COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: In the first half, I thought that the defense was real flat. We didn't play with much emotion. Offensively, we had the ball four times and got points out of it twice.

I thought we ran well on offense all day. But our defense got cranked up in the second half. The crowd also got with it and played a big, big part in our effort.

You got back, Georgia Tech throughout this year has played everybody tough and very close. What has happened to them is that they've turned the ball over and given people points, but they didn't give us any today. It was a hard, fought game.

(Concerning wearing the orange pants). We don't wear orange pants until they earn the right to wear them. I told them at the first of the year, when they earned it, they could wear those orange pants because a bunch of people had put a lot into them before they came along. I felt like coming out of North Carolina that they had earned that right. It would have been easy to wait two weeks (from the UNC game) but I didn't want to do that because I thought they had earned the right to wear them this week. We talked about it last (Friday) night just what these pants mean and what people before them have done in those orange pants and I think that they responded with it.

I should have told Lamont (Begues) on one of those time outs to just get the first down and run the clock out. And he had the first down, but he cut back trying to get more yards and lost it. That's a freshman mistake, but it's my fault for not calling him over and explaining it to him.

We're a much improved football team from what we were four weeks ago. All of those offensive yards came because our offensive line is blocking people up front and they weren't doing that before.

The game started off slow because I don't think this team knows yet how to react to certain things. This thing has been a total team effort. This thing is coming together...I'm talking about the Clemson family...support has been tremendous...our football team has responded to the fans...they've earned that support...and it's coming together now. but this football team has never given up...we've stuck together as a staff and as a team and the big thing about it is that our fans and supporters have stuck with us...and when you do this, good things will happen to you.

TIM JONES -- ILB -- 56

"We didn't play as well as we could in the first half. They weren't doing anything special, they just came out and ran the football. A lot of things happened to put them into position to win the football game, they just came out to play the game. "I think we have a lot of confidence now, more than a month ago, especially on offense. I think that they feel like they can move the football now and they just go out and do it. I feel like the team has come together as a whole. We come to play together, offense, defense, and the kicking game. We do a lot of good things. We're working hard, but we just need to improve a little more. We have the attitude that we would like to have a winning season. We've done a good job sticking together as a football team, no matter what the situation was. We're going to fight together until it's all over with."

"South Carolina is a good team. We're 5-5, fighting to have a winning season and the fighting to go to a bowl game. Coach Scott has done a good job with that team. They have improved every game. This is the biggest rivalry, I think, in the country. We just have to get our heads together tomorrow and concentrate on next week."

"We new Tech was going to come out emotional with a coaching change just last week. We came out pretty flat and did things to turn it around. We executed well and came up with the win. Right now we just take things game by game. We're not looking to next year right now. We just want to go out the door with wins and keep the positive for next year.

"At a home game, you get more emotionally into the game. You get a lot of strength, know that. With the fans behind you it makes you feel great. The crowd helps me out during the game, but I just have to go out and do what I need to do.

I thought the football team came up here and started off playing hard. Offensively, we came up here trying to run the ball and that's what we accomplished in the first half. Defensively, we just didn't tackle didn't very today, and we had too many off-sides penalties in critical situations on defense, which hurt us as far as momentum is concerned.

(Was fatigue a factor) I think we were a little bit worn down at the end, but this is the ninth game of the season and they should be aware of what's going on. We may have been able to substitute a little bit more on the front line but we're down people since losing (Dan) Witherspoon this past week.

(Missed FGs) I thought those three field goals would have put us in the game. I thought he had a legitimate shot at the one on the 18, which is sort of half kicked. He did hit the next one. He missed three, but he's done a good job this year. That

(Davis at QB) We planned on going with him more but he got hurt. He was out the whole second half with an AC (shoulder) sprain. We had him in for an offensive series that we wanted to run with him. I thought it was a good situation for him. He moved the ball and did well.

(Missed tackles) It's bewildering to me. I thought they missed tackled early and late. It wasn't just late so it wasn't like they were weary. I think there were too many guys trying to reach for people instead of running through the ball carrier. We've got to keep working and get better at that.

