CLEMSON VS. VIRGINIA 9/23/95

Emory Smith - #18

"We just didn't capitalize on the chances we had. Virginia played pretty hard today. I can't take anything away from them. They played an outstanding game and all I can do is compliment them on their victory. Virginia had a lot of penetration today. They had a lot of time to look at film this week.

"(Conditions, did they play a part?) I can't really say that. We played under worse conditions last week (against Wake Forest) We just really didn't play well. We just have to get better. We have to go back to day one, concentrate on our next opponent and go from there."

Brian Dawkins - #20

"(On his teammates) I'm proud of those guys today. They never gave up. Some things didn't go our way the whole game, but they never gave up. I don't know what it was, but something just held us back, no matter what we tried to do, something went wrong. But we're going to blame it on ourselves as a team. We lost this game. The defense lost, the offense lost, we all lost the game. We can't start pointing fingers. If we do that, we'll fall apart.

"We have the whole season ahead of us. The seniors have to pick it up. I think execution-wise, Virginia was the more-sound team today. We had too many mistakes. Too many offsides penalties, too many defensive penalties. Any time you have too many penalties against a good team, it will always hurt you. We have to cut back on the mistakes we're making. We'll try to do better next week."

COACHES QUOTES

COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: I don't think we can play any worse offensively. I'm very disappointed in the overall execution (of the offense).

The thing we have to do is for somebody to step up and take charge. We gotta grow up. It's been the same two weeks for us offensively. The ball was wet on both sides of the field. We have to accept responsibility and be a man.

I don't believe Nealon (Greene) ever got in the rhythm of the game. He never did get in sync. I don't think he played well early, we tried to help him toward the end of the first quarter...take some of the pressure off him by running the ball some and get him in the groove because it's still a close game. I don't think he ever got in the rhythm the entire game.

And in a game like this...where Virginia has a good defensive team...if you can't throw the ball, then you're not going to have a chance just lining up with them..

I thought the biggest part of the game where we didn't get it in before the half. We missed a touchdown there, then coming back out (in the second half) I think we still are in the game--although we probably didn't deserve to be, we're still in the game, but we took ourself out of it. You get it down there, you gotta knock it in...you line up, it's toe to toe and cheek to cheek and you have to score.

I really appreciate the people who stayed here through this kind of weather and through that kind of performance by our team. But I apologize to them for the offensive execution. The fans certainly deserved better than what they watched.

Our defensive team fought their tails off the whole game. They made a couple of runs on us and hit a pass on us...I knew the kid (Tiki Barber) would make a couple before it was over with. But I thought our defense played extremely hard, and swarmed to the ball and they acted like they didn't care where it was wet, or cold or anything else. they came to play ball. And I was very proud of our defensive performance

GEORGE WELSH, UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA HEAD COACH

"The win today feels good. I think we have broken all curses the media have put on us over the years. Today is our first win ever in Death Valley. I am glad the next guy after me won't have to live with the curse Clemson had on us.

This win helps us in the conference. They (Clemson) are good defensively--better than I thought. Our defense played well today also. We made the goal line stand which was an important play of the game.

I didn't mind the weather today. We have played so much in the heat and humidity that today's weather was a nice change. The weather shouldn't affect the game that much. It was tough on our snapper and seemed to be tough on Clemson's quarterback. We both had some dropped balls and passes we should have caught.

I don't think we lost energy in defense, but I don't know how to describe what happened to our offense. Maybe we were too conservative. I am not upset with our offense, but we didn't move the ball well in the second half.

I never said anything to the team about not ever winning in Death Valley. But, they know they are the first team to break that curse. We knew we had to come down here and play with poise and confidence and that is what we did. If you execute, you must play with poise.

I think the thing that helped us the most this season was playing Michigan. We had to go on the road and play a good team with a hostile crowd. Today we couldn't hear in the beginning. The Clemson fans were loud.'



