### Postgame Notes

Clemson 31, Maryland 7

Quick hits: Maryland fell to 4-2 on the season with the loss to Clemson ... the Tigers snapped a two-game losing streak to the Terrapins ... Maryland is now 1-1 in ACC play ... Maryland outgained Clemson 350 yards to 213.

Running and Throwing: Da'Rel Scott threw a 4-yard touchdown pass to Danny O'Brien in the second quarter. Scott took a pitch from O'Brien, ran to his right, and then threw to O'Brien on the left side of the end zone. It was the second TD pass of his career — he also had a 9-yard TD pass against Wake Forest on 10/18/08. Scott also had 18 rushing yards.

**Scott Joins 3,000 Club**: With 22 all-purpose yards on the day, Da'Rel Scott became the 10<sup>th</sup> player in school history to reach 3,000 all-purpose yards in his career. The senior has 3,007 in his career.

O'Brien Makes Third Start: Danny O'Brien made his third career start and first on the road, and was very solid through three quarters. His three interceptions in the fourth quarter were the first of his career. He had gone his first 96 collegiate passes without a pick. As a team, Maryland had gone its last 125 pass attempts without an INT. O'Brien's interception that was returned for a TD Still, O'Brien went 24-of-45 for 302 yards. That's the most passing yards by a Maryland QB since Chris Turner had 307 against Wake Forest on 10/10/09.

**Long Catch**: Matt Furstenburg's 53-yard reception in the third quarter was the longest by a Terps tight end since Jason Goode had a 57-yarder at Clemson on 11/4/06. Maryland now has 13 plays of 50 yards or longer this season.

Yeatman Gets Involved: Senior tight end Will Yeatman, playing in his first game without a cast after he broke a finger in the preseason, recorded his first receptions as a Terrapin. The transfer from Notre Dame had three catches for 48 yards on Maryland's lone scoring drive, including a one-handed catch that got Maryland to the 5-yard line.

Terp Tight Ends: With Matt Furstenbug's five catches and Will Yeatman's three, Terrapin tight ends combined for eight in the game, a season-high for the position. Furstenburg set career highs in receptions and yards (98). Yeatman matched his career high in receptions, while his 41 yards were a career best.

Cannon Comes Through: Senior wide receiver Adrian Cannon had a career-high seven receptions for 67 yards against Clemson. Cannon made a highlight-reel catch in the first quarter, reaching behind him to make a one-handed catch while in stride that went for 26 yards.

In the Rankings: Da'Rel Scott moved up to 10th on Maryland's all-time rushing list. He now has 1,970 yards in his career ... Alex Wujciak moved into a tie for 14<sup>th</sup> on Maryland's career tackles list. He is tied with Kevin Walker (1985-87) with 330.

**Tidbits**: Taylor Watson had a career-long 13-yard run in the first quarter, as well as an 11-yard reception, which matched his career high ... Watson also had a 20-yard kickoff return and his 46 all-purpose yards were a career high ... Darin Drakeford had one tackle-for-loss and is second on the team in that category (4.5) ... Adrian Moten also had a TFL ... there were no turnovers by either team through three quarters.

#### On the game:

"This was a great team win for us. We came together as a family and played tough. The past games we've been close to pulling all the strings together to make us one unit, but today we finally did it and took care of business. We took care of the ball, played together, and overwhelmed our opponent.

"We did what we had to do to win. The kickoff return for a touchdown by Andre (Ellington), our three picks on defense, and our special teams unit played a major role in our win today."

#### Handling Maryland's defense:

"Our offensive line did an excellent job on picking up their blitz. The most difficult part in preparing for the game was the schematics of their defense. Kyle Parker also did a good job by scrambling in the pocket. He's really hard to sack. He maintained good ball protection and was able to read the defense really well."

#### On Kyle Parker:

"KP had a career high in rushing yards this game. We worked during the week in adding a lot of new stuff for him because we knew we needed him in order to win this week."

#### On the play of his defense:

"Da'Quan (Bowers) had a terrific game today with 6 tackles and 3 sacks. Gave him the game ball for his great effort."

"Overall defensively we played tough and worked through our difficulties. We came out in the third quarter and perfected our flaws. Kids like Miguel (Chavis) and (Xavier) Brewer really stepped up today. Brewer especially impressed me today. He's a really serious, focused player and I was happy to see him do well today."

#### Maryland Head Coach Ralph Friedgen

#### On the team's response in the second half:

"We went in at halftime confident, and we came out in the second half flat. I'll take the responsibility there. We didn't play very well in the second half. We didn't play very smart. We had too many penalties in key situations. We were not very good, again, on third down on either side of the ball. We have to play smarter, and if we don't, then we won't know how good a football team we can be."

#### On his team's overall play:

"We're young, and I can make all the rationalizations, but it's really a matter of getting it done. We're not getting it done. It's not getting done. I'm going to start holding people's feet to the fire because they have to get it done."

#### On dealing with Da'Quan Bowers:

"We were trying to do some things to help on Bowers. He's a good player. Like I said before the game, you have to get a running game going. You can't let these guys get going and just tee off and come after you."

#### On the development of quarterback Danny O'Brien:

"I thought Danny was doing okay until he threw those interceptions. You can't do that. I know we were in passing situations, but I'd rather have an incompletion or a sack than an interception. Overall, I think he did some good things. He's going to improve every game because he's a young kid. As a redshirt freshman playing in his third game, he's probably doing better than average."

#### On the next step for his team:

"We have to win on the road. I think sometimes that our guys think we're on an amusement trip or something. We're on a business trip to win football games. We have to learn how to do that if we're going to be the team we want to be. We've got some tough road games coming up."

