- \*\* Attendance: 46,074
- \*\* Today's NC State Textile Bowl MVP is Mike Guffie. Guffie caught eight passes for 146 yards, both career highs. North Carolina Textile Manufacturer's Association will present the NC State Athletics Department with a \$5,000 check in the name of Guffie which will go to the general athletic scholarship fund.
- \*\* Clemson's 43 points is the most points scored by the Tigers against the Wolfpack in the 65 game history. Clemson scored 39 points in 1985 in a 39-10 rout of the Pack in Clemson, SC.
- \*\* Terry Harvey's six interceptions is most in a single game in his career. He had only nine interceptions during all of last year's play. To date, Harvey has seven touchdowns and 10 interceptions.
- \*\* With 383 yards passing today, Terry Harvey moves into second place in school career passing yards, surpassing current Chicago Bear Erik Kramer. He sits behind Shane Montgomery who has 5,298 career passing yards. To date Harvey has 4,883 yards.
- \*\* Harvey also moves into second place in career pass attempts with 658. His 52 attempts today was the most in his career. He trails Shane Montgomery who recorded 746 attempts in his prolific career.
- \*\* Harvey's 383 yards passing sets a new career mark for the senior from Decula, Ga. His previous best was 333 yards on 21 of 36 versus Marshall in 1993.
- \*\* Addis set career highs in receptions and yards with 7 catches for 92 yards.
- \*\* The last time NC State team started with 1-4 record was Coach Tom Reed's last season in 1985. That year's squad started out 1-7 and finished with a 3-8 record.
