## #59 Will Young, Offensive Guard

"This is a very good win for us. We didn't have much success in the first half but we kept ourselves in the game. Our team didn't expect Raymond Priester back for this game but it was a good lift for our football team. In the second half we just wore South Carolina down. We knew if we kept running the football and tire them out we could come out on top."

### #18 Emory Smith, Fullback

"We just wore down South Carolina in the second half. We kept punching the football right down the field. Our game plan was to just come in a run the football. Nothing complicated. We grinded it our in the 4th quarter and won the game. It feels good to end the season on a positive note."

## #27 Raymond Priester, Tailback

"I feel real good today. We stuck to the gameplan and won the football game. Our team started out slow. South Carolina came out and controlled the football for much of the first half. #### South Carolina Game Notes

- Monty Means' 10th receiving touchdown ties Sterling Sharpe's single-season record of 10 in 1986.
- Today's attendance of 74,990 was the 6th largest crowd to see a football game of Williams-Brice.
- Stanley Pritchett had 12 touchdowns on the year 4 receiving and 8 rushing.
- Steve Taneyhill winds up with 61 TD passes in career and 29 this season. The 29 touchdown passes this season broke the old SEC record of 28 held by Shane Matthews of FLorida and ties Danny Wuerffel who also has 29 touchdown passes this year.
- Stanley Pritchett's 62 catches this year ties Sterling Sharpe for second place for most passes caught in one season for a USC player.
- Winners of the Flagstar Award given to the most outstanding lineman was received by Will Young of Clemson and Eric Sullivan of South Carolina.
- For the past five meetings the visitor has come away with the victory.

#### CLEMSON NOTES

*Clemson running back Raymond Priester gained 85 yards on 17 attempts and broke the Clemson single season rushing record in the process. Priester now has 1286 for the season, breaking the record of 1258 set by Terrence Flagler in 1986. Flagler did it in 12 games. Priester now has an average of 117 yards per game for the season. He has clinched the Clemson single season rushing record on a per game basis. The record is 106.4 by Cliff Austin in 1982 and Priester would still average 107.2 per game even if he did not gain a yard in a bowl game.

*Priester had just seven yards in the first half and just 27 through the first three periods, then gained 58 in the fourth quarter. He missed most of the first half with a pulled hamstring.

*Priester's running mate in the backfield, Emory Smith, gained 101 yards on 12 rushes and scored two touchdowns. It was his second 100-yard game of the season and third of his career. He scored a pair of touchdowns and now has 15 for the season, 14 rushing. His touchdown total is tied for the second highest total in Clemson history for a single season. Fred Cone also had 15 in 1950 (14 rushing and one receiving). Lester Brown has the record with 17, all rushing, in 1978. *Clemson finished the season 5-0 on the road, just the second Clemson team since 1948 to have a perfect road record. The only other team to do it since 1948 is the 1981 National Championship team. Clemson has won six in a row on the road dating to a 17-0 loss at Florida State last year.

*Clemson gained a season high 494 yards in total offense, 323 rushing and 171 passing. It was a season high for the Tigers in terms of total offense, and the sixth game this year with at least 400 yards. The Clemson record for 400-yard games in a season is seven. Clemson now has an average of 399.7 yards per game in total offense, or just three yards short of an average of 400 yards per game. Only two Clemson teams, 1991 and 1978, have averaged at least 400 yards per game over the course of a season.

*Antwuan Wyatt gained 171 yards in terms of all-purpose running, 83 in receiving, 50 in punt returns and 38 in kickoff returns and now has 1366 all-purpose yards for the season, an average of 124 yards per game. The record for the course of a season is 122 by Ray Mathews in 1950.

*Nealon Greene was 9-13 for 171 yards and a touchdown for the game, including 5-5 for 125 and a touchdown in the second half. For the season he has completed 107-183 for 1474 yards and 10 scores. He needs 182 passing yards in a bowl game to break Steve Fuller's single season passing yardage record (1655 set in 1977). Greene has a passing efficiency figure of 137.6 for the season, currently sixth best in Clemson history. His 107 completions rank in a tie for fourth best in Clemson history and his touchdown pass total of 10 is tied for fourth best in Clemson history. In many ways he has had the finest sophomore season in Clemson history for a quarterback. His 1474 yards and 58.5 completion percentage are best ever by a Clemson sophomore quarterback. His 10 touchdown passes ties the sophomore record of 10 by Tommy Kendrick in 1969.

*Clemson gained 334 yards of total offense in the second half and the Tigers did not punt the football. The Tigers' used three punters in the first half. The Pooch punt by Jeff Sauve was the first punt of his career.

*Freshman Anthony Simmons had 11 tackles on statistics kept in the press box, including 1.5 sacks and a pass deflection. The total gives Simmons 134 tackles for the season, a figure that ranks in a tie for 7th in Clemson history. He has already shattered the freshman record of 104 by Ed McDaniel in 1988.

*Leomont Evans had an interception in the fourth period, giving him four for the season and five for his career. Clemson now has 21 interceptions this year, at least one in each of the last 5 games and 9 of 11 games this year.