#### Quarterback Kyle Parker

"I had to make some plays with my feet. It's not going to go the way you draw it up every time. You have to improvise and make plays and I feel like I did that and put us in a position to win."

"It was really cool to have C.J. back today. He came and talked to us last night, and you don't really find a better guy than C.J. The biggest thing that I noticed is that he's still the same humble teammate that I played with. He just came back and encouraged us."

"I don't care if we won 3-0 and had zero yards of offense, it didn't matter today. We just needed to go out there and do what we needed to do to win. The biggest thing was that whenever the momentum came our way, we just took it on offense."

#### Defensive end Da'Quan Bowers

"I want to give my teammates my best effort every week. I don't want to let those guys down because there are a bunch of guys out there depending on me to make plays. I just want to give all the credit to all my fellow defensive players giving me the chance, especially putting pressure on the quarterback allowing me to make plays."

"This is a very big win for us. We needed this win to get back on track. Coach Swinney says it's a one-game season and we have to take it game-by-game."

Clemson vs. Maryland Notes Memorial Stadium October 16, 2010

#### **Team Notes**

- \*Clemson's 31-7 victory today was the Tigers largest victory margin and most points scored against the Terps since Ralph Friedgen became head coach in 2001. The previous high was 30 points in a 30-17 win at Maryland in 2007.
- \*This is the first time Clemson has had two returns for touchdowns since last year's Miami (FL) game. It is the third time Clemson has done this since Dabo Swinney became head coach in 2008. Clemson also did it last year against Middle Tennessee. Clemson had just two games with two returns for touchdowns in the last 17 years prior to him taking over in the middle of the 2008 season.
- \* Clemson committed nine penalties against North Carolina last week. However, the Tigers did not commit a penalty until the third quarter in today's game and finished the game with just three penalties.
- \*Since 2002, Clemson is now 35-13 in regular season games played after October 15 and 26-21 in games played before October 15.
- \*Andre Ellington had an 87-yard kickoff return for a touchdown today, his first career kick return for a score. He accomplished this on the day C.J. Spiller's number was retired. Spiller is the NCAA career leader in kickoff returns for touchdowns with seven.
- \*Ellington's kickoff return for a score was the fifth punt or kickoff return for a touchdown against Maryland since 1990. Clemson had lost each of the last two games against Maryland when a Tiger ran a kickoff back for a score. Derrick Hamilton went 100 yards on a kickoff return for a score at Maryland in 2001, a game Clemson lost. Then last year, C.J. Spiller went 92 yards with a kickoff return for a score, but the Tigers lost 24-21.
- \* Clemson was 2-2 in the red-zone today. On the season, the Tigers have scored 18 touchdowns in 20 red-zone possessions this season, 90 percent. Clemson scored touchdowns in the red-zone at a 57 percent rate last year. Maryland entered the game having allowed just five touchdowns in 20 opponent red-zone possessions and ranked seventh in the nation in red-zone defense.
- \* The 13 play, 80-yard, and 6:52 drive that resulted in a Jamie Harper touchdown in the second quarter was the longest Clemson drive of the season in terms of plays and time of possession.
- \* In the third quarter, Clemson stopped Maryland on a fourth-and-four play. This was the first time this season Clemson had stopped an opponent on a four-down play. Entering today, opponents were 5-for-5 on fourth down plays against the Tigers.

#### **Individual Notes**

- \* Chandler Catanzaro made a 42-yard field goal, his fourth of the season, in the first quarter of today's game. All of his field goals this season have been between 40-49 yards.
- \*Andre Ellington scored two touchdowns today and finished with a team best 163 all-purpose yards. He now leads the team in touchdowns with nine.
- \* Da'Quan Bowers recorded three sacks and four tackles for loss in today's game. He now has a total of nine sacks and 15.5 tackles for loss on the season. Bowers sack total is already the most by a Clemson player since 2006 when Gaines Adams had 12.5. The Clemson single season record is 16 by former linebacker Keith Adams in 1999. Bowers has nine sacks this year. The Clemson team had just 14 for the entire 2008 season.

Bowers has recorded a sack and at least two tackles for loss in all of Clemson's games this season except Presbyterian, a contest in which he played just 21 plays.

Today was a career high for sacks in a game for Bowers. In fact, he was the first Clemson player to record three sacks in a game since 2001 when Bryant McNeal had three against Duke on Dec. 1. Gaines Adams, who also wore number-93, never had more than 2.5 in a game.

- \* Jaron Brown had the longest punt return of his career and the longest punt return of the season for Clemson with a 41-yard punt return in the third quarter. He finished the game with three punt returns for 52 yards, also a career-high for punt return yards.
- \* Kyle Parker had a career-high in both carries (11) and rushing yards (39) and was tied for the leading rusher in today's game. Parker is now 12-8 as a starting quarterback.
- \* DeAndre McDaniel recorded his second interception of the season and the 13<sup>th</sup> of his career. He is now tied with Justin Miller for fourth place in Clemson history in career interceptions.
- \* Xavier Brewer, who attended the same high school as Clemson quarterback Kyle Parker, intercepted his second pass of the season in the third quarter and returned it 61 yards for a touchdown. The last time Clemson had an interception return for a touchdown was against Miami (FL) last season when DeAndre McDaniel returned an interception 23 yards for a touchdown in the Tigers' 40-37 win in overtime.
- \* Darius Robinson recorded the first interception of his career in the fourth quarter of today's game. The true freshman had played just 41 snaps entering today's game.
- \* Rashard Hall had a team-high eight tackles in today's game. Hall was also the leading tackler against Miami (FL) when he recorded 10 tackles.
