Coach Tommy Bowden quotes:

On passing game:

"Yeah, I don't think we were real sharp, but we made some downfield throws, and that accounted for the yards. Probably not one of our better performances."

On facing Temple:

"The players were real excited coming off of that N.C. State game. I think that they did a good job facing an 0-7 team in Temple and systematically taking care of business. It had been a long time since we didn't play our best and still won by 30 points."

"You want to go out and play your best every week. It is only an 11 week season. In the mind of a 21 year old, sometimes that is harder said than done as you face different opponents from week to week. I was real pleased with our defense. We came out and played aggressive., especially up front. We had to settle for some field goals, and we jumped offsides a couple of times.

"We had 10 different players get a tackle for loss, so we had a contribution from a lot of different players."

On depth:

"I saw some guys make some plays who don't get to play very much. Littleberry came in and got a sack, Cannon came in and made a couple of plays. The young skill guys on offense have been playing all year, and they made some big plays. Harris had a touchdown late. We wanted to execute the offense, not just hand the ball off. For us to get Procotor some at-bats for later in the year, or maybe for next year.

"I have been talking about Aaron Kelly a lot lately. He has continued to improve and we saw that today. He is a humble player and is respected by his teammates. That was quite a performance today."

On rush defense

"The rush defense was very good. We started substituting and lost some of the rhythm and let them get a couple passes. We held them to 12 yards rushing which is great. We almost had a shutout, but they scored late. I thought that we were a little sharper on defense than offense."

Bobby Wallace Quotes

- "I think our kids played extremely hard. I'm proud of them. We played an excellent football team and they have an excellent quarterback."
- "A big key for them was early in the game, they were completing most of their passes. They were also very efficient on third down conversions."
- "We got a little something going there towards the end of the half but then we fumbled it at the one."
- "It was kind of ironic because 17-7 was the score at halftime when we beat Virginia Tech when they were number 10 in the country. I had that same feeling. If we could have punched it in right there, we would have had a lot of momentum at halftime. We did use it as a positive since we were able to drive the ball down to the one."
- "In the second half, the kids still came out and played hard. We get tired though. We only have the 50 scholarship kids that we recruited and our défensive players play on special teams. By the end of the game against a team like this, we're just worn out. But I thought we kept fighting."

On Clemson having to suspend players but not wanting to be disrespectful to an opponent

- "I would have looked at it as realistic. They play Duke in a few weeks and that's homecoming and an ACC game. And we're struggling. I wouldn't have taken it as an insult. It's a realistic thing for his program but at the same time, I understand his thought process."
- "Backup quarterbacks have to get prepared. They might have to come in next week and win the game. So I don't look at that as disrespectful."
- "I wasn't very confident with our passing game. To be honest with you, I was pleasantly surprised. Mike McGann had a great game. Joey got hurt. He bruised his ribs. It was not an elected thing to do. Mike has been through so much in five years. I can't say enough about what kind of a person and team player he is. I was excited for him to play well. Our receivers also played well. That was probably the best game we've had passing all year."

On how Clemson stacks up with other ACC opponents Temple has faced

"They compare exactly with Miami and Virginia Tech. They have great speed and great athletes. Clemson has had some tough losses but they're an excellent football team with an excellent quarterback. They are an excellent team that could beat anybody they play."

