tailback situation went like the rest of the day for us. It wasn't our day, wasn't meant to be. Their defense stopped us. You never know. Natrone pulled something in his rib cage area. He could not come back. Hopefully, he'll be back for the Duke game. It's a shame for him he didn't get to play because he's a great player.

"Clemson whipped us in every way possible in the game today. Our players are good enough that shouldn't happen. So I'll take full responsibility."

"This was as good as Clemson has played. This was better than the Florida State game. Every player they've got graded a winning performance. They dominated the line of scrimmage with their running game and that allowed Sapp to throw. I'm very happy for Ken. He's a great football coach. I'm sorry this came at our expense."

CLEMSON COACH KEN HATFIELD

This was without a doubt our best game of the year. We (the coaching staff) could not have been prouder of the performance that our players gave. They fought all the way, but we had a lot of help--the band, the fans, spirit blitz day, Hall of Fame Day--all of that rolled into one really helped.

I thought the key drive of the day was right after North Carolina scored in the first drive of the second half to pull within five points, and we took the kickoff and kept the ball for a good while (over seven minutes). ~~Although we fumbled at the zone and didn't get any points out of the drive xxxzxxzxxz~~ We only used two passes in that drive and got the seven points back that we had given up some easy.

We had a healthy quarterback today for the first time in four weeks and Patrick (Sapp) gained more confidence as the game went along.

On the fumblerooskie, I asked Stacy (Seegars) Friday how far did he think he could run and he said 80 yards. Then he corrected it to say 20, but we had planned to use it somewhere around the 50. We worked on it everyday this week, and it went off just as we ran it in practice. I think that changed the momentum of the game with that play. Our coaches did a heck of job making preparations for this game.

When (Natrone) Means went out, there's no doubt that it hurt them offensively. We've been through that also.

We gave a good account of ourselves and we're going to work real hard this week to get ready for Maryland. They've always given us a tough game.
