CLEMSON AT MARYLAND OCTOBER 21, 1995 POST GAME QUOTES

Coach Tommy West of Clemson:" When we scored right before the half, this became a Louie Solomon game. But this was by far out best game defensively all year. We challenged our defensive line all week long and it played extremely hard today."

"We did have the wind with us in the fourth quarter, and that was a help to us, but it was our defense that was the key today."

"Our speed was also a great advantage for us. We played extremely fast today on both sides of the ball."

"The touchdown right before halftime was just a huge momentum swing going into the locker room. Maryland was coming right after us at the time and that play turned things around. That was a break that went our way. When you hustle and play hard, you can get those breaks."

"I don't know that are defense can play any better than they did today. We stopped the run and got good pressure on the quarterback."

"Offensively, we moved the ball fairly well, but the turnovers concerned me."

"We played a very good 5-1 Maryland team. They were at home, playing for a bowl game, on homecoming day."

MARYLAND COACH MARK DUFFNER

"You witnessed a dissappointing loss here today. We didn't have the execution we needed to get the ball into the endzone. I am disturbed by that and we need to get answers for next week. I felt like the defense played awful hard against the fifteenth ranked rushing team in the country."

"We are where we are right now because of our football team, not because of any one player. We won five football games as a good football team, we lost today because we didn't play well. We have a lot of work to do. We need to get back some of that consistency and productivity.'

"Inconsistency was a key for us. We are a better football team than we showed today."

About bowl games: " No I didn't talk to the kids about that. We are trying to play one football game at a time. We have four big games ahead of us."

About the quarterbacks: "It wasn't anyone player today. We lost as a football team. They were both prepared to play. "

"I felt like we had a good gameplan going in. We just didn't get it done."