Clemson vs. Temple Notes

October 22, 2005, Clemson Memorial Stadium

- *Today's final score of Clemson 37, Temple 7 was the exact same score of Clemson's victory over the Owls in 1991, the only previous meeting between the two teams.
- *Charlie Whitehurst had 300 yards of total offense and became Clemson's career leader in that category. He broke the record of 8,798 yards of total offense by Woody Dantzler from 1998-2001. Whitehurst now has 8,959 for his career and obviously needs just 41 yards at Georgia Tech to hit the 9000-yard mark for his career. When he does he will become just the 10th player in ACC history to reach 9000 yards in total offense. He had 307 yards passing and -7 rushing in the contest
- *Whitehurst threw two more touchdown passes today and now has a Clemson record 46 for his career. He already had that record, as Dantzler had 41 from 1998-01. Whitehurst also moved into sole possession of fourth place on Clemson's all-time wins list among quarterbacks. It was Clemson's 22nd victory with Whitehurst as the starter, as he moved ahead of Steve Fuller and Mike Eppley, who both had 21 for their respective careers. Fuller played from 1975-78 and Eppley from 1980-84.
- *Aaron Kelly had seven receptions for 155 yards and a touchdown today. The 155 yards were a Clemson freshman single game record, breaking the mark of 139 receiving yards by Roscoe Crosby against Duke in 2001. Kelly's 155 receiving yards were the sixth most in Clemson history in a single game for an individual regardless of class. Rod Gardner has the record with 182 against North Carolina in 2000. It was the most by a Clemson receiver since Derrick Hamilton had 175 at Maryland in 2003.
- *Kelly's 155 receiving yards were just three of f the single game best by an ACC player this year. Maryland's Vernon Davis had 158 receiving yards against West Virginia on September 17.
- *Kelly and La'Donte both had their first career touchdowns today. Kelly's came on a 34-yard scoring pass from Whitehurst in the third period and the Harris touchdown came on a 16-yard scoring pass from Will Proctor in the fourth quarter. It was also Proctor's first career touchdown pass.
- *The Clemson defense also had some firsts today. Antonio Clay, Dorell Scott and Xavier Littleberry all had their first career sacks this afternoon.
- *Scott had two recovered fumbles in today's game to tie a Clemson record. He is the 15th Clemson player on record to do it, the first since Kelton Dunnican had two fumble recoveries against Virginia in 1996.
- *Clemson played 68 players in today's game, including 19 who are freshmen or red-shirt freshmen.
- *Clemson had six sacks today, the most by the Clemson defense since the Tigers had 11 in a victory over Utah State in 2004.
- *Clemson had 514 yards of total offense, the most by a Clemson team since the Tigers had 542 at South Carolina in 2003.
- *Clemson now has 1003 three yards over its last two games, 489 at NC State and 514 today. This is the first time Clemson has had 1000 yards of total offense over consecutive games since 2003 when Clemson had 486 against Duke and 542 at South Carolina for 1028 yards. This is also the first time Clemson has scored at least 30 points in consecutive games since the Duke and South Carolina games in 2003.
- *Clemson's 359 passing yards today rank as the third highest single game figure in Clemson history. The only passing yardage games that are higher are the 420 passing yards against Duke in 2002 in Durham (Charlie Whitehurst's first career start) and the 364 yards passing by the Tigers at Duke in 1963. Thus, this was the most passing yards by a Clemson team in the history of Clemson Memorial Stadium (opened in 1942).
- *Kyle Browning scored his second career touchdown reception, a 41-yard scoring reception from Whitehurst in the first quarter. It was the second touchdown reception of the senior's career. The other was an 11-yard scoring reception from Whitehurst in the overtime victory vs. Wake Forest in 2004.
- *The 678 yards passing by the two teams combined were the sixth most in a Clemson game in history, the second highest combined figure in the history of Memorial Stadium. Clemson (329) and NC State combined for 703 yards for the Stadium record in 1998. The overall record is 783 by Clemson and Texas Tech in the 2002 Tangerine Bowl.
- *Jad Dean booted three more field goals in today's gave and is now 17-20 for the season. That is the most field goals in a season by a Clemson kicker since Aaron Hunt had 18 in 2003. Dean still has at least four games remaining. The record is 23 by Obed Ariri in 1980. Ariri led the nation that year. Dean was second in the nation entering today's game.
- *Clemson averaged 7.7 yards per play today, the third best average in the Bowden era. The only figures that are better are an 8.0 average against Duke in 2001 and the 8.1 against South Carolina in 2003.
