Clemson Head Coach Tommy Bowden Quotes November 8, 2003 Vs. Florida State

Overall

"Our players prepared hard and we even had a good concentrative preparation day at the hotel. I'm very happy and proud for the players. They invested the time and the effort for those guys to be rewarded like they are. Our staff had a good plan. John Lovett and Brad Scott had a plan for the players, but of course it's up to the players to execute."

On defeating his father

"I hadn't heard before that it was the first son to defeat his father in college football, but Sports Information Director Tim Bourret told me it was the highest ranked team a Clemson team has ever defeated. For our players, I was happy for them. It's something they can take with them for a long time, like the Georgia Tech win being the largest margin of victory in 100 years. This team has worked hard. It might not be the most talented team Clemson has ever had, but they never quit. I'm happy those things are accomplished for those guys because they'll remember that for a lifetime."

On team's confidence

"I wish I could say I knew we would win, but no one ever knows from Saturday to Saturday. I think the ray of hope is that anything is possible and that our players know that. I told the team first thing in the locker room after the loss at Wake Forest last week that I fully expect to win this game. What it came down to was personnel. Our guys just kept executing and performing."

On the win from a career perspective

"I think it's probably the highest ranked team I've ever defeated myself. To beat my father, the winningest coach in college football, obviously they're going to be well-coached. They have good players because of how they've recruited from a facility standpoint for the last few years. It's a big win in that regard, but it's also just a big win for the players. In the coaching profession, you really get your joy from seeing players reactions in this kind of situation."

Clemson Player Quotes Post-Game vs. Florida State

Quarterback Charlie Whitehurst:

"It worked out like we thought it would. So it was a good thing. Our backs were against the wall and we were blown out last week. We really took it to them tonight. I'm just proud of all the guys. It was a great team effort. I feel especially good for Coach Bowden. We haven't beaten them in 14 years, and somebody had to beat them. I'm glad it was us. This was a long time coming for Clemson. I don't know if they took us lightly or not. The setting was great. We had them at home; the fans were behind us. It just worked out for us."

Kicker Aaron Hunt:

"We're doing pretty well in our kicking operation now, and having some good luck along with it. The career scoring record is nice, but it doesn't compare to beating Florida State. That's something you dream of as a kid. We won a big game tonight."

Linebacker John Leake:

"We tried to make them one dimensional, and make Chris Rix beat us. We forced some turnovers, and got the offense going. They played great. We just came out here to play and win. You have to get up for Florida State. They're #3 in the country, at least until Monday. But don't get me wrong, we beat a great team tonight."

Wide receiver Derrick Hamilton:

"Their defensive backs played good against us, but they played a lot less man coverage and a lot more soft coverage. I thought we did pretty well against the coverages they showed us. We were successful moving the ball. We kept getting first downs.

"A lot of the all-purpose yards comes from great blocking from the team. The coaching staff finds different ways to get me the ball."

On the 58-yard touchdown:

"We lined up and saw what the coverage was. I think it was Cover 3 and the safety rolled down onto me. That gave us a chance to just fly by. Charlie just tossed it up and let me go get it."

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden Post-Game Press Conference

On QB Chris Rix:

"I thought that there was way too much heat on him, and he was not hot."

On Clemson QB Charlie Whitehurst:

"I knew that he was capable of playing like that. I think that he is one of the best passers in the country. He has the physical tools that you want in a quarterback. He is tall and big."

On meeting with Tommy after the game:

"Well, I couldn't really hear him. I told him that his job should probably be good for about another five days. I'm happy for him, but I'm not happy for us. I tried not to assist him in any way. You knew that something like this was coming sooner or later, but this was very unlikely tonight. It was thorough (Clemson's win) and it wasn't even close."

On coming into the game:

"It was a terrible situation coming into the game. We played so good against Notre Dame, and they played so bad against Wake Forest. And when you put those two against each other, it's almost like a brain transplant."

On Clemson's defense:

"Well, they forced us into a passing game a lot. They kept great field position. When they gave the ball up, it was way down on our end of the field. And when we have to start throwing down there, we are really taking a chance. They blitzed us and we couldn't pick it up well enough. They had a great plan. It was almost like they had an open date, but they didn't."

We didn't play our best and didn't do the things we needed to do to win the game. Now our backs are against the wall. It doesn't get any easier next week against NC State. "The Clemson guy pushed me from behind and I ran into one of their receivers," said Darnell Dockett. "That's what happened and they called a flagrant foul. It was a terrible feeling standing on the sidelines and not being able to help my team."

"Clemson outplayed us tonight," said Chris Rix. My hats off to them team and their coaching staff, especially their defensive coaches. You can't take anything away from them, they earned the win. They blitzed a lot more than they usually do and that confused us a little bit. Their defense surprised us with some of the stuff they did. That's what you have to do to beat a quality opponent. We couldn't make the big play with the deep ball that we had been making this year. Our focus now is on a 10-win season and getting to a BCS bowl. That starts with NC State next weekend.

FSU has had at least seven different receivers record a reception in every game this season. Chris Rix connected with nine different receivers in the game.

It Has Been Awhile

Junior place kicker Xavier Beitia's missed 40-yard field in the third quarter was his first miss since he missed a 38-yard attempt at Virginia on October 18. Beitia had made five straight including 11 of his last 12 prior to tonight's miss. He later kicked a 46-yard field goal with 3:25 left in the third quarter to give the Seminoles their first points of the night.

Tigers On The Score

Clemson's 26 points is the most allowed by the Florida State defense this season and the most since Georgia scored 26 in the Sugar Bowl on January 1, 2003.

Stovall Shines At Clemson

Junior wide receiver Chauncey Stovall had a career-high four receptions for a career-high 131 yards and one touchdown. His 71-yard touchdown reception was also a career long. Stovall became the third different Seminole wide receiver to have a 100-yard receiving game this season. Florida State has had three 100-yard receivers in the last four games.

Fabian Walker Has Career Night

Fabian Walker's 11 completions and 21 attempts for 164 yards (all in the fourth quarter) were all career-highs. His 71-yard touchdown pass to Chauncey Stovall was also a career-long completion. Walker came into the game 19-for-29 for 178 yards with two touchdowns on the season.
