Postgame Notes • Wake Forest

- Today's game captains for Wake Forest are #12 Tarence Williams and #25 Ed Kargbo-Okorogie.
- It didn't take long for redshirt freshman **Jason Anderson** to keep his streak going of consecutive games with a reception. He caught a 11-yarder from James MacPherson on Wake's first offensive series of the game, extending his streak to seven games (every game of his collegiate career).
- Tarence Williams put Wake' first touchdown on the board with a four-yard run in the second quarter. It was the 13th touchdown of his career and sixth of the season. Williams has scored at least one touchdown in five of seven games this year.
- Tight end Ray Thomas set up Williams' touchdown with a 26-yard reception that moved the Deacons inside the 10-yard line. It was a career-long reception for Thomas, and the longest completion by a Wake tight end since former Deacon Rhamen Love-Lane had a 26-yard reception against App State in last year's season opener.
- Walk-on Chris Rolle, making the fourth appearance of his career as the Deacons' punter, enjoyed a career-best day, averaging 43.3 yards on three punts and booting a career-long of 47 yards in the first quarter. All three of his punts were 40 yards or better.
- Defensive end Nate Bolling recorded three tackles for loss against the Tigers, moving him into a tie for sixth place on Wake's all-time tackles-for-loss chart with 32 career TFL. Former Deacon Mike McCrary is WFU's all-time tackles-for-loss leader with 46.
- Although he was forced to leave the game with a sprained ankle midway through the third quarter, Tarence Williams' 37 yards on the ground pushed him over the career 1,400-yard mark and moved him into 18th place on Wake's all-time rushing list with 1,402 career yards.
- Another young Deacon has started a streak of his own, as sophomore running back Fred Staton has scored at least one
 touchdown in each of the last four games. After recording his first career touchdown against Florida State on Sept. 29, he
 also scored one against NC State, two at Duke and one today.

Clemson vs. Wake Forest Notes

- *Clemson quarterback Woodrow Dantzler had 119 yards rushing in today's game, his ninth career 100-yard rushing performance. He is tied with Joe Burns of Georgia Tech among active ACC players in that category. The ninth 100-yard rushing effort moved Dantzler into fifth place on Clemson's career list of 100-yard rushing games. He is now just one away from Terry Allen, who had 10 in his Clemson career (1987-39).
- *Dantzler had 300 yards of total offense and at least 100-yards for the third time this year and seventh time in his Clemson career.
- *In three road games this year, Dantzler has averaged 156 yards rushing and 266 yards passing for 422 yards total on a per game basis.
- *Clemson injuries: Ben Hall (strained neck), John Leake (sprained ankle), Airese Currie (sprained foot).
 *Linebacker Chad Carson had his first career interception in today's game. Today was his 42nd game as a Tiger.
- *Clemson won the turnover margin stat for the first time this year. Clemson had tied with Georgia Tech (1-1) in that category. Clemson ranked 104th in the nation in turnover margin heading into today's game. *Walk-on wide receiver Marvis Jenkins made just the second catch of his career in today's game. It was a 19-yard reception on a 3rd and 11 play that gave the Tigers a first down. Clemson went on to score a touchdown.
- *Clemson had 16 receptions as a team and 13 of them were by freshmen. Derrick Hamilton led the way with six for 91 yards. He now has 37 receptions for the season. He broke Terry Smith's (34) Clemson freshmen record in today's game.
- *Today was Woodrow Dantzler's ninth career 200-yard passing game. He is now tied for the Clemson record in that category with Nealon Greene, who had nine from 1994-97.
- *Clemson's defense held Wake Forest to 14 points today. That is the fewest points scored by a Clemson opponent since the Wofford game on September 8. It is the fewest points scored by an opponent in an ACC game since last year's 35-14 over Maryland on October 14th.
- *Clemson has now started out 3-0 on the road in the ACC for the second year in a row, but just the third time since 1983.

On Wake Forest:

"Coach Grobe and his staff have some great schemes. They give their team a chance to win. Give credit to their players. They played hard. The key is to get ahead of them and make them play out of their game which is tough with their offense. Their offense is as good as anybody we've faced. Their new staff has done a great job and they're going to be a tough team to beat in the future."

On scoring before halftime:

"It gave us a tremendous lift. Not only because we scored immediately after they did, but it was right before the half. I think it motivated our team and deflated them a bit."

On the key to winning:

"The four (Wake Forest) turnovers were the key. We hadn't had that many all year and it makes such a difference for our offense. We're not to the point on offense where we can dominate teams and that makes field position all the more important."

Clemson Linebacker Chad Carson

On the significance of the win:

"Three road wins is a huge accomplishment especially with how balanced the league is this year."

On slowing down the Wake Forest offense:

"In the first half, they ran inside on us quite a bit and it hurt our pride. We didn't feel very good about that. When they had the fourth down early in the third quarter, they thought they could run it up the middle again but they couldn't. Stopping a team on fourth down, that's about the best feeling you can have as a defensive player."

On making the interception:

"It wasn't pretty, was it? The ball was tipped, I think. It was end over end but I caught it. I've waited four years to make an interception like that."

Clemson Wide Receiver Derrick Hamilton

On bouncing back after a loss:

"We just tried to pick up the slack after last week. We played bad and we knew we had to come out and do a better job. We did a better job but I still dropped two passes so they're still room for improvement."

On his touchdown catch:

"The play was designed for me to stop and turn around. But I saw Woody scrambling and so I took off downfield. That's the scramble rule."

Wake Forest Head Coach Jim Grobe

"We gave ourselves a chance there at the end but we lost to a good team today. I'm disappointed for the kids more than anything else. That's a pretty down lockerroom right now. They're playing as hard as they can play. We turned over the ball too many times, but I feel we got as good of an effort out of our kids as we could get."

On James MacPherson:

"James ran okay with the football and it looks like he's going to have to be our guy down the stretch. Anthony Young may work his way back in. Having the two quarterbacks helped us early this season because it forced teams to prepare for us in a couple different ways. Now, we're in a situation where we need to throw it a little bit more and that's James' stronger suit. He played hard today, he just made an unfortunate decision down the stretch."

On Turnovers:

"Really, if you look back, we had three turnovers and they had one. That's generally going to be the difference in the ballgame. You've got to take care of the ball, especially when you're down with the chance to put points on the board. You look back at a 21-14 game and turnovers are generally the difference."

On Rebounding Next Week:

"I'm proud of our kids. We play programs with a lot of history and tradition, and we are a work in progress. We're just not there yet. Our guys are giving everything they have. We just didn't win today against a good football team but we'll just keep chipping away and getting better. It's not going to happen overnight. Our kids are resilient and they'll bounce back. They've done it all year long."

Wake Forest Defensive End Calvin Pace

"I was proud of the way we stayed in the game. We almost pulled it off. Now we just have to come back against Virginia."

On Clemson QB Woodrow Dantzler:

"I'm glad he's graduating. It's hard to play against Woody Dantzler. Give him a lot of credit, he won the game for them today. I thought for the most part that we contained him but in pressure situations, he scrambled and got the first down. What can I say? Great players make great plays."

Wake Forest Quarterback James MacPherson

On Turnovers:

"We just can't turn the ball over. I was responsible for all three today and if we didn't turn the ball over, we probably would have won the game. We just have to focus on these next four games because turnovers are probably what those next four games will come down to."

On Losing Close Games:

"It's tough to take. It just hasn't happened yet but we're right there. We've got four games left so we just have to keep playing."
