"The set it up really well. It was great execution on their part. We didn't think they would throw a screen."

COA CH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: This was Clemson's team today. This game game goes first to the players, then to the assistant coaches, and then to the Clemson football family.

I thought our team was ready to play, but with the circumstances, it was not very fair to them. We camein and had seven practices at Clemson and there were some jarrxing plays made. In fact, we had to slow them down for feat that somebody was going to get hurt.

Defensively, I thought we did very well, except when we were offsides and gave them another chance at that field goal, and on a couple of other occasions.. But I wasn't surprised at the way they played.

I'm glad we don't have another game coming up next week. I'm looking forward to a good night's sleep, maybe not tonight, but tomorrow night anyway. It's been a j oy to be around this team in this short of time and I am happy to be back. I left Clemson (for four years), but Clemson never left me.

I thought this was going to come down to a two-minute game, but wen when Emory broke that screen for the long gain, we then had press plenty of time to go thexxxxs distance we had to go.

### KENTUCKY COACH BILL CURRY QUOTES

"I think that was a great football game. We fought our hearts out. We can't play any harder than that."

"The obvious things that cost us the ballgame were execution and the fact that we didn't capitalize when we got the ball down close. You have to do those things to win."

"You have to deliver to win football games. We had that great punt that put us in position to bottle them up. And we knew heey would probably throw the screen, and they did and we didn't tackle them."

"We showed that our football program is moving in the right direction. We showed that we could get to a bowl game and we showed that we can compete with a top 25 team. We went toe-to-toe with them, and these are the things we must focus on. This was a great step forward for our program."
