Clemson Post-Game Player Quotes Ball State, September 21, 2002

Defensive End Bryant McNeal:

"They are a pretty tough team. We feel good getting a win going into an off-week. I haven't seen any Florida State film. It will be tough playing in Tallahassee. We are not playing at our peak right now, but we can be at any time. We are getting better each week and that is what counts. Having an extra week will help the team a lot, we have a bunch of guys banged up."

Wide Receiver J.J. McKelvey:

"On the touchdown catch it was just good blocking by the wide receivers. I just made one cut and then it was wide open for the touchdown. They played good defense today. We could not get anything deep except that one play (51-yard reception). Basically we took what the defense gave as today. We played kind of sloppy, but it is a victory. We have to go out to practice next week and get ready for Florida State. We are probably not ready for Florida State right now. We have to work on the mistakes we made today. But we will get better."

Quarterback Willie Simmons:

"We could have put more points on the board. We got a win, but we still feel we are not hitting on all cylinders yet. A bunch of different guys stepped up for us today. Derrick (Hamilton) made some big plays and Yusef (Kelly) ran real hard today. It felt real good to finally get a deep ball. We have not thrown as much as we have in the past. To finally get one, it feels real good.

Clemson Head Coach Tommy Bowden:

"You worry about these games when you come out unemotional. We didn't play with much emotion or discipline, but I have to learn to enjoy the wins. You talk about coming out with intensity and playing hard. This team (Ball St.) is a well-coached team, and they played extremely hard. Hats off to Coach Lynch and his staff."

"I told my players after the game, we had penalties, we had turnovers and we played uninspired, and we won 30-7... that's not all bad."

"We shouldn't have any problem with playing with emotion for the next game. It's a nationally televised Thursday night game. I tried to talk to the team about playing with inspiration for this game, because we're not going to have that problem for the next game."

"The turnovers were a very important aspect of the game. I think we converted in the second half on some of those turnovers. The defense is beginning to realize how important those things are, especially the change in momentum which really deflates the other team's momentum and increases if for us. The last few games we've been able to score off turnovers which makes it double damage for the other team."

"The defense, we always play with a lot of bodies. I'd like to play my (offense) line more, though. I think people will be excited with Charlie Whitehurst when he gets to play more."

"One of our goals was to hold Marcus Merriwether; we did not want him to leave here with 100 yards. I was real pleased and I was glad to see us come away with it."

Ball State Head Coach Bill Lynch:

(on the game): "For starters... for us to come in here and win a football game, we would have to play a near-perfect game. We needed to play perfect and we did not. We talked about three things coming into the game. Turnovers, we were not going to win this game if we did not win the turnover battle and we lost."

"The kicking game was very important, especially kickoff returns. Today there was a big difference. Derrick Hamilton is a dynamic player. Every time he gets the ball in his hands you hold your breath. Our guys tried like heck to tackle him but it was hard. We lost the battle of the kicking game today."

"We knew we could not give up any big plays. I really thought our defense played well because they kept the ball in front of them. The only exception in their play was the long pass. I have to give Clemson credit for that."

"Those were the three things we had to do to win, and we did not win those areas."

"It is hard to win any game when you lose the turnover battle. But against a team like Clemson, it is nearly impossible."

(on his overall impression of Clemson as a team): "I think Clemson is a very, very good football team. Their defensive front is very good. We get to play against teams like this a few times each year, and for comparison purposes, their talent really shows in their defensive front."

(on Clemson's offense): "Offensively, they had a lot of skill out there. Simmons has total control out on the field. They have a lot of good athletes that can score a lot of points."

Clemson vs. Ball State Notes Clemson Memorial Stadium Clemson, SC September 21, 2002

*Clemson receiver J.J. McKelvey had a career high 10 catches for a career high 123 yards in today's win over Ball State. McKelvey's previous career high was 8 catches for 73 yards against Wofford last year at Death Valley. McKelvey had two touchdowns in that Wofford game last year and one today. McKelvey is the first 100-yard receiver for Clemson this year. He is the second Clemson player to have 10 catches in a game this year, as Kevin Youngblood had 10-89 against Louisiana Tech earlier this year. This is the first time in Clemson history that two different players on the same Clemson team have had 10 catches in a game in the same season.

*Clemson had just seven games in which a player had 10 receptions prior to Coach Tommy Bowden's arrival at Clemson and now has five in his four years as head coach.

*Clemson finished the month of September with as 3-0 record. This is just the second time since 1991 that Clemson had had a perfect month of September. The Tigers were also 5-0 in September in 2000, but that is the only other perfect September since the 1991 season.

*Clemson gained at least 200 yards rushing and 200 yards passing in the same game for the 40th time in school history. Clemson is now 39-0-1 all-time when gaining at least 200 of each in the same game. This marked the first time this year, but the 13th time Clemson has done it in the 40 games Tommy Bowden has been the head coach.

*Bryant McNeal had two and half sacks today. He had a career high three sacks against Duke last year.

*Unofficially, John Leake had 10 tackles today. Including today's game, Leake now has a streak of five straight games with at least double figures in tackles. He has double figures in tackles in 10 of his last 16 games.

*Altroy Bodrick had a sack in the first period, his first sack since the Wake Forest game of 2000. He also had a fumble recover in the first half, also his first takeaway since the 2000 season.

*Clemson allowed just 220 yards of total offense today (77 came on the first Ball State drive of the game). So far this year Clemson has allowed just 1019 yards for the season, an average of 254.8 yards per game. That is a full 140 yards per game better than the average for last season. If the season ended today, that would be the best total defense average by a Clemson team since the 1990 season when Clemson led the nation in total defense by averaging 219 yards per game. Clemson has held three of the four opponents under 300 yards total offense this year. Clemson had allowed opponents at least 300 yards in 17 games heading into this season.

*Yusef Kelly had a career high rushing with 99 yards in 21 attempts. It marked the second time this year Kelly had set a career high without reaching 100 yards. He had a career high 97 yards rushing in the victory over Louisiana Tech, then topped that with the 99 today. He also had 89 in the win over Georgia Tech. So, Kelly has averaged 95 yards a game over the last three games without registering a 100-yard game.

*Derrick Hamilton continued his all-purpose performance in today's game. He had 160 all-purpose yards today as he had 36 rushing, 29 receiving, 55 in kickoff returns and 40 on punt returns. He had 256 last week against Georgia Tech, giving him 416 all-purpose yards in the last two weeks. Hamilton now has 151 yards rushing in just 11 rushes this year, an average of 13.7 yards per carry.

*Willie Simmons completed 17-25 passes today and the 68 percent completion rate is the best of his career, given a minimum of 10 attempts. He had 203 yards of total offense, his second best figure this season. His career high is 234 against Louisiana Tech.

*Nick Eason suffered a sprained knee late in the game. He will be evaluated on Sunday.
