Coach Jim Grobe post game quotes

"One thing we wanted to do today was run the football and we had some success doing it. Not as much as we had planned, though. We did want to throw the football today but we didn't have a lot of success protecting our quarterback. We didn't really consider that a series so we put him back in because we wanted to play him two or three series. When we got down to crunch time there in the fourth quarter we felt like it was time to play our experienced quarterback. In this type of environment we felt like we should probably have Cory (Randolph) in there are the end.

Our passing game is pretty much the same package we've had in the past, we added some new routes in there but its pretty much the same. The thing that disappointed me today was that we ended up in so many 2^{nd} and 10 situations. For our passing game to be effective we have to run the ball which opens up our play action.

I thought Chris's (Barclay) performance was good. I don't think we blocked particularly well for him but he ran hard. Chris Barcaly is a very good football player and made a lot of things happen today.

Their last drive they hit a couple of passes underneath and just did a really good job of moving the ball down the field. I was disappointed they were able to drive down the field at the end but you really have to give them a lot of credit. I thought the defense played pretty well, we gave up 9 points in the kicking game on the punt return and the blocked punt.

I can't really explain it but when Wake Forest plays Clemson you should want to watch because it is going to be fun. Our kids enjoy the rivalry and certainly their kids were ready to play. We have had some close games, it's a great atmosphere down here I just wish we could have come away with a win.

Its totally to Clemson's credit that they came back and won. We had some chances in the 2nd half to score some more points and we had good field position but we just couldn't get it done. We didn't give it to them, its totally to Clemson's credit.

"We knew they were going to come with a lot of pressure on Charlie. Once I got past the line I knew I was open. I just wanted the ball to come down quickly into my hands. Other than the Peach Bowl this is the biggest play I have had at Clemson. It means a lot to get this win. Wake Forest beat us by 30 last year. That makes it even more special.

Clemson vs. Wake Forest Notes Death Valley September 4, 2004

*Clemson is now 4-0 in overtime in its history, 3-0 under Tommy Bowden. Bowden's other overtime wins came against Georgia Tech in 2001 (47-44), and Virginia last year (30-27). Clemson's other overtime victory took place in 1997 against Duke (29-20). Yes, it was nine-point margin, as Clemson scored a field goal, then Rahim Abdullah ran an interception back for a score for the nine-point margin. *Charlie Whitehurst is now the first quarterback at Clemson to win two overtime games. *In five overtime periods in its history, Clemson has given up just nine points on three field goals. No opponent has recorded a first down against Clemson in the five overtime periods and four games. *The attendance for today's game was 79,500 and that included 750 tickets that went to residents of Florida and South Georgia who left their homes as the result of Hurricane Frances. Clemson gave those people

who showed a drivers license from that area a maximum of two free tickets to today's game. *Clemson had a pair of 100-yard receivers in today's game as Airese Currie had 152 yards on nine catches and Chansi Stuckey had 8-112. It is just the third time in Clemson history that the Tigers have had two 100-yard receivers in the same game. The other games took place against NC State in 1998 and at Duke in 2002.

*Currie's 152 yards receiving were a career high and rank in a tie for sixth best single game in Clemson history. The record is 182 by Rod Gardner at North Carolina in 2000. Currie's performance today was his career high, and tied for the second most ever by a Tiger in Death Valley. That record is 161 by Perry Tuttle vs. Wake Forest in 1981. Currie's total was a record for a Clemson player in the season opener. *Charlie Whitehurst's 288 yards passing were the most in Clemson history by a Tiger quarterback in a season opener, as was his 303 yards of total offense. That total offense record had been 297 yards by Billy Hair against Presbyterian back in 1951.

*Justin Miller scored on a 69-yard punt return on the final play of the first quarter. It was the second straight game in Death Valley that the junior had returned a punt for a touchdown. He had a 63-yard punt return for a score against Duke in the season finale of 2003 in Clemson Memorial Stadium. Miller now has two punt returns for touchdown in his career tying the Clemson career record also held by Shad Bryant, Don Kelley and Donnell Woolford.

*Miller also has a kickoff return for a score, giving him three kick returns for touchdown in his career. Miller is the first Tiger to have three total kick returns for touchdowns in a career.

*Miller's return was the seventh punt or kickoff return for a touchdown since Tommy Bowden became head coach in 1999. Clemson once went 999 kick and punt returns combined without a score over a 17-year period (1970-87). Clemson then broke that streak on the 1000th return on a 78-yard punt return by Donnell Woolford against Georgia Tech. Later in that game, Joe Henderson went 95 yards for a touchdown on a kickoff return.

*Kyle Browning has played less than 10 snaps in each of his last two games, but has had a key touchdown in each contest. He scored on an eight-yard run for a score on a "Panther Play" against Tennessee in the Peach Bowl that ended the 2003 season. Then had the game winner in overtime on an 11-yard pass from Charlie Whitehurst in today's game.

*Clemson was 4-17 when trailing entering the fourth quarter under Tommy Bowden prior to today's victory. Clemson trailed 20-19 entering the fourth quarter today.

*The three made field goals by Stephen Furr were the first made field goals of his Clemson career. He did not appear in a game in 2003 after lettering as the kickoff man in 2002.

Tommy Bowden quotes:

They had our number, they beat us by 30 last year and we won by 7. We are making progress. Wake Forest is a well coached team, they have really given us problems with their offense and their defense. Somebody said earlier that we really had a lull in the 3rd quarter. Well I think that they had something to do with that. They are a good team. I wish that we could go out there for 4 straight quarters, go down the field and execute every single series but if you are going to play in this league, that's going to be tough to do.

If they do something real good, it can affect your execution. They had great defensive calls, but just didn't match up.

I don't know how we will respond, but the things that happened out there on the field, you can't get that environment in the spring game, you can't get that environment during 2 a days, the momentum changes, it looks like you are going to lose the game. The kids never gave up, it was the longest game in Clemson history I think, some of the situations that were created out on the field tonight we responded to in a very positive way. I'm hoping that this will do some things for our character and our heart, things like that that you have to have experience and that usually has to happen at some point and time during the season. We protected well, we caught well, I think that Charlie made some good throws. It was a combination of those things. I think that Mike did a good job of calling the plays. There was the drive with our backs against the wall, you have to do it or the game is over.

You ask the players not to give up and to play for 60 minutes, and as a coach you can't show those signs on the sidelines. My attitude was one of hey, you take one catch, you have to catch 1 out of 3 or 4. You have 4 downs to catch 1. You try to give some hope, say something positive to get the kind of results that we got. You know that you have to be productive.

I'll be anxious to see once we get the film on them. We do a lot of passes, I don't know about 40, 41 passes, so we played good enough against a team that we struggled against last year. Off the top of my head I would say that we did pretty good.

You look for more physical mis-matches than you do anything else. Kelvin is pretty good at that. Charlie did a good job of throwing it. It's tough to stop because those guys, I'm talking about the defense, don't practice it. You look at that deep ball that they completed against us, some of our secondary has not seen a lot of deep balls, and they totally misjudged it. On those fade type throws, offensively you practice them an hour a day or an hour a week, defensively you practice maybe 5 minutes a week.

The only way to go with the running game from here is up. I don't know how Georgia Tech is going to play us. A lot depends on what type of defense you play.
