*Clamson quarterback Brandon Streeter threw for 319 yards in today's game, the second highest yardage total in Clemson history. It was the most passing yards in a game for a Tiger quarterback since November 6, 1965 when Thomas Ray threw for 323 yards against North Carolina in Chapel Hill. Thus, today's performance by Streeter was the most by a Clemson quarterback in Death Valley, a facility that has been in use since 1942.

*Streeter also had 301 yards of total offense in the contest, the 10th highest total in Clemson history. It is the most by a Tiger since Nealon Greene had 309 yards in a n overtime victory against Duke.

*Streeterconnected with Rod Gardner on a 63-yard pass on the first play of the game. That was the longest pass of Streeter's career and the longest reception of Gardner's career. The previous long for Gærdner was a 41-yard reception against Wake Forest last year.

*Eight different receivers caught passes today and three diffe-ent playe-s had at least 70 receiving yards. The group was led by Mal Lawyer, who had 5-89. The yardage total was a career high for Lawyer, who had 79 yards at Georgia Tech last year.

*Javis Austin had five receptions today, most by aClemson runningback since Michael Allen had five against Virginia in 1995.

*Chris Jones had a career high 15 tackles, including two for losses. Of course the total off the film as observed by the C Clemson coaches will be official.

*Defensive lineman Jason Holloman had his first career sack and first career fumble recovery. He had a caused fumble in last week's game against Virginia.

*Clemson has lost three games in a row for the first time since 1994. It is the first time since 1985 that Clemson has gotten off to a 1-3 start. That Clemson team ended the year with a bid to the Independence Bowl.

*The 58-yard touchdown reception from Brandon Streeter to Brian Wofford was the longest touchdown pass of Streeter's career and the longest touchdown reception of Wofford's career. The two combined on a 54-yard scoring pass at Virginia last week.

*Antwan Edwards did not play much of the second half due to a pulled hamstring. Edwards had his second fumble return of the year inthe first half and also had 79 yards in kickoff returns. He had 90 total return yards between the two categories today.

*Brian Kuklick completed just 2-9 passes in the second half, but both went for touchdowns, 48 yards to Chalmers and 56 yards to Desmond Clark. The 56-yarder to Clark was the longest reception of his career.

*When Wake Forest recorded a safety against the Tige-s in the second period it was the first time a safety was scored against the Tigers since 1984. South Carolina recorded a safety against the Tigers in a 22-21 South Carolina victory in Death Valley.

*Wake Forest had just two first downs in the sec-nd half and were 2-16 on third down for the entire game (stats in final books are wrong in that area). The two first downs that Wake Forest had in the second half were the two long touchdowns. Wake Forest had 138 yards of total offense in the second half and 104 came on two touchdown plays. The Deacs had just 34 yards on the other 28 plays of the second half.

*The 350 yards passing by the Tigers rank as the second highest total in Clemson history. The only total that is higher is 364 yards against Duke in 1963, a 35-30 defeat in Durham. Thus, today's 350 yards ranks as the most yards passing by a Clemson team in Death Valley. The opponent record for yards passing in Death Valley is 361 by Maryland in 1985.

*The two teams had 601 yards passing today, the fifth highest combined total in Clemson history and the third most in Death & 1ley's history. Clemson and Maryland combined for 691 in College Park in 1992. Clemson and Virginia combined for 627 in Death Valley in 1966.

*Clemson opponents are now just 15-59 on third down this year, 25.4 percent.

*The 406 yards of total offense ranks as the most by Clemson in a loss since the 1996 South Carolina game when Clemson had 412 yards in a 34-31 loss.

*The seven turnovers committed by Clemson is the most by the Tigers since Clemson committed seven at Kentucky in 1985. That 26-7 loss gave Clemson a 1-3 record, the last time Clemsonwas 1-3 to open a season.

CLEMSON VS. WAKE FOREST Sept. 26, 1998

WAKE FOREST HEAD COACH JIM CALDWELL QUOTES

"I think it was just a heck of an effortiby our guys. We played extremely hard against a very very good football team that has a great defense. Obviously playing in a very very tough place to play, the toughest place in the country."

I think our guys really hung in there, particularly in the second half when things got a little tough, and made some big plays when they needed to be made, and we certainly are proud of them."

"We were just afraid of Brian, he wasn't 100 percent the first couple of ballgames, we didn't want to move him around out of the pocket and thingsof that nature, so we tried to protect him early on. In this particular ballgame, we turned him loose. He was feeling good, he was healthy again. In order for the play action to work for you, you've got to have at least a semblance of a running game, and I thought we were able to run the ball. We didn't run it as we'l have liked, but we certainly did make them respect it."

"They got a little tired, but that's going to happen to you against one of the better defenses in the country. I mean its going to happen. The great thing about it was our guys were able to hang in there. And we've got to win it any way we can. That's a good football team...Today we had to win it obviously down the stretch with our defense."

"We're getting a little bit better in terms of our depth. We have young guys like a Nathan Be Bolling, who hasn't played a whole lot of football, but he certainly has ability. He really came in and did a nice job. "

"With all those things happening (fumbles, etc. in the first half), to be up by five points at halftime, I felt pretty good."

(On only two 1st downs in the 2nd half) "We didn't throttle down a whole lot, we just didn't execute very well."

WAKE FOREST NOTES:

QB Brian Kuklick became just the 9th player in ACC history to complete 500 career passes (505) Also Kuklick's 13th career 250-yard game Kuklick's 56-yd TD pass to D. Clark was the second longest TD pass of his career. The 56-yard TD reception was the longest reception (TD or otherwise) of Clark's career. LB Mark Makovec, a fifth-year senior and first-year starter, had his first career INT vs.

Navy two eeks ago. He had two today, including his first career INT return for a TD. The win marks WFU's first victory at Clemson since 1993, and only the second win at CU since '6. The 29 points were the most by a WFU team vs. the Tigers since 1980 (a 35-33 loss)

RB Morgan Kane had his 3rd career 100-yard rushing game today.

COACH TOMMY WEST OF CLEMSON: It's really, really, really frustrating to everybody. We're a team right now that turns the ball over too much.

We came back in athe second half, down 12-7, and thought we were ready to play, but we gave them two quick scores; then, we had a comeback of our own, but seemed to find a way to give them the ball back and they took advantage of it.

Our defense came on andplayed good, but again the turnovers came back to haunt us. We're a **Althakkkanne Collank** football team right now that's got a long way to go. But somehow, we've got to get our football team to a place that will give them a chance to win. Right now, we don't give ourselves a chance to win.

It doesn't make any difference who you play, when you give the other team seven turnovers.

It's very disappointing right now. We anticipated they would put a lot of people up around the line (because of our backfield injuries). Right we gotta find a wey to get better.