Clemson vs. Virginia  
September 23, 1995

- \*Raymond Priester had his 3rd straight 100-yard rushing game when he had 27-111. He is the first Tiger since 1991 to have three consecutive 100-yard rushing games. Ronald Williams had three straight 100-yard games that year against Georgia Tech, Georgia and Virginia. The streak was snapped when he tore his ACL in warmups prior to the N.C. State.
- \* Nealon Greene threw for 213 yards against Virginia, giving him consecutive 200-yard passing games. Greene threw for 234 yards against Wake Forest last week. Patrick Sapp, current Clemson starting outside linebacker, is the last two have consecutive 200-yard passing games. He did it against North Carolina and Maryland in 1992. Tommy Kendrick is the only Clemson quarterback in history to have three consecutive 200-yard passing games. He did that in 1970.
- \* Clemson failed to score a touchdown this afternoon, the first time Clemson has done that in Death Valley since 1985 against Georgia Tech, a 14-3 Yellow Jacket victory.
- \*Clemson has just three field goals versus Virginia in the last eight quarters. Clemson did improve its total offense against the Cavs. The Tigers had just 167 yards against the Cavs last year and had 393 today.
- \*Clemson outgained Virginia by 90 yards total offense today. This is the biggest positive total offense margin by the Tige-s in a loss since the 1990 Georgia Tech game in Atlanta. Clemson outgained Georgia Tech 343-218 in a 21-19 Yellow Jacket win.
- \*Clemson has 12 turnove-s this year, including four today. The Tigers had just 12 turnove-s all of last season.
- \*Clemson saw its streak of consecutive 400-yard total offense games end today...by seven yards. Ctenson finished with 393 today and was trying to become the first team in Clemson history to record four consecutive 400-yard games to open the season.
- \*This is the first time Clemson has outgained the opposition, yet lost the game since 1992 against Wake Forest.
- \*In Clemson's two losses this year the Tigere-s have controlled the clock for 71:18 and the opposition has had the ball for 48:42.
- \*Virginia converted just 1-12 third down conversions today. That is the fewest third-down conversions for an opponent in an opponent victory since Georgia was 1-9 on third down in 1980. The Bulldogs won that game in Athens, 20-16. Today's 1-12 by Virginia is the worst third down percentage by an opponent in an opponent victory since Maryland was 1-16 on third down in 1979, a 19-0 Terp win in Death Valley.
- \*This is the first time Clemson has won the total offense statistic, won the time of possession stat, outrushed the opponent, had more yards passing and more first downs, yet lost the game since that 1980 Georgia game in Athens. That day, Clemson had a 194-yard margin in total offense, 116-yard passing margin, and 78-yard rushing margin, and 16 first down margin (26-10), yet lost the game 20-16.
- \*This is the first time Clemson has had 12 penalties since the 1992 UT-Chattanooga game when Clemson had 12-100 in penalties.
- \*Antwuan Wyatt had 182 yards in all-purpose running this afternoon, his career high total. Wyatt now has 585 all-purpose running yards for the first four games. He led Clemson in that category last year with 538 for his 10 games.
- \*Raymond Priester now has 437 yards rushing this year, more than the 343 he had all of last year. In fact, Priester's 437 this year is already more than Lamont Pegues had last year, (390) when he led the Tigers in rushing.
- \*The 76-yard touchdown pass from Mike Groh to Patrick Jeffers tied for the sixth longest pass play against Clemson in Death Valley. It is the exact same length as the Terry Harvey to Eddie Goines touchdown play (N.C. State) against Clemson last year.
- \*Nealon Greene had 19 completions this afternoon, a career high. It is the most by a Tiger since Patrick Sapp had 19 completions against N.C. State last year. He also attempted a career high 36 passes.
- \*The four pass receptions by Raymond Preister equalled his entire reception total of last year.
- \*Dexter McCleon's pass interception was the seventh of his career, more than any active Tiger.
