Auburn Peach Bowl Game Notes Jan. 2, 1998

\*\*Auburn finished the season with a 10-3 record. Its the ninth time in school history that the Tigers won 10 games and the first time since 1993 when Auburn went 11-0.

\*\*Auburn has a record of 14-10-2 in Bowl games including a 2-0 mark in the Peach Bowl.

\*\*Auburn's 15 points in the fourth quarter tied the most scored in the fourth in a Bowl game since Auburn scored 15 against Oklahoma in a 40-22 loss in the 1972 Sugar Bowl. The 15 points is also the most scored in the fourth quarter this season.

\*\*Dameyune Craig was named the offensive MVP while Takeo Spikes earned the defensive MVP. Both players earned their second consecutive honors, after being selected MVP's of the Independence Bowl last season.

\*\*Auburn trailed by 11, 17-6 before rallying for the 21-17 win. The 11 points tied the largest comeback this season. The Tigers also trailed Alabama 17-6 before winning 18-17. The 11 points also ties the biggest Bowl comeback. Auburn also trailed Ohio State by 11, 14-3 in the 1990 Hall of Fame Bowl before winning 31-14.

\*\*Auburn earned its second consecutive 4-point Peach Bowl victory. The Tigers also defeated Indiana by four, 27-23 in the 1990 Peach Bowl.

\*\*In the first quarter, Jaret Holmes nailed a career-long 52-yard field goal. It tied Auburn's Bowl record of 52 yards set by John Riley against Arizona in the 1968 Sun Bowl. The field goal also tied for the eighth longest in Auburn history and is the longest field goal since 1987.

\*\*Dameyune Craig and Karsten Bailey connected on a 61-yard pass play in the second quarter. It marked the seventh time this season that Craig was involved in a pass play that covered 60 yards or more. Craig and Bailey were responsible for three of those plays, connecting for 77,76 and 70 yards, all for touchdowns.

\*\*Two records for the fans: The Peach Bowl had a record crowd of 71,212 today. Last month, Auburn fans were involved in a SEC Championship game attendance record of 74,896.

\*\*Dameyune Craig's 22-yard touchdown run was the second longest scoring run of his career. The longest was a 33-yard TD run against Army last season in the Independence Bowl.

\*\*Auburn held Clemson to only four first downs. The last time Auburn held an opponent to under 10 first downs in a game was last season against UAB when the Blazers were held to nine first downs.

\*\*Clemson's four first downs are also the lowest by an opponent in a Bowl game since Michigan State only had two first downs in the 1938 Orange Bowl.

\*\*Auburn held Clemson to an opponent season low 145 yards of total offense. The previous low was 198 by South Carolina.

\*\*Clemson was held to only 145 yards of total offense, marking the lowest total in a Bowl game since 1938 when Auburn held Michigan State to 65 total yards in a Auburn 6-0 win.

#### Quoting Auburn Head Coach Terry Bowden

"To every Auburn fan, this probably is fitting to end the season much like the other games, having to fight through adversity.

"We are a passing offense, and we could not catch the ball today, but the defense played a great game. We mixed the run well, but we were as cold as we could get in the passing game.

"You have to be happy when you have two punts blocked that led to touchdowns, and you still win the game. I think it is a game of will, and when it looked like it was time for us to give up and quit, our team came through and won the ballgame.

"I am proud of our seniors, they have set the foundation for what we are trying to do. For Nate Smith, Bobby Daffin and Shannon Suttle, all seniors, to step up the way they did today, that says a lot about this team.

"To go out and win 10 games with some of the things that have happened to this team. I'm pround, because we could have easily just made excuses.

"I am confident that this team will be a top-10 team when the final polls come in. I think we have set the stage for a championship run next season." Clemson Quotes by Head Coach Tommy West

"We played poorly on offense all day. We had some opportunities to do things on offense, but we dropped some passes and did not convert.

"One of our concerns at the half was that we left the defense on the field so long in the first half. They wree on the field for 38 plays in th first half and that was too much. We got tied late in the game.

"Late in the game we had the ball in good field position so I made the decision to go for it on fourth down. Earlier in the year agianst North Carolina we were backed up so we decided to punt and try to get the ball back. The best decision today was go for it because we had good field position.

"Our seniors put us in a bowl for three straight years. You can go back to the 57-0 loss to Florida State (1993) and see how we have improved. We were very close to Florida State and North Carolina this year (losses by a touchdown apiece).

"This was a very important game for our seniors, they wanted to prove themselves and go out with a victory. But, they still have done so much for our program. We are really going to miss them.

"Our defense played as hard as they can play. At one point Craig was 9-37 and we had them going backwards. We had many players make big plays on defense.

"Our kicking game played as well as it could. The kicking game put us in position to win the game. Auburn changed their protection from the regular season and when we saw that we changed what we were going to do and it worked. We came after four punts and got three.

"We tried as hard as we could to bring this program to another level. We were just a little short against some outstanding temas (four losses by seven points or less).

"Rahim has become one our dominant players, he is a playmaker. He has really come a long way over the last two years.

"Craig made three or four plays wto win the game for them. We had him bottled up the first three quarters, but he did the job in the fourth quarter.

#### Clemson Notes

\*Clemson blocked three punts in today's game , an all-time single game record. The Tigers also blocked two punts against The Citadel in 1954 and against Maryland in 1989. Rahim Abdullah had two blocks today, the third Clemson player in history to do that. \*The three blocked kicks tied a Clemson for overall kicks blocked in a game. Clemson had three placekicks blocked against Georgia in 1995. Clemson also lost that game. \*Anthony Simmons had 14 tackles for the game and four tackles for loss. The four tackles for loss were a Clemson bowl game record. He ended the season with 158 tackles and 25 tackles for loss. The tackle for loss total is third highest in Clemson history for a season and he now has 52 tackles for loss for his career, more than any Clemson linebacker in hisotry.

\*Raymond Priester ended the season with 956 yards, while Tony Horne ended the season with 907 yards receiving, the first time in history Clemson has had a 900-yard receiver and 900-yard rusher in the same season. Horne ended the year nine yards short of breaking Perry Tuttle's single season yardage record, but his 70 catches were a single season mark.

\*Chad Speck became the first Clemson player to score a touchdown on a blocked punt since the 1995 Western Carolina game when Andy Ford blocked a punt and returned it for a score. \*Clemson ran just 52 plays on offense, fewest all season. The four first downs were also a season low.
