COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: I'm really proud of this team again -- and it's been that way for the last several games -- of standing up and showing what it's made of when a lot of people were ready to throw in the towel on them.

This week we challenged the defense as well as the offensive line and they gave their answer today. I thought it looked like they were on a mission and they went out and made the best of what was offered to them.

The orange pants -- the seniors wanted to wear them before today, but I didn't think that they had earned the right to wear them. But after the last couple of weeks, I they had earned the right to wear them because the orange pants are special and we just don't put them on for the heck of it.

Our coaches had the team ready to play. They had a good game plan. But regardless of what kind of plan the coaches have, the players make the plans work.

I can't say enough for our defense by accepting our challenge. It looked like when one player would slow a runner up, there were three or four showing up right behind him in some great gang tackling.

When we had to run today, our offensive line was there. I'm sorry Rayond (Priester) didn't get his 100 yards, but he had it and the play was called back for holding. But guess I'm happiest for Sam (Zanders) who really turned on the after burner on

his run.

We had to make a few adjustments on our game plan in the first half, and I believe we made another one or so in the second half. All of the adjustments helped us out.

On Nealon Greene's shoulder: Nothing broken and he'll start getting treatment on it sSunday. Glenn Rountree went back in after having to come out for a few plays and he appears to be okay.

Maryland Head Coach Mark Duffner

"We certainly didn't do what we had to to win the game. We were unable to stop Clemson's inside power game or the scramble of their quarterback"

"We did not play well at the line of scrimmage. We are unable to control the football. We did not perform up to the level of our expectation for our team. (It is) very disappointing."

Clemson vs. Maryland Notes November 2, 1996

*Clemson wore orange pants today, the first time Clemson has worn that all orange garb since last year's North Carolina game. Clemson has now won eight straight in orange pants dating to a Halloween loss at Wake Forest in 1992. The Tigers are now 17-1 in the month of November in all orange, 6-0 against Maryland. Clemson's overall record in Orange pants is now 30-6, including 15-2 in games Tommy West has coached as either a head coach or assistant coach.

*Peter Ford's 66-yard interception return for a touchdown was the first touchdown of his career and the 11th interception of his career. Ford is now tied for fifth in Clemson history with those 11 interceptions. He is tied with Pete Cook (1950-52) and Brian Dawkins (1992-95). Ironically, Ford's interception today was the first return for a score by a Clemson player since Dawkins had a 49-yard return for a score last year against North Carolina, the last time Clemson wore orange pants.

*Člemson gave up just 113 yards total offense against Maryland, fewest allowed by the Clemson defense since the opening game of the 1994 season when Furman had just 99 yards against the Tigers. You have to go all the way back to 1977 to find the last time Clemson gave up fewer than 113 yards total offense in an ACC game since 1977 when Virginia had just 61 yards total offense against the Tigers in a 31-0 Clemson victory.

*Maryland had just 48 yards passing today, the fewest yards given up by the Tigers through the air were the fewest allowed by the pass defense this year (151 was previous low vs. Furman) and the lowest since 1991 when Temple had just 15 yards passing. It was the fewest passing yards by a Clemson ACC opponent since 1980 when North Carolina had just 27 yards passing in a game at Death Valley, a 24-19 North Carolina victory.

*Clemson had eight sacks for minus 66 yards in today's game. The eight sacks were turned in by seven different players. Clemson had a school record 12 sacks against Furman earlier this year, but this was the most sacks against an ACC opponent since the Tigers had 10 sacks for 59 yards against Duke in 1992. *Clemson had seven other plays in which the Terps lost yardage so there were 15 negative plays turned in by the Clemson defense today. This was the most negative yardage plays in an ACC game since 1992 when the Tigers had 17 such plays against Duke.

*Tony DeSue had two tackles for loss today, the first game of his four-year career in which he has had multiple tackles for loss.

*Sam Zanders had a 61-yard run for a touchdown this afternoon, the longest run by the Tigers this season. It was the longest run by a Clemson player since 1993 when Derrick Witherspoon ran 89 yards for a touchdown against Maryland. Zanders had a career high 83 yards rushing in eight attempts. He entered the game with just 44 yards all season.

*Trevor Pryce had his best game as a Tiger with two sacks for 25 yards and three total tackles for loss for 30 negative yards. Pryce now has nine tackles for loss in his six games.

*Rudy Currie had a career high six tackles in today's game.

*Clemson had 146 yards rushing and 17 yards passing in the fourth quarter against Maryland.

*Clemson controlled the clock for 19:47 in the second half and converted 6-9 third downs, the best single half third-down conversion ratio for the Tigers this year.

*Clemson had a season high 35 points in today's game and the first time Clemson scored five touchdowns in a game since the South Carolina game last year.

*Tommy West is now 6-1 in November games as Clemson's head coach.

*Brett Williams had a sack and a fumble recovery against the Terps. Williams has had at least one sack against Maryland in every game he has played in his career against the Terps (four).

*Emory Smith had a season high 48 yards in nine attempts and scored two touchdowns, his first multiple touchdown game of the season. He now has five touchdowns to lead the team this season.

*Raymond Priester had 85 yards rushing and now has 789 yards for the season, 211 away from the 1000 yard mark. If he reaches that 1000-yard mark he will become the first Clemson player to have a pair of 1000-yard seasons. Priester had 1322 last year when he set the Clemson single season record. Terry Allen came close, he had 973 in 1987, then 1192 in 1988. Priester moved into fourth place on Clemson's career rushing mark with his 85 yards today. He now has 2454 for his career and moved ahead of Ray Yauger (2439) today. Next on the list is Buddy Gore at 2571. Kenny Flowers leads the list with 2914. *Clemson came three points away from becoming just the second team to shutout an ACC team four years in a row. Maryland shutout Wake Forest four straight years (1972-75).

*Clemson is now 39-10 in games played after October 17 since 1988.

*Clemson is now 5-0 this year when it outrushes the opposition.

*Clemson is now 16-3 the week after an open date since 1974.