I thought our players were ready to play and they came out ready to play. I thought we made too many mistakes on defense, especially the key short yardage play on third down, when we had a tackle and it ended up being a missed tackle. You can't win games missing tackles, and we had too many missed tackles today.

My own personal feeling was that I was trying my best to keep the kids in the game and get them a win, which they really need. I was more worried about the players than myself. I thought they played their hearts out today. I didn't see any lack of effort. I saw at times just some poor tackling, which we work on in practice every day.

(Establishing the run) We emphasized it in practice all week. I've always believed that we can run the football with this unit and we did it today. I think basically the offense, except for a couple of areas, probably played well enough to win today. I think defensively we had to play better. Too many easy plays made where we had them stopped.

\*Georgia Tech runningback C. J. Williams rushed for 117 yards against the Tigers today, becoming just the third back in the last 20 games played at Death Valley to gain over 100 against Clemson in Memorial Stadium. The last to do it was Corey Croom, who had 135 yards in 32 carries in the opener of 1992. The only other player to do it since the opener of 1986 is Kennard Martin of North Carolina who had 16-116 in a 1988 contest.

\*Clemson had two running backs over 100 yards today. It is the first time since the Virginia game of last year when Dexter McCleon (127) and Emory Smith (113) both had at least 100 in a 23-14 Clemson victory. Lamont Pegues had 136 yards and Nealon Greene had 111 in Saturday's win over Georgia Tech.

\*Donnie Davis of Georgia Tech and Patrick Sapp of Clemson both played wide receiver today. They were the starting quarterbacks in last year's game between the Tigers and Yellow Jackets in Death Valley.

\*Tim Jones had nine tackles in today's game and moved into fifth place on the Clemson tackle list. He now has 323 for his career. He moved ahead of Henry Walls with today's performance and now trails only Bubba Brown (515), Jeff Davis (469), Ed McDaniel (389) and Randy Scott (382).

\*Clemson gained 283 yards on the ground today. One of the big contributors was Jamie Trimble, the backup center. Trevor Putnam went out with a knee injury in the first half and Trimble played the last half of the contest. Trimble, a sophomore from Ormond Beach, FL, had appeared in just four games all season. It is safe to say that he had not played as many plays in his entire career as he did in today's game.

\*Clemson is now 28-6 lifetime in Orange pants. Half of the losses came in the 1992 season. Clemson has now won six in a row in Orange pants and is 3-0 lifetime against the Yellow Jackets. According to Tommy West, "I told the team before the season that they had to earn the right to wear orange pants. They were worn for special occasions when I was here before. I thought they earned the right to wear them with the performance at North Carolina.

\*Lamont Pegues tallied 136 yards in today's game. That is the most by a Clemson first year freshman since Ronald Williams had 183 against Appalachian State in 1990.

\*Clemson finished its ACC schedule with a 4-4 record. The Tigers have had just one losing season in ACC play since 1981. That took place in 1992 when the Tigers were 3-5 in the ACC.

\*Clemson is now 4-1 at home. The Tige-s are 26-3-1 at home in the decade of the 1990s.

\*Clemson quarterback Nealon Greene has played in five games for the Tigers this year, four as a starter. In those five games he has taken 297 snaps. Clemson has zero turnovers for those 297 snaps. The Tigers have had a turnoverless game four of the last five games. The only turnover in the last five games was against Wake Forest and Greene was hurt for that contest.

\*Clemson first-year freshmen have now touched the ball on 352 plays (running, receptions or returns) and have not lost a fumble. Nealon Greene has 83 consecutive pass attempts without an interception. Clemson has just nine total turnovers for the season and still has just one lost fumble. The Clemson record for fewest fumbles (lost in a season) is six: by the 1938 Clemson team.

\*Clemson has just nine turnovers in 10 games this year, 0.9 per game. The Tiger record for the course of the season is 0.88 by the 1940 Clemson team that had just eight turnovers in nine games. Clemson can break the record with a turnoverless game against South Carolina.

\*Andre Carter had a career high 13 tackles today. He also had his fourth interception and took over the team lead in that category.

\*Clemson is 4-0 this year when rushing for at least 200 yards, 1-0 when it does not.
