Georgia Post-Game Notes...Aug. 31, 2002

*Season-Openers: With tonight's 31-28 win, Georgia is now 82-24-3 in season openers including 43-10-1 here at Sanford Stadium. The Bulldogs have won six straight season openers.

*Georgia-Clemson Series: Georgia now leads the series with Clemson 40-17-4 including 20-2 in Sanford Stadium. In games decided by seven points or less, Georgia is now 10-7-4 versus the Tigers. Georgia has won the last four meetings versus the Tigers.

*Senior Terrence Edwards set the Bulldog Career Record for TD catches tonight getting his 20th, this one coming from redshirt freshman D.J. Shockley and covering 24 yards. He also moved up to second in the Bulldog record book for Career Receiving Yards now with 2,124. Tonight, Edwards moved ahead of Lindsay Scott (2,098). Brice Hunter holds the mark with 2,373, set from 1992-95.

*Sophomore Fred Gibson became the first Bulldog to return a kickoff for a touchdown since 1990. Gibson took one back 91 yards in the second quarter. Prior to that, the last Bulldog to do that was Andre Hastings vs. Kentucky, covering 89 yards.

*Kedric Golston became the first true freshman nose tackle to start for the Bulldogs since 1994 when Travis Stroud started against Northeast Louisiana in game three of the season. Golston is the first true freshman to start on defense since Chris Clemons (LB) in 2000.

Overall, 9 True Freshman played tonight for Georgia: Along with Golston, Tony Taylor (LB), Darrius Swain (DT), DeMario Minter (DB), Tyson Browning (RB), Tim Jennings (DB), Bartley Miller (OL), Josh Brock (OL), Max Jean-Gilles (OL).

*FIRSTS: Junior Decory Bryant notched his first interception, coming off a tip by junior Kentrell Curry. The INT led to Georgia's first touchdown. For the first time since 2000, an opponent returned a fumble for a TD as Bryant McNeal took one 55 yards tonight. Prior to that, it was Byron Thweatt of Virginia in the 2000 O'ahu Bowl....In his Bulldog debut, RS-freshman QB D.J. Shockley completed three of four passes for 50 yards and 1 TD and had five rushes for 10 yards and 1 TD.

*Junior PK Billy Bennett's 43-yard field goal in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference. In his career, Bennett is now 9-for-11 from a distance between 40-49 yards. It marked Georgia's fourth comeback win in the Mark Richt era as the Bulldogs trailed 28-21 heading into the final period.

*INJURIES: Senior LB Tony Gilbert injured his right ankle in the first half and did not return in the second half. Gilbert, who normally wears jersey number 42, wore 99 tonight in honor of senior David Jacobs. Jacobs wore 99 throughout his career before being forced to retire from football last season after a stroke.

Also, senior defensive end Nic Clemons (toe) did not return in the second half due to injuries.
