COACH KEN HATFIELD OF CLEMSON

For the last four games, the margin has been ~~xxxxxxx~~ four points or less, and for the last two times here at Clemson it has been a field goal. You remember two years ago Scott Cisson missed a field goal that would have been a victory for Georgia Tech.

The defense just played great today--like we knew they could. We have 10 of the 11 coming back. The one senior we have--Brenston Buckner--makes a great interception, which turned out to be the start of the winning drive. I told them in the team meeting that I couldn't have been prouder. They fought, gang tackled and knocked the ball loose several times. The ball was on the ground, and we ended up not getting it...we can't allow that...we gotta come up with the ball.

It was a beautiful site...the crowd was behind us...the defense was there when we needed them most of the time, and we got to play a lot of people. There were a few key injuries on both sides, and this can affect the outcome of a game sometimes.

I told our defense that you keep on making things happen until ~~xxxxxxx~~ something happens offensively. The two big plays in the game were the two two-point plays and both quarterbacks had to get the ball in the end zone physically. For Travis Harvey to make that kind of play (first two-point conversion) and really there wasn't any finesse...he had to dive and run hard and that's the way you win the big games and are what championships are made of. I was just tickled to death with those two particular plays. I don't ever remember being in a game where two two-point conversions were made that turned the game around like that

We had things going good with Louie (Solomon), then he got hurt (toe) and we had the tempo we wanted. He had given us a spark with some ad libbing. When something went wrong, he made something happen. The other thing, he ends up throwing the big touchdown pass. But Patrick (Sapp) came back in and got them moving again...and I can't say enough about Spoon (Derrick Witherspoon). He got some critical yards on third down and that enabled us to eat some clock (had ball for 7:41 on missed field goal). That was a key drive in the game.

We didn't throw the ball as well as we wanted ~~xyto~~, but Terry Smith made a couple of outstanding catches, and that touchdown catch was a thing of beauty.

GEORGIA TECH HEAD COACH BILL LEWIS

"First let me congratulate Coach Hatfield and his staff and players. I thought it was a heck of a football game. They found a way to do the things and make the plays to win the football game. I really feel for our football game because I thought we played our hearts out, but we simply could not finish the job. Their football team did what they had to do to finish the job, and we could not find a way to do that. There's only one way that I know how to handle this situation, and that's to continue to work hard. There's not going to be any shortcuts, there's not going to be any drastic change. We've got, I think, a pretty good football team. We simply have to keep working hard until we get our football team where we need to be.

(Was fatigue a factor?) No, not at all. I didn't think that was the problem. As a matter of fact, I thought our conditioning was going to be a plus for us.

(Screen pass that was intercepted) You've got to find a throwing lane. You don't try to throw a screen pass over top of people, you've got to find a throwing lane, and if the throwing lane doesn't open up, then you throw the ball at the feet of the intended receiver. That was just a situation where Donnie tried to loft it over the top. If you start floating that you give the defense time to react.

(Success of Clemson running game) "I think they just did a good job of blocking us. A couple of times they took the lead isolation play and bounced it outside when we got things clogged up. They did a good job of blocking. They've got a big line of scrimmage, and it was obvious that when they got ahead, they were going to let their running game and their line of scrimmage win it. That's one of their strengths, to run the ball right at people, and they did a good job of it in the fourth quarter.

QUARTERBACK DONNIE DAVIS

"I think everything that set us back wound up being a big play. It's just part of football. Those things are going to happen. It's just up to us to try and come back from it. We didn't do that today.

(On intercepted screen pass) "He read it very well. It was a mistake on my part for throwing it in the first place. But he was shaded in between, and he made a good play.

(To questioner asking if Tech won game every where but on scoreboard) "I can't say yes. because that's the one that counts. We didn't wind up with the most amount of points."

"We've got to try and cut down on the mistakes that we made, and capitalize when we have a chance to score in the red zone. That has to come.

KICKER TYLER JARRETT

"I had been hooking the ball a little bit, so I was aimed more toward the right upright. I was coming across it more than I should. On the second one, I thought it was going in, and at the last second, it seemed like it broke left and hit the upright. At halftime, I was reminded that I was coming across the ball, and again, I tried to aim more to the right. And I pushed it.

LINEBACKER JAMAL COX

"I don't know what to say. Defensively, I thought we shut them down. I thought we gave them an easy one in the first half. They earned the second one."

LINEBACKER RODNEY WILKERSON

"We just have to keep our attitudes up, come back and be ready for next week. We've lost two tough ones. We knew we had to win the game. This was a big game for us. We came here with the attitude that they were going to get nothing."
