MTSU Head Coach Andy McCollum

On the Clemson Offense:

"Whitehurst is a really good player, and he showed that today. They have great receivers. We were hoping to get some pressure on him. I think that their offensive line played better than we thought going into the game."

On the play of Charlie Whitehurst and Airese Currie:

"They executed. Charlie Whitehust is a great quarterback and we gave him too much time. And it's not just those two. Clemson's offense played today and they executed today. They ran the ball better today. They mixed it up well. We had chances to get off the field and we didn't. They had a lot of guys making plays and I think that it starts with their offensive line. We felt like we could hang in there up front, and we got whipped. We got whipped up front and that makes it easy on Whitehurst and that makes it easier on their receivers."

On Airese Currie and the wide receivers:

"He can fly. And then you look around and you've got a 6'5" #17 (Youngblood) and a 6'5" #21 (Hamilton). We just don't have big enough corners. Our guys compete like everything and they try, but those guys are special. Their offense was clicking today, but it doesn't start clicking unless it starts up front, and it clicked up front today."

On MTSU's offense"

"We had 12 play drives, and then we would get a penalty. We had two other drives, and then we would get another penalty. We can't do that. We are not good enough to come on the road playing the teams that we play and then stop a drive on our own. We didn't put a lot of points on the board, but I thought that our offense played well."

Head Coach Tommy Bowden Quotes

On the decisive victory

"I think our seniors did a good job of keeping us together. This was not a conference team, not a team we knew a lot about, but our seniors did a good job responding mentally. We've gotten a little bit better every week, which is all you can ask the team to do. We had penalties in the kicking game last week and we didn't have any today. I thought the players concentrated well and eliminated a lot of mistakes they made last week."

On the passing attack

"I though the line did a good job protecting. Charlie threw the ball well. Our offense staff, Mike O'Cain, Brad Scott, Dabo Sweeny, Burton Burns, and Ron West, did a good job with the preparation of the offense, but execution is the key when the play is called."

On Charlie Whitehurst

"He's still just a young guy learning. His 23-28 performance with 300 yards was a high percentage. The line has to protect and the receivers have to catch and run the right routes. A lot goes on Charlie's shoulders. Nowadays people jam the box so you have to be able to throw the ball too."

On Jim Phillips

"He meant a lot to our team, not as much as to someone who's been listening to him for 36 years. He was a piece of Clemson history for those that had been listening to him for so many years on the radio. Our team didn't know him as well, but over the week, they felt how much he meant to the university. There was no doubt he was on their mind and possibly created a sense of urgency for our team."

To the fans

"I really appreciate the fans. They keep showing up, cheering and motivating the team. It really means a lot when the team comes out and the fans are there. I appreciate their patience. This team is continuing to improve week to week."

Clemson Player Quotes Post-Game vs. Middle Tennessee

Quarterback Charlie Whitehurst:

"It feels good to get a win, especially after the way Middle Tennessee played Georgia last week. Hopefully, this will be a stepping stone for us. I don't know where we're going to go from here. Hopefully we can stay in the I-formation some and have a balanced attack.

"I just like scoring points, I don't care how we do it. We could run the wishbone all the way down the field and that would be fine with me, as long as we score. We have to keep striving for a balanced attack, and hopefully that will make us a better team."

Linebacker John Leake:

"Next week we've got a tough game against a quality ACC opponent, so it feels good to get to 2-1 going down to Atlanta. When you lose your first game, a lot of people may get down on you. But we have stayed together as a team and it's still only the third game of the season. We're 2-1 and we want to be 11-1, that's our goal. Hopefully we'll go down there next week and win the game."

Wide receiver Airese Currie:

"I started off with a bad drop, and I was pretty upset about that. So I just wanted to come out and play hard and keep getting after it. I was not aware of the single-game catch record until we came back to the locker room and Coach Bowden was giving his speech. It means a lot to me, because I worked hard in the spring and summer and I'm glad to see that it's paying off. I just want to come out every Saturday and do the same thing." Clemson vs. Middle Tennessee Notes Death Valley September 13, 2003

*Clemson quarterback Charlie Whitehurst completed 23-28 passes for 298 yards and four touchdowns in today's Clemson win. He is now 46 for his last 59 passing, a .779 completion percentage, and 599 yards over the last two games.

*Whitehurst tied his own Clemson single game record for touchdown passes with his four scores today. He had four against Duke and North Carolina last year. Whitehurst has now started just eight games in his Clemson career and has thrown for four touchdown passes three times. He already has 16 TD passes for his career, tied for ninth in Clemson history with Jimmy Addison, Rodney Williams and Willie Simmons. Williams was at the game today as the sideline reporter on the Clemson radio network. Simmons was a former teammate who now plays for The Citadel.

*Wide receiver Airese Currie had 12 catches for 133 yards today. He established a Clemson single game record with the 12 catches. The previous mark was 11 set by Phil Rogers against North Carolina in 1965 and by Rod Gardner against Marshall in 1999. Clemson had lost both of those games. Currie now has 20 receptions for the year in just three games. He had just 16 catches all of last year.

*Clemson had 31 first downs today, tied for the third highest total for a single game in Clemson history and the most by a Clemson team since 1981 when Clemson had a record 35 first downs in a 82-24 win over Wake Forest.

*Clemson quarterback Charlie Whitehurst now has a career passing efficiency rating of 135.62. He has jumped to first place in Clemson history in that area. He was 11th after the Georgia game, but has now moved to first with his recent two performances. He is also Clemson's career leader in completion percentage at 60.97 percent.

*Whitehurst also had his best rushing game as a Tiger with 9-41 on the ground. His previous best was 11 yards rushing in eight attempts against Maryland in 2002.

*Running back Kyle Browning made his first career start today. He responded with a team best11-53 rushing. Entering the game he had played in just three games in his career and gained just 29 yards. *Entering today's game, Clemson running backs had combined for just 163 yards and a 3.26 average in the first two games. Today, Clemson running backs gained 132 yards at a 4.0 clip.

*Derrick Hamilton had 4-78 receiving and two scores. It was the first game with two TDs receiving for Hamilton. Hamilton now has 1470 passing yards in his career, and moved into the top 10 in Clemson history with his performance today. He moved past Phil Rogers by one yard with the performance. Ironically, Rogers also lost his single game reception yardage record today with Airese Currie's performance

*Jamaal Fudge was credited with 12 tackles from the press box today, a career high by far. In fact, he had just 11 in the first two games combined.
