Clemson Head Coach Dabo Swinney

Thoughts on the Game:

"The team came out and competed today. I'm glad that we had zero turnovers, which was great for our team. Both of the teams battled it out today, and it came down to a few plays. Unfortunately, they made a couple more plays at the end of the game. It's a tough loss for our team, but I'm proud that we played consistently, and competed today."

Thoughts on the Defense:

"We didn't do a good job on the quarterback (Andy Dalton) today. We did a great job defending Joseph Turner (#24), but we didn't stop the rush from the quarterback as well as we needed to today. "

Thoughts on the Offense:

"I liked our effort up front. We did not have Chris Hairston today; however, everyone stepped up and we were able to run the ball today. We had some big plays, but the two critical drops in the end zone hurt us. Overall, our kids fought hard today. Again, TCU just made a couple more plays than us."

TCU Head Coach Gary Patterson

Thoughts on the Game:

"That's a good Clemson football team. We feel very fortunate to be able to have done it. We had to come up with a couple of plays on offense. They had a very good defense. We had chances. Missed a field goal, and probably should have kicked one early. I felt like on that fourth down they stopped us. When you go to someone else's house you have to take the game early. I thought we could get a yard, but they did a great job. We made it interesting defensively. We stopped people when we had to. In the last couple of drives we made them kick a field goal. I said going into the game that we had to stop the run and we could not allow Spiller or Ford to catch big passes, and it about beat us. Our kids came back, they fought and made some plays. I think this will go a long way for our confidence to go and win on the road two out of the first three weeks of the season especially coming to the East coast against a very tough ACC and give ourselves a chance to be successful."

On his team's first half touchdown:

"Sometimes you have to be lucky. We didn't plan that pass that way. Sometimes you have to have a little luck. We got fortunate on the pass. When you play good people somebody has to make a play on offense. We hurt ourselves today with penalties. It could have cost us on both sides of the ball. It was just a good football game."

On the play of Andy Dalton:

"He ran the football. We had some stuff we felt like we could do in the read option game and we were able to get him loose. We had some surprises that worked well. We did just enough."

On the impact of the rain:

"I don't know. It was raining on both teams. They moved the ball down two times and we had to stop them on both ends."

On Kerley getting more touches:

"You just do what you need to do. We got him loose a couple of times and we need to do a better job of getting him loose on punts and kickoffs. They had some good coverage today. The thing that was also big for us was that we did not allow Spiller or Ford to have any punt or kickoff returns in the game. For us that was unbelievable and we also got great field position out of it."

Team Notes

*Entering the game, TCU is 54-1 under head coach Gary Patterson when allowing 17 points or less.

*TCU trailed at halftime (10-7) for the first time this season.

*Approximately 500 people gathered inside TCU's Daniel-Meyer Coliseum to watch the ESPN 360 broadcast on the video board.

*TCU started the same 11 players on defense for the third consecutive game.

*TCU earned its first win at Clemson in its second opportunity. The Frogs lost 3-0 in their only other trip to Death Valley, on Oct. 23, 1965. Overall, TCU evened its all-time series record with the Tigers at 2-2.

*TCU played turnover-free football Saturday, the first game this season the Frogs went without a turnover. For the season, the Frogs have only three turnovers through three games.

*TCU improved to 13-3 against opponents from BCS conferences since 2002.

*TCU won its 27th straight contest when attempting 34 passes or fewer. The Frogs threw 26 passes Saturday.

Individual Notes

*With 226 yards; Andy Dalton became TCU's second all-time leading passer with 5,326. He moved past Steve Stamp (5,123, 1978-81) with a 58-yard first-quarter completion to Ed Wesley. It was also the Horned Frogs' longest play from scrimmage this season. Max Knake is TCU's career leader in passing yards with 7,370 (1992-95).

*Dalton rushed for 86 yards Saturday, the second-best single-game total of his career. He set his career high of 91 yards versus Stanford last year.

*Curtis Clay's 6-yard touchdown reception from Dalton represented his first collegiate score.

*With 13 and eight stops, respectively, linebacker Daryl Washington and weak safety Alex Ibiloye both posted career highs in tackles for the second straight game. Ibiloye accomplished the feat with six first-quarter stops. Washington and Ibiloye had nine and four tackles, respectively, last week versus Texas State.

*Washington's 13 stops are a team season high.

*Antoine Hicks' 25-yard fourth-quarter touchdown reception was his first career scoring catch. He reached the end zone for the first time last week on a 4-yard touchdown run against Texas State.

*Wide receiver Jonathan Jones made his first career start.

*Wide receiver Jeremy Kerley set career bests with five receptions and 63 yards receiving.
