"I was very pleased with Tyrone Moss' effort tonight.

"There was way too much pressure on Kyle Wright.

"This is a huge, huge win for us. They (Clemson) are a good football team. To beat Texas A&M and then go on the road and beat Maryland is tough. They are a good team.

Clemson vs. Miami (FL) notes

*This was Clemson's first overtime loss in history. The Tigers were a perfect 5-0 in overtime games dating back to the beginning of the rule in 1996. Clemson was the only 5-0 team in college football in overtime games entering Saturday.

*Clemson and Miami (FL) have now gone to overtime in their two games since the Hurricanes joined the ACC. The two teams don't play again in the regular season until 2009 in Miami.

*Today's game was the longest in Clemson history in terms of overtime periods and time. The previous long in both areas was against Wake Forest last year, a double overtime game that took 3:58 to play. Today's game was a triple overtimer that took 4:10 to play.

*Clemson did not commit a turnover until the final play of this game, its 77th play. Clemson did not commit a turnover in the first two games, a time period that covered 137 plays. Thus, Clemson went

the first 213 plays of this season without a turnover.

*Clemson tight end Cole Downer was brought to the Oconee Hospital in Seneca for a spleen problem before the conclusion of the game. We will get a report on his condition on Sunday. In the first half, Downer caught his first touchdown pass as a Tiger, an eight-yard aerial from Charlie Whitehurst. It was his first scoring pass as a Tiger, but his seventh as a college football player. He had six TD receptions in 2002 at Hampden Sydney.

*Chansi Stuckey had seven receptions for 71 yards. It tied for his second most catches in a game as a Clemson Tiger. He had eight catches in the double overtime game against Wake Forest last year and seven in the final game of the season against South Carolina.

*Clemson got five sacks for 40 yards on defense. The five sacks were by five different players. Two of the players, Lionel Richardson and Donnell Clark recorded their first career sacks.

*Charlie Whitehurst's 65 yards run in the first half was the longest of his career. His previous long was 26 yards. Whitehurst had just 71 yards rushing in his career prior to the 65-yard run, which was the longest by a Clemson quarterback since Woody Dantzler raced 75 yards against Virginia in 2000.

*Charlie Whitehurst attempted 55 passes, tying the Clemson single game record. Patrick Sapp attempted 55 at Maryland in 1992. Whitehurst's previous high was 54 passes against Duke in 2002. Whitehurst had 31 completions, the second highest total in Clemson history. The only total that is higher is the 34 he completed at Duke in 2002.

*Whitehurst set a Clemson Memorial Stadium record for both pass attempts and completions with his 31-55 showing. Clemson Memorial Stadium opened in 1942.

*The passing yardage figure(288) for Whitehurst today was his high figure since he threw for 288 yards against Wake Forest in the opener of 2002. He added a team best 58 yards rushing, giving him 346 yards of total offense, the second highest total of his career. The only figure that is higher is the 414 he had at Duke in 2002, which was his first career start.

*Whitehurst had 58 yards rushing, his career high. His previous best was just 39 yards rushing in the 2003 victory over Florida State. It marked the first time a quarterback had led Clemson in rushing since the 2002 Florida State game when Willie Simmons led the Tigers in a loss in Tallahassee with 13-50.

*Curtis Baham continued his fine play this afternoon with 5-87 receiving, including a clutch twoyard touchdown catch in overtime on a fourth down play. Baham had three career touchdown receptions in his first 26 games at Clemson and now has three in the last two games. His 87 receiving yards today were a career high.

*Jad Dean kicked three more field goals today and is now 9-10 for the season. His only miss was a 50-yard attempt today. Dean is now 21-25 for his career at Clemson and all four misses have come against Miami. Last year he was 1-4 in the Orange Bowl with the misses coming from 52, 47 and 44 yards. His miss today broke a streak of 12 consecutive made field goals, just two off Obed Ariri's record of 14 in a row set in 1980. Dean is now 15-15 in his career inside the 40.

*Clemson continued its incredible run of close games. Today marked the ninth game in the last 14 that came down to the last minute of play. Clemson is now 6-3 in those games. Today marked the second straight week Clemson had trailed by 10 points in the fourth quarter and either won or forced overtime.

*Miami (FL) became just the second team to win its first game in Death Valley since 1978. The other was Marshall in 1999 by a 13-10 score.

*Clemson is now 9-5 in matchups of two top 25 teams in Death Valley. The Clemson vs. Boston College game next week could also be a matchup of top 25 teams.
