COACHES' QUOTES

<u>COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON:</u> I thought that N. C. State whipped us in every phase. But we're certainly not going to make any excuses, but we have to give them credit. That's my responsibility to see that we play like a winning football team. We'll have to get ready to play next week (at Virginia).

I thought the key early is that we couldn't move the ball and we couldn't get any yardage on first down. On the other hand, I thought what gave them the momentum was getting good yardage on first down. To me, it's real simple to assess the game: We get two series in the first quarter and get penalties on both of them, and we're not nearly good enough offensively to overcome penalties.

On the positive side, I thought we improved on the special teams. We blocked a punt and did some good things in other areas. Our kickoff coverage team improved. But I don't see anything positive the way we played on offense. Defensively, we can't give up the long play. I thought we were in the game at halftime. But then we gave up the long pass.

Offensively, they made the plays. I thought their kids did a great job in making things happen on first down. I believe both teams were prepared, but they made the plays and we didn't.

I thought our crowd was great, but I'm very disappointed in the performance we gave them. But we're not making any excuses. We bot our tail whipped--everybody in the locker room. All I know is we're going to put our nose down, we're going to go back to work Monday and get ready to play Virginia next week.

COACH MIKE O'CAIN OF N. C. STATE: "What can I say. It was a great effort by efferyone involved. The players, the coaching staff, our scout team. We were prepeared as well as any team I've been associated with. Beside a couple of fumbles and a blocked punt, we ran our game plan to perfection. We were as near perfect today as we could be.

When you keep a Division I team out of the endzone for three and a half quarters you've done something. That's a chore.

This staff worked their rear ends off since our last game. Our young men were ready. Right now, I'm happy to be the coach at N.C. STate University.

(On Terry Harvey): He's okay. He could have playered late, but Geoff (Bender) came in and did an outstanding job. Terry got his bell rung, he had a bloody nose and his should is sore.

(on rushing attack): You don't come to Clemson very often and run the ball like we di I did'nt know we would that. We feel you have to run right at Clemson to be able to beat them. We've always tried to do that, somethimes with not much success. /Today it worked. Rod's (Brown) run off a trap with a veer look set the tone. It was a confidence boost. E Last year's fourth quarter gave us a tremendous amount of confidence coming in here. **Eddie Goines' 76 yard TD reception is the longest catch of his camer, besting the 75 yarder against WF last year. That catch also went for a score.

**Goines TD catchegives him 16 for his career, a new NCSU record. He came into the game tied w/ Haywood Jeffires (1983-86) with 14 TD catches.

** Goines three catches for 108 yards moves him into second place on the Wolfpack career charts in both categoires. He now has 117 catches for 1,944 yards.

** Steve Videtich established a new school record when he connected on his llth consecutive field goal in the third quarter. The record breaker was his third field goal of the day (Mike Cofer (1986) held the old record of 10 straight.

MARVIN CROSS--91 (DE)

"They did a good job. They just scored a lot more points than we did. My hat goes off to NC State, they had a good game. I think we were ready for the option. The loss is going to challenge us, but we'll bounce back. We're not going to stay down for long. I'm a little surprised that we got pushed around like we did, but we'll look for next week now."

*Cross had 9 tackles in the game.

WILL YOUNG--59 (OG)

"A lot of guys on this offensive line don't realize how fast it is out there. They will learn, but it'll take some time. It's something we have to work on in practice. We'll look at the film tomorrow, I'm sure we'll study it pretty closely, and we'll see what happens this week. The fans were good and loud. Coach West is doing a great job getting the fans back into the stadium, but we as players have to keep the fans here. We just weren't ready for everything that happened out there today. We have a long way to go, but we'll be all right. We've been working all week to be ready to play. NC State did a great job. They are really fast as far as linebackers go. They just beat us."

CHRIS FRANKLIN -- 38 (LB)

"On the play, I dropped back on coverage and saw that Brett (Williams) beat the offensive lineman and that the ball came free. I just ran forward, picked up the ball to try to get a good field position. I didn't know who was behind me. As I got closer to the goal line, I thought more about scoring. I thought the play lifted the team and gave us something to build on. But they played us tough and now we have to focus on Virginia. That's going to be a very big game for us."
