COACHES' QUOTES

COACH KEN HATFIELD OF CLEMSON: What a great collegiate game. This is the reason people come to the stadium...an exciting game. Both teams today had a lot of character, they fight hard, they are very physical and both of them never gave up.

I thought Coach Mike O'Cain did an outstanding job of preparing his team for the game, and for bringing them back when it was down 20 points.

Terry Smith wasn't able to play, Louie (Solomon) wasn't able to go and we had to go with what we had. We appreciate so much Richard Moncrief working at quarterback when (Patrick) Sapp got hurt.

We made some great things happen. Again, we had some long drives when we had to, especially when we were going into the wind and I'm just so happy for the entire football team for finding a way to win.

Being able to win without those who were hurt was a big plus for us and hopefully it will help us on down the line. And that what this team is made up of...you never know when you're going to be called on to contribute. Terry's out and Marcus Hinton comes in and makes a big play for a young person. And there's Chris Franklin, a freshman, makes a great touchdown play on the trap. Other people are now helping out and this is going to help on down later.

The only thing we're disappointed in is the blitz where they went 70 yards because that really got them back in the game. Two things really. We should have put them away when we had that long drive and missed the field goal. But again, we're a young team, we haven't blitzed very much. But they have a great skilled man (Eddie Goines), and when you put him one on one with nobody else to tackle him -- he's a great competitor. We just haven't used the blitz very much and when we have used it, we weren't very good at it.

We're not as polished as I want us to be because we're young, they're fun and enthusiastic. We're just going to keep working and improve with every down. That delay penalty at the last just gave our guys one more chance to show their character and gave us one more chance to play in that kind of environment which you can't set up in practice to have that type of situation. There isn't any doubt that the fans made the difference. I know it was hard for the players to hear. The fans pulled it up another notch and they contributed as much as anybody.

NCSU HEAD COACH MIKE O'CAIN: "We dug ourselves in a hole early and it was too deep to dig out. But I'm proud of the way this team hung in there. I'm very proud. We played hard and we played with intensity.

"Clemson is a very underrated team on defense. They are big and strong. As big and strong as anyone we will play all year. They are a very difficult team to drive 90 yards on, which is the kind of field position we had most of the day.

"Today, we made a lot of mental mistakes on both sides of the ball. But in the end, we were in a position to win and just didn't get it done. We had our chances.

"When we started the fourth quarter, down 20-0, we still felt we had a chance. When we stopped them and got it back and scored ourselves, it gave us a boost. It generated some momentum and belief for us. The scenario at the end was very draining"

(On coming back to Clemson): "It was very emotional for me. You don't spend six years of your life somewhere and not have feelings about it. I'm proud to come back here as a head coach. I'd feel a lot better if we had won."
