"I thought Clemson played a great game on offense and really beat our defense. I thought that was the difference in the ballgame. At halftime we went in and said that if we can keep them from scoring in the second half, we have the opportunity to win the ballgame, and we did have an opportunity to tie the game at the end and missed the field goal. It was But give credit to Clemson for hanging in there. I thought they played a good game today on both sides of the ball and deserved to win.

[On decision for FG] "It was fourth and three or 51 yards. He made 53 last week and it was with the wind. I think that's a decision I'd make all the time. He didn't make it, but if he makes it he's hero. I never second guess a decision. I'd rather have that decision and try to tie it up and get that thing into overtime then have fourth and three and not make it. That's the decision I made. I made it myself on the sideline and that's the way it goes. We gave ourselves an opportunity to tie it up but we didn't get it done.

[On Clemson offense] "To be honest with you, I don't think we've tackled the toss yet. They took the ball to our defense and did a great job of blocking and running. Basically I thought that was the difference in the ballgame. Their offense against our defense. Our defense didn't come today. They didn't play very well, and give credit to Clemson for what they did. They ran the ball well and they hit some key passes when they had to hit them.

"That's football. You've got 11 contests. How you rebound from setbacks is ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ what proves what kind of character you have. After a win it's easy. After a setback is when you see what kind of football team you have.

"I thought Joe played well. He got hit a couple of times, but I thought he threw the ball well. I wish that pass to Harvey had been a catch. He made some good decisions. I'm very happy with Joe Hamilton and the way he's doing things. [Best game?] I haven't seen the stats but as far as handling the crowd noise and just moving the offense and coming back from 21-10 to go ahead, I would say he's a heckuva an athlete and I'm glad Georgia Tech has him."

COACHES QUOTES

COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: I couldn't be any prouder of this group of players and assistant coaches. If there is anything we learned from this (win) -- as long as we continue to work our tails off, play hard and do the things they're supposed to do -- then they're going to get better.

There are a lot of people who had given up on this football team, but this crowd today went ahead, then got behind and then came back to win. This was a great gut day. They fought back after getting behind. I think Nealon (Greene) probably played his best game of his career.

I don't think that the wind was a factor in any quarter. It was blowing hard at times, but now down in the stadium.

The football team felt good when it took the field. Nealon fought, scrapped and competed. Even the score they took away from us (after lineman downfield), he made a great play. We've been so close in some games this year, and really, we've been our own worst enemy. We stopped ourselves in the second half twice -- things that you can't do.

I thought our crowd was tremendous today. Those are the real Tigers up there in the stands today, and those are the ones who come out when some say this season is over. And they helped us win this football game.

I thought the officials called what they saw and I know that they have a tough job out there. I thought the punt hit that player, but maybe it didn't. We certainly made some bad calls on offense, as well as defense. All of us are human.

On that last drive, I told them we've got to make one first down and it's ours. I didn't want them to get the ball back. And Raymond (Priester) made a great run and got the first down, and it was ours then and only then.

Clemson vs. Georgia Tech Notes
October 19, 1996 at Clemson Memorial Stadium

- *Clemson had a season high 28 points and a season high four touchdowns in today's game.
- *The Tigers converted 8-15 on third-down, just the second time this year the Tige-s have converted over 50 percent of their third down opportunities-
- * Raymond Priester had 25 rushes for 175 yards and a touchdown today. It was his third game of at least 100 yards this year and eighth of his career. Priester now has 2369 career yards, fifth on the all-time Clemson list. He jumped from ninth to fifth with today's performance.
- *Emory Smith scored his 22nd career rushing touchdown today and moved into a tie for eighth in Clemson history (Steve Fuller) with the score.
- *Nealon Greene had 193 yards of total offense today and now has 3698 for his three-year career. He is seventh in Clemson history in that category, trailing former Tiger Mike Eppley by just 54 yards. Greene went over the 3,000-yard mark in passing yards today and ranks seventh in Clemson history in that area.
- *Clemson head trainer Fred Hoover suffered a concussion on the second play of the game, a 21-yard run by Melton Dunnican. It was a memorable play for Dunnican because it was the longest run of his career. But, it will also be memorable for Hoover because he was knocked out when Dunnican and Georgia Tech tackles ran into the Clemson sideline. Hoover was taken out of the stadium via ambulance and was taken to Oconnee Memorable Stadium. He will remain there overnight for observation, but should be fine according to Clemson team physicians. Hoover, in his 38th year as Clemson Head Trainer, was working his 417th consecutive game as Clemson head football trainer. He has never missed a game. And, if we know Doc Hoover, he'll be ready for the Maryland game on November 2nd. While the open date next week will help Clemson players get oversome bumps and bruises, it will also help head trainer Fred Hoover.
- *Clemson's 15-play, 77-yard touchdown drive that proved to be the game winner was the longest of the season in terms of number of plays this year. Today's game was just the second time this year (Wake Forest the other) that Clemson has had two drives of over 75 yards in the same game.
- *Kenya Crooks caught a three-year touchdown pass from Nealon Greene in the second period, his first touchdown reception since the 1994 Georgia game. Crooks and Joe Woods have had at least one catch in every game this year.
- *Tony Horne had five receptions for 82 yards in today's game, His third straight game of at least 80 yards in receptions. Horne has 16 receptions for 292 yards over the last three games.
- *Since the last quarter of the Missouri game, Nealon Greene is 55-92 for 806 yards, three interceptions and four touchdowns. That computes to 60 percent completion percentage and an efficiency rating of 141.6
- *Clemson had 262 yards rushing against Georgia Tech today. The previous high yielded by the Tech defense in a game this year was 112 by N.C. State and North Carolina.
- *Clemson had season highs against Tech in terms of points scored, rushing offense, first downs and total offense.
- *Tech was ranked in the top 25 of both polls coming into the game. This was Clemson's first win over a top 25 team since the 1994 North Carolina game. The Tigers best the Tar Heels that day, 28-17. North Carolina was 12th in USA Today and 19th in AP heading into that game. The last time Clemson defeated a ranked team in Death Valley was the 1993 season when Clemson defeated an 18th ranked Virginia team, 23-14.
- *Clemson has now won 10 straight games dating back to last year's Virginia game when it outrushes the opposition. Clemson is 4-0 this year when it wins the rushing game and 4-0 when it wins the turnover margin.
- *This is the first time Clemson has beaten Georgia Tech four times in a row since 1898-1899-1902-1903. Those games were in 3 different cities, Augusta, Greenville and Atlanta.
- *Nealon Greene is now 3-0 as the starting quarterback against Georgia Tech. This is the first time a Clemson starting quarterback has beaten an ACC team three years in a row since 1985-88 when Rodney Williams defeated Duke and Virginia four years in a row. For his career, Greene is now 28-46 for 404 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions against Tech. He has a career passing efficiency rating of 156.2 against the Yellow Jackets.
- *Clemson has an open date next week before playing Maryland on November 2. The Tigers are 15-3 after an open date since 1977, but one of the losses took place this year, at Missouri.
- *Clemson is now 24-1-2 on Homecoming games since 1970.
